NOTES

LAST TIME OUT: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies walked-off the Harrisburg Senators on Sunday on the series finale, with a bases-loaded walk from Nolan McLean, and won 3-2 in 11 innings. The two teams split the six-game series. RHP Brandon Sproat struck out a career-high 10 batters over a career-high seven scoreless innings, while allowing just one hit and one walk. He faced the minimum over his first six innings of work. Ryan Clifford hit his second Double-A homer with a solo shot in the second inning and McLean extended his hitting streak to three games, along with drawing the game-winning RBI walk.

LIGHTNING MCLEAN: Mets No. 19 prospect two-way Nolan McLean drew a walkoff walk in the 11th inning on Sunday against Harrisburg to win the game for Binghamton. McLean doubled in the seventh inning and extended his hitting streak to three games. He belted the first home run of his Double-A career with a solo shot on Friday against Harrisburg. McLean is slated to make his third Double-A start on the mound tonight against Bowie. The 22-year-old pitched five innings of two-hit ball with four strikeouts on Wednesday against Harrisburg. McLean was drafted by the Mets in the third round of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Oklahoma State.

**SPROAT KEEPS SPROUTING:** Mets No. 13 prospect **Brandon Sproat** spun the best start of his professional career to date on Sunday against Harrisburg. The 23-year-old right-hander struck out a career-high 10 batters over a career-high seven scoreless innings, while allowing just two baserunners on one hit and one walk. Sproat faced the minimum over his first six innings of work. In two starts last series against the Senators, Sproat struck out 15 batters over 14 innings of one-run ball, while issuing five hits and three walks. Over his first 10 professional appearances, across High-A Brooklyn and Double-A Binghamton, Sproat ranks tied-for-third with a 1.23 ERA. He has gone a career-high seven innings in three-straight starts and in each of his first four Double-A starts, Sproat has gone at least five innings and has allowed three runs or fewer. Sproat is 1-0 with a 1.38 ERA and a 30-to-6 strikeout-to-walk ratio at the Double-A level.

**CLIFFORD THE BIG RUMBLE PDNY:** Mets No. 4 prospect **Ryan Clifford** belted the second home run of his Double-A career on Sunday with a solo homer against Harrisburg and he was intentionally walked twice. Clifford has drawn 43 walks across High-A and Double-A and currently ranks tied for the third-most walks in Minor League Baseball, with Rylan Bannon (Triple-A Syracuse). In 16 games at Double-A, Clifford has two homers, four doubles, and 11 walks. He hit 24 home runs last season, which was the second-most among teenagers in all of MiLB. Clifford was traded to the Mets by the Houston Astros, along with Mets No. 2 prospect Drew Gilbert, for Justin Verlander at the trade deadline last season.

**BAYSOX ROSTER:** The Bowie Baysox current roster features nine of the Baltimore Orioles top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline. Bowie won four-of-six games in the series at Binghamton in May, with the Ponies taking the series opener & finale.

LAST START: McLean allowed two runs on six hits and two walks over a career-high-tying five innings with four strikeouts against Harrisburg on Wednesday morning at home, and took the loss..Binghamton was shut out in a rain-shortened game that ended in seven innings.

**2024 SEASON:** Began the season with High-A Brooklyn...Went 2-2 with a 2.57 ERA and 36 strikeouts in 28 innings across seven starts for the Cyclones...Hit .222 with an .849 OPS, five home runs, and 13 runs batted in over 25 games as the Cyclones' designated hitter.

-Reid Brignac (pronounced Brin-yac) is coming off leading the Rumble Ponies to the postseason last season, for the first time since 2017. In 2023, under Brignac's tutelage, the Ponies went on a second-half surge, going 39-27 overall and 17-5 over their last 22 games. Brignac's team swept the Somerset Patriots in the Eastern League Division Series to lead the Ponies to the ELCS before falling to Erie.

-In 2022, he led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies, tying a Binghamton franchise record (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, José Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca). Brignac also was the Mets' representative on the Arizona Fall League coaching staff after that season, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas.

-Brignac enjoyed a long and successful playing career, spending parts of nine years in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was initially drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft, out of St. Amant High School.

-AJ Sager was named the 2023 New York Mets Minor League Staff Member of the Year for his efforts last year. Sager's pitching staff in 2023 set a Binghamton franchise record with 15 shutouts and took home five Eastern League honors, highlighted by Mike Vasil winning Eastern League Pitcher of the Month for May and Dom Hamel being named EL Pitcher of the Month for September. Sager's staff also ranked first among the 30 Double-A clubs in strike rate and walks issued, and second in opponent on-base percentage. On September 7 at Hartford, right-hander Joander Suarez threw the eighth no-hitter in franchise history, facing the minimum 21 batters over seven innings.

-Sager previously spent 20 years coaching in the Detroit Tigers organization and pitched for parts of five seasons in the major leagues, playing for the San Diego Padres, Colorado Rockies, and Tigers as part of a 12-year professional career. In 123 major league appearances, the right-hander was 12-15, with five saves and a 5.36 ERA. Sager was originally drafted by the Padres in the 10th round of the 1988 MLB Draft, out of the University of Toledo.
