SERIES RECAP:

A strong outing from the Reading Fightin Phils' pitching staff led the R-Phils to a 6-0 shutout over the New Hampshire Fisher Cats (Blue Jays) to open a six-game homestand on Tuesday. Ethan Lindow turned in his best outing in a Fightins jersey in 2022, pitching six-scoreless innings and striking out five. Reading's pitchers combined Johan Rojas, Jhailyn Ortiz and Aldrem Corredor each tallied two hits. Johan Camargo, who is on an MLB rehab assignment in Reading, tallied two hits, two runs and two RBIs.

CAMARGO COMING:

Johan Camargo starts an MLB rehab assignment in Reading on Tuesday. He contributed two hits, two runs and two RBIs while batting third and starting at third base. The Phillies placed the infielder on the 10-day injured list with a right knee strain on June 29. This is Camargo's second time on the injured list in 2022. He landed on the 10-day injured list on June 7 with a right knee strain and rehabbed in Triple-A (Lehigh Valley). Camargo worked his way back to the Phillies and was activated on June 21 but reinjured his right knee. In 2022, his first season with the Phillies, Camargo has 32 hits through 47 games at the highest level. The Phillies signed Camargo as a free agent on Dec. 1, 2021.

RIJO & ROJAS:

Wendell Rijo and Johan Rojas lead the Fightins on offense and defense. In Tuesday's win, Rojas had two hits and two runs scored while swiping two bases. Rijo added a hit and a run. In the previous 10 games before Tuesday, Rijo leads the team with a .375 batting average, a .500 on-base percentage, nine runs and nine walks. He hit tome home runs last Wednesday at Richmond and ranks second on the team, behind Rojas, with 12 hits, six RBI and four stolen bases. Over the same time frame, Rojas leads the team in hits (14). He pulls in right behind Rijo with a .341 batting average .438 on-base percentage and six walks. He stole a team-best six bases in the last 10 games. The two speedsters lead the R-Phils on the base paths while also showing it off in the field. Rijo makes quick plays in the infield, whether he's at third or second base. Rojas showed the ability to play all three outfield positions with his ability to cover lots of ground quickly.

LINDOW'S LEARNING:

Left-handed pitcher Ethan Lindow will start his eighth game of the season for the Reading Fightin Phils on Tuesday. Lindow picked up his second win of the season in Double-A on Tuesday. He pitched six-scoreless frames and gave up five hits while striking out five. Since his call up from Jersey Shore (A+), Lindow worked his way into the starting rotation and found success recently. In his start on July 7 against Richmond (Giants), Lindow pitched 6.2 innings, his longest outing in Double-A this season. In his last start at home before Tuesday, he pitched six innings-string innings, giving up one run on four hits. His first win of the season in Reading came on June 10 against Altoona (Pirates) when he went five innings and finished with a season-high eight strikeouts. Lindow made six appearances, including five starts, in Reading last season. The Phillies drafted him in the fifth round of the 2017 MLB Draft.

BIG LEAGUE CLUB WATCH:

The Phillies lost to the Blue Jays 4-3 at Toronto on Tuesday. Odubel Herrera plated the Philies' first run of the game with an RBI single in the top of the second inning, cutting the team's deficit to one run. A home run from Bryson Stott in the top of the fourth and an RBI single by Nick Castellanos tied the game at three runs apiece. But the Blue Jays pulled ahead in the sixth inning for good. Andrew Bellatti got the start on the mound and Jeury's Familia took the loss in Tuesday's contest.
