### Today's Game

The Fightin Phils continue a series with the Somerset Patriots, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. It is the 10th-of-18 matchups between the teams this season and seventh-of-nine at TD Bank Ballpark. Reading and Somerset split the team's lone series in Somerset from Apr. 8-13. Following this week's split series, the Patriots return to Reading from Sept. 9-14 to finish off the 2025 season.

### Game 76 Recap

The Fightin Phils picked up their first win of the week, in a 2-1 affair on Thursday. Aidan Miller led off the first inning with an infield single, and after a stolen base, scored on a single to center field from Jose Rodriguez. Reading's second run of the night came on a RBI fielders' choice hit by Hendry Mendez. Chuck King started for Reading and was strong again on the mound. He did not pick up a quality start, but earned his fourth win. King allowed one run on five hits over 5.1 innings, with four strikeouts. Behind King, Andrew Walling finished off the sixth inning, then tossed a scoreless seventh. Tommy McCollum then followed and got the final six outs of the game for his fourth save, and second-straight two-inning save.

### Double Trouble

The Fightin Phils have turned an impressive amount of double plays the last couple of weeks. Since the start of the Richmond series on June 24, Reading has turned nine double plays, which is tied for third in the Eastern League over that stretch.

### The Ball was Flying in June

The Fightin Phils finished June with 29 home runs on the month, which was ranked as most in the Eastern League. Second place was this week's openent, Somerset, who hit 28 long balls. Reading racked up tons of extra-base hits in June, as they had the second-most doubles in the league at 50 and were tied for the second-most triples as well, with seven.

### Newcomers Starting Strong

Both Dylan Campbell and Jose Rodriguez joined the Fightin Phils prior to last week's series in Richmond and had great starts to their Reading tenures. After going hitless in his first game, Rodriguez posted a .353 average (6-17) over the next five games of the week, which included a home run, three RBI and two stolen bases. Campbell had a hit in all five games he played in last week, and hit .313 (5-16) at Richmond, with two stolen bases and a RBI.

### Binelas Brings the Boom

Alex Binelas continued his recent surge with a hit and two RBI on Wednesday, then a double on Thursday. Since June 11 (18 games), Binelas is slashing .350/.400/.633 (1.033 OPS). He's added 13 runs, five doubles, four home runs and 19 RBI. Since June 11, Binelas holds the following Eastern League ranks: 6th AVG (.350), T-3rd HR (4), T-1st RBI (19), 4th SLG (.633), 3rd OPS (1.033) and T-10th TB (38).

### Organizational Honors for Felix Reyes

Felix Reyes was named Phillies Minor League Hitter of June on Thursday. Over 18 June games, Reyes slashed .324/.360/.620 (.980 OPS), along with 14 runs, five doubles, two triples, four home runs and nine RBI, along with two stolen bases. Reyes struck out just nine times over 75 plate appearances (12%). Reyes's June Eastern League rankings: 7th ABG (.324), T-6th HR (4), 4th SLG (.620), 4th OPS (.980), T-5th 3B (2), T-5th XBH (11) and T-7th XBH (44).

### It's Miller Time

After not playing much the two weeks prior, Aidan Miller returned to the lineup and played in the final five games at Richmond last week. Miller rode a 10-game on-base streak from June 7-29. Miller hit a season-high two doubles on Sunday, which marked the fifth two-double game of his career, and first since May 17, 2024, when he was with Clearwater against Daytona Beach. After another stolen base Thursday, Miller sits at 29 stolen bases, which is alone in second place in both the Eastern League and Phillies organization.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

**July 4, 2024:** At Reading, the Fightin Phils first home game on July 4 since 2015 is suspended due to rain in the top of the fourth inning. After over an hour since last game action, MEGA Blast fireworks are still shot off to the delight of the fans who stuck around.

### Sup Somerset

Somerset enters tonight with a 39-39 overall record, and 4-5 record in the second half, which is fourth in the Northeast Division. The Patriots dropped four-of-six games against Erie last week to begin the second half, winning on Thursday and Saturday. Following this week, Somerset remains home and welcomes New Hampshire. The Patriots roster has eight of the Yankee's Top-30 prospects: George Lombard (1), Chase Hampton (7), Brock Selvidge (8), Rafael Flores (15), Carlos Lagrange (17), Trystan Vrieling (22), Roc Riggio (24) and Bredan Jones (29).

### Patriots Pitcher

Righty Trent Sellers makes the start tonight for Somerset. Over 13 starts this season, Sellers is 1-4, with a 4.07 ERA (25 ER, 55.1 IP). He's struck out 68 across 55.1 innings (11.06 SO/9.0 IP). Sellers last pitched June 27 against Erie, allowing one run on four hits over 4.2 innings, with eight strikeouts in a no-decision. Sellers has only surpassed five innings in four-of-13 starts, and has not in his last six appearances. Against Reading on Apr. 13, Sellers allowed two runs on four hits over 4.1 innings, with four strikeouts, in a no-decision. Sellers spent most of 2024 with Hudson Valley (A+), but made one appearance with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, going 7-3, with a 2.26 ERA over 32 games. The 25-year old signed with the Yankees in July of 2023 as a free agent.

Jimenez bounced back in a big way in his second Double-A start, also earning his first Double-A win. He started the game on a great note, not allowing a run over the first five innings of work. Returning for the sixth, Jimenez was tagged for a couple of runs before being lifted from the game with two outs, but in line for the win. Jimenez was relieved by Daniel Harper in the bottom of the sixth inning.

- Began season Jersey Shore (A+); promoted to Reading (AA) on June 22
- Made Double-A debut June 22 vs Hartford (L, 5.0 IP, 7 H, 6 ER, 2 HR, 3 BB, 2 SO); matched season-highs in runs (6) and walks (3)
