### Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Pedro Avila** to the mound tonight, looking to bounce back from yesterday's loss (2-7 on Friday, 4G losing streak). Louisville will counter with LHP **Brandon Leibrandt**. Columbus is 4-12 (.250) versus left handers this year. Leibrandt has pitched against the Clippers two times in his career, going 0-1 with a save and a 5.19ERA (8.2IP, 7H, 5R, 5ER, 1BB, 4K).

### vs. the Bats

Columbus was 7-11 against Louisville last year, going 4-10 in the last 14G to lose the season series for the third straight year (4-0 from 2018-22). Individually, **Kahlil Watson** has gone 11x30 (.367) with a HR and 3RBI against the Bats during his career (8G). **George Valera** has collected 6HR and 14RBI in 27G opposing Louisville, while **Kody Huff** owns 2HR and 11RBI in 14G.

### Crazy Eighthths

Columbus had an 8th inning scoring streak snapped at 7G last Tuesday, but has scored in 11 of the last 14G (also scored in five of eight last 9ths). On the year, the Clippers have 84 runs from the 8th inning on (19 more than 2nd place), crafting a collective .976OPS (+131 points on 2nd). In the 8th alone, Columbus has 22 runs in the last 14G (more than nine teams have all season, including Louisville).

### UnFairchild

**Stuart Fairchild's** on base streak was snapped at 10G in the nightcap last Friday, when he got only 3PA due to the shortened game (.500OBP, 5/2-5/15), and he has just 1G with a PA since (1x4 with a BB on 5/16 at St. Paul). Entering tonight, Fairchild ranks 4th in the IL with a .434OBP and is one of 10 in the IL hitting at least .300/.400/.500 (joined by **Kody Huff**, **Noelvi Marte** and **Edwin Arroyo**).

### Watch Out for Watson

**Kahlil Watson** is hitting .306/.402/.613 with 17XBH in his last 29G (1XBH in first 12G), having reached base in each of 13G prior to last Friday (.453OBP, 4/23-5/13). Watson hit 4HR and had 15RBI in 7G from 5/9-5/16 (.300, 9x30); however, he has not drawn a walk in his last 10G (45PA; hitting .295, 13x44), his longest walkless stretch since a 17G run from 5/21-6/17/22 (career long, 76PA; hit .189, 14x74).

### Controlling the Zone

**Cooper Ingle** is riding a 7G hit streak (.385, 10x26 since 5/13), but more importantly, his exceptional pitch recognition has returned with 6BB and 3K in his last 5G (24PA; had 3BB and 12K over 37PA of 9G prior). After his OBP dropped to .517 on 5/15 (lowest since .500 on 4/1), Ingle has reached 14 times in 24PA. He is the only batter in pro baseball with at least 100PA and an OBP over .500 (.531).

### Hey Now

After a rocky start to his Triple-A career (1x10, 2K), **Angel Genao** has hit .347/.407/.673 with 3HR and 7RBI in 13G, including four multi-hit games. Saturday's homer was his sixth between Akron and Columbus in 36G (max of 10HR in 110G in 2024). Genao was leading the Eastern League in walks (22) at the time of his promotion, but has just 5BB in 64PA with the Clippers (1BB in each of last 3G, 12PA).

### Hot Huff

**Kody Huff** rebounded from a pair of hitless games to end April with hits in each of his first 12G this month (.476, 20x42, 14RBI). The hit streak, from 5/1-5/16, set a new career best, topping his streak in the first 10G of April, 4/1-4/12 (.316, 12x38; hit .220, 11x50, in last 13G of the month). Though Huff's hit streak ended on Tuesday, he rebounded with an RBI single on Wednesday (23RBI in last 25G).

### POW Hangover

Since being named the IL's Batter of the Week for 4/14-4/19 vs. Iowa (10x20, 4HR, 10RBI), **Milan Tolentino** is hitting .169/.273/.221 with 0HR and 8RBI in 21G (15K in last 22PA). Of 41 IL batters with at least 20HR since the start of last season, Tolentino is one of two that has not homered off LHP (108AB; 27HR in 431AB vs. RHP), but he is hitting .393 (11x28) off lefties this year (.138 in '25).

### Back on Track

In the last 10G, the Columbus bullpen has cobbled together a 2.66ERA (40.2IP, 12ER), the 3rd best mark in the IL (3ER or fewer in all 10G, longest streak of the year). Clipper relievers had allowed 21ER in 10.1IP of the 2G prior to the hot streak, as the relief ERA rose to 6.08 (worst in the IL; currently at 5.42, 17th). They have allowed 1HR to 182BF in the last 10G (17HR to 775BF prior, 45.6PA/HR).

# Columbus Clippers Game Information

## This Date in Clipper History

5/22/1993

Columbus beat Ottawa 9-4 on the strength of 2HR and 4RBI from Hensley "Bam Bam" Meulens. The Clippers scored 5 runs in the top of the 7th to break the game open. Meulens would hit 14HR in 1993 for the Clippers, his 5th and final season with Columbus. He currently ranks 3rd all-time in franchise history with 73HR and 2nd with 266RBI.

## Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,425 to 1,374).

## Challenging Times

The Clippers are 68-65 (.511) in pitch reviews, with batters going 40-45 (.471) and pitchers/catchers going 28-20 (.583). They have run out of challenges in 27G and have not challenged in 2G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

## Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 1-3 in extra innings this season, after having gone 5-5 in 2025 and 9-9 in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 51-36 when playing past regulation (.586, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-17 at home (.605, but 4-7 in last 11G). Of the 87G to require extra play, 69 have been resolved after one frame (including eight DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

## On the Runs

Starting with the embiggened 150G schedule in 2022, the Clippers scored over 800 runs in three consecutive seasons from 2022-2024 (855, 808 and 805 runs, respectively; accounting for the 3rd, 4th and 5th best totals in team history). Following a steep decline last season (670, fewest scored in a full season since 2018), Columbus is looking to easily top 800 again, with an outside chance to establish a new team high (on pace for 863, would rank as 3rd most all-time; 898 scored in 1983).

## On the Run

On the basepaths, the Clippers are making a run at the franchise mark in stolen bases, with 67 through the first 48G (on pace for 209SB). The team record was set in 2024 when Columbus swiped an even 200, but the team speed was throttled last year (129SB; still, the 2nd highest total since the Cleveland affiliation started in 2009). However, with 18CS so far, the Clippers are also pacing (56) for the most times caught stealing of the Cleveland affiliation (nabbed 79 times in 2008, last time over 51).

## Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 77 grand slams and 1,924RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

## Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

## In Big Trouble

The Clipper pitching staff is trending toward the worst ERA in club history, sitting at 5.55 through the first 48G. Since the reorganization of the minor leagues in 2021, Columbus has twice finished the season with a 5+ ERA (current record is 5.32, set in 2023), after having done so just once in the first 43 seasons (5.08 in 1983). However, the staff is pacing to give up only 144HR (lowest total since 133HR in 2018; averaging 182 per season since the Year of the Homer in 2019).

## Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 15th in the IL this year (.976), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 23G this season (14-9, .609), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

## Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

## Good Baseball

Stuart Fairchild moved a runner into scoring position with a bunt single on 5/13 at St. Paul and that runner came around to score in a win. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 86-23 (.789) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 3-2 mark this season (.600, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

## To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses last season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (1-17th, .439).

## Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following Tony Mansolino's championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; Gene Michael-'79, Joe Altobelli-'80, Frank Verdi-'81, Bucky Dent-'87 and Mike Sarbaugh-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 411-429 (.489), 381-383 with Columbus (.499).

### Unfortunate Run:

Prior to 3GS from 4/19-5/1 (14.2IP, 16ER), Avila had only one stretch of consecutive games with at least 5ER in his previous 248G as a professional. That run came with El Paso in 2023, as he surrendered at least 5ER in each of 5G to end April (19.0IP, 27ER). In total, he has given up at least 5ER on 24 occasions, maxing out at 7ER with both Fort Wayne in 2017 and San Diego in 2023.

### 2026 Spring Training:

Avila pitched six times for Cleveland in spring training, turning in a 3.24ERA (8.1IP, 10H, 4R, 3ER, 1BB, 4K). He was released on 3/17, then signed a new minor league deal on 3/22 and assigned to minor league camp.

### Last Season:

Pitched for Yakult in Japan... in the Central League (Majors) went 7-8 with a 4.04ERA in 15G (82.1IP, 70H, 41R, 37ER, 30BB, 61K)... in the Eastern League (minors) was 0-1 with a 1.33ERA in 6G (20.1IP, 12H, 3R, 1ER, 12BB, 13K).
