Today's Game: The Sounds take on the Saints in the second game of the series after winning a thrilling 5-4 game last night. Nashville will send right-hander Janson Junk to the mound for his first start of the season and opposed by Saints right-hander Caleb Boushley.

Janson Junk: The 28-year-old is making his 28th career appearance (26th start) with the Sounds. He finished last season 7-10 with a 3.65 ERA (140.0 IP/65 ER) and 94 strikeouts for Nashville. He added two appearances (1 start) with Milwaukee...7.1 IP, 8 H, 4 ER, 2 BB, 5 K. He ranked among qualified International League pitchers in ERA (3rd), innings (3rd), starts (T-4th), WHIP (6th, 1.35), and win percentage (8th, .412). Junk was originally drafted in the 22nd round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft by the Yankees out of Seattle University.

Caleb Boushley: The 30-year-old makes his return to Nashville after having 54 appearances (51 starts) in the last two seasons for the Sounds. Boushley earned the 2022 Pitcher of the Year award and 2023 Community Player of the Year award in his time with Nashville. He was 9-8 with a 5.11 ERA (135.2/77 ER) and 110 strikeouts in 2023. Boushley led the team in wins in 2022 (12) and ERA (3.25). He has pitched the most innings for the club over the last two seasons (263.0 IP) and second-most since 2015. Boushley was picked up by the Twins after electing free agency on November 6. Dating back to 2015, he has the most wins (21) and starts (51) by any Sounds pitcher.

Calm Before the Storm: Neither team scored during the first five inning of Tuesday's game. Saints starter Simeon Woods Richardson went 5.0 innings while allowing three hits, two walks, and four strikeouts. The Sounds had the sacks jammed in the 5th but were unable to score with Joey Wiemer grounding out to end the inning. Sounds starter, Aaron Ashby had a clean first five innings giving up two hits and striking out five.

Rain, Rain, Go Away: Ashby allowed the first three runners in the 6th to reach base, including one scoring before the game was put into delay due to rain. The delay lasted one hour and 24 minutes before returning to action. Nashville last had a home opener delay in 2019 against Iowa and had Opening Day postponed last season against Louisville.

Yonny! Yonny!: After a Brewer Hicklen single and Patrick Dorian walk, Yonny Hernandez launched a three-run home run to take a 5-4 lead. This was Hernandez's first home run with the Sounds and his 10th in 2,106 career minor league at-bats.

Raging Bullpen: The Sounds bullpen has been exceptional to start the season posting a 1.56 ERA (17.1 IP/3 ER) which is good for 2nd-best in the International League. Nick Bennett and Kevin Herget each had 2.0 innings of scoreless relief against Toledo and Rob Zastryzny added 2.0 scoreless last night. The Sounds pen had 5.0 innings of scoreless relief to finish off a shutout victory on Sunday against Toledo.

Back in Black: Tyler Black extended his on-base streak to 20 games, dating back to September 5, 2023. He's batting .420 (29-for-69) with 23 runs, 11 extra-base hits, 15 RBI and 16 walks during the streak.

All Zapped Up: Rob Zastryzny retired all six batters he faced in the 7th and 8th inning last night. He has four-straight scoreless outings dating back to last season...5.2 IP, 2 H, 7 K. The lefty was signed by Milwaukee as a free agent on December 12 after pitching in the Pirates organization last season.

Enoli's Cannoli's: Enoli Paredes picked up the first save of the Sounds season by striking out all three batters in the 9th. Paredes has converted 26 of 36 total save chances and 20 of 29 at the Triple-A level. He has not allowed a baserunner in his 2.0 innings for the Sounds in 2024. Paredes had 52 appearances for Triple-A Sugarland in 2023 posting a 4.80 ERA (54.1 IP/29 ER)

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet returns for his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 684-584 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,277-2,104 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more wins).

Back Home Again: The Sounds are now 28-18 in home openers and have won their last three (2022 vs. Durham, 2023 vs. Louisville, 2024 vs. St. Paul. Both of the previous two wins came in walk-off fashion, with Corey Ray getting a single to win it in '22 and Tyler Naquin hit a two-run blast to win it in '23.
