### RIDERS SECURE SERIES SPLIT WITH MIDLAND:

The Frisco RoughRiders defeated the Midland RockHounds 5-1 on Sunday evening from Riders Field. Frisco (27-17) starter **Emiliano Teodo** (3-1) tossed 6.0 innings, allowing just one run on five hits and a walk while fanning four. Midland (28-17) starter James Gonzalez (2-1) allowed a two-out RBI single to **Josh Hatcher** in the bottom of the first inning, plating **Kellen Strahm**. Caeden Trenkle blasted his second homer of the series to tie the game at 1-1, marking the first home run allowed by Teodo this season. **Cody Freeman** worked a leadoff walk in the bottom of the fourth and went to third on a double by **Abimelec Ortiz**. The Riders regained the lead on a groundout by **Frainyer Chavez**. **Geisel Cepeda** and **Cooper Johnson** each recorded two-out RBI singles in the frame to push the Frisco lead to 4-1. Chavez scored on a throwing error in the bottom of the sixth, providing the fifth run for the Riders and capping off the game's scoring. **Florencio Serrano** tossed a pair of scoreless, one hit innings before giving way to **Robby Ahlstrom**, who faced the minimum in the ninth while striking out two to secure the 5-1 win. Offensively, Hatcher snagged the only multi-hit performance with three two-out singles in the contest. Chavez drove in a run, scored a run and reached twice via the walk. Strahm's first inning single pushed his on base streak to 29 games.

### FULLY LOADED:

The RoughRiders have been the best hitting club in the Texas League with the bases loaded this season, hitting .333 (12-for-36) with 38 RBIs, but they are one of two teams (Corpus Christi) without a grand slam. This is coming off of last season when the RoughRiders hit a franchise record nine grand slam.

### TO BE FAIR, IN MY DEFENSE:

The RoughRiders have committed just 24 errors this season in 44 games, the fewest in all of Minor League Baseball. Their .984 fielding percentage is the best in MiLB as well. Their 43 double plays are first in the Texas League and fourth among non-Triple-A teams. **Cody Freeman** is one of just 14 players in Minor League Baseball who has at least 80 total chances and has not committed an error while he is one of just two non-first baseman infielders with at least 80 chances and no errors.

### RISP-ECT THIS:

The RoughRiders have been great with runners in scoring position this season, but have struggled recently. Over their last nine games, they are just 4-5 and are hitting .185 (12-for-65) with runners in scoring position. On the season, they are still first in the Texas League, batting .276 with RISP. **Josh Hatcher** leads the team and is ninth in the Texas League, batting .348 with RISP.

### MORE THAN O-KAY(ber):

**Keyber Rodriguez** has been tearing up the baseball over the last week. In his last 10 games, Rodriguez is hitting .432 (16-for-37) with six multi-hit games during that span, including five doubles, a triple, a home run, seven RBIs, two walks, five runs scored and a steal. The infielder raised his batting average from .087 to .300 and OPS from .371 to .865 over the last week.

### IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

Riders outfielder **Kellen Strahm** has the longest on-base streak this season for the RoughRiders, currently at 29 games. During the streak, he hit .306 (33-for-108)/.392/.426/.818 with two doubles, a triple, three home runs, 10 RBIs, 16 walks, six steals and 25 runs scored. The streak is the second-longest active streak in the Texas League. In his career, Strahm has the second-longest on-base streak in RoughRiders franchise history (37 games in 2022). His 161 career walks with the RoughRiders are the second-most in franchise history, trailing only **Guilherme Rodriguez**, who walked 206 times over seven seasons from 2009 to 2015.

### I WANT TO BREAK FREE(MAN):

**Cody Freeman** had a monster game on April 25th against Amarillo, going 5-for-5 with two home runs and a double. It was the first five-hit game in Freeman's Minor League career and the first one for the Riders since **Blaire Crim** accomplished the feat on September 2nd, 2022 at Amarillo. Freeman is sixth in the league in batting average (.301) and sixth in SLG (.500). In his last 27 games, he has batted .343/.377/.616/.993 with all six of his homers. This season, he has the seventh-lowest strikeout rate in the Texas League (12.6%) and has just whiffed six times in 20 games and 72 at-bats in May.

### THE HATCHER HAMMER:

In an incredible win on April 27th, **Josh Hatcher** hammered a three-run, walk-off home run for a 4-3 win over Amarillo. Hatcher's capper was his third home run in as many games. He is slashing .323/.358/.472/.830. Hatcher is third in the league in batting average (.323). Hatcher was named the Rangers Minor League Player of the Month for April. He slashed .373/.403/.576/.979 over 15 games for Frisco in April with three doubles, three home runs, 16 RBIs, 11 runs and three steals. He finished third in the Texas League in batting average (.373), tied for eighth in RBIs (16), sixth in slugging (.576) and sixth in OPS (.979).

### ABOUT JOSH

-Attended South Grand Prairie High School, going 3-0 with a 1.50 ERA, striking out 20 over 14 innings in a shortened 2020 season. He was committed to Stephen F. Austin State University.

-Missed a majority of his freshman (elbow surgery for a broken growth plate) and sophomore (torn meniscus) seasons before returning healthy for his junior campaign...as a freshman, was limited to designated hitter duties on the junior varsity team while unable to pitch due to injury

-Signed his professional contract while on vacation with friends and family in Gulf Shores, Ala., and went kayaking, fishing and jet skiing to celebrate.

### 2024 SEASON

-Stephan began 2024 in Extended Spring Training with a lower back injury before joining the RoughRiders starting rotation.

### 2023 SEASON

-In Double-A debut on July 4th, pitched in front of 12,045 fans at Riders Field. He left after 4.1 innings with lower back spasms.

-He missed the rest of the season with the back injuries.

-In second start of the season with Hickory, he threw seven shutout innings at home against Bowling Green, striking out 10 batters to just three walks.

-Stephan struck out a career-high 11 batters on June 14th against Bowling Green.

-Threw four quality starts out of 11 total starts with Hickory.

### 2022 SEASON

-Broke spring camp at Low-A and went 4-4 with a 3.34 ERA (34 ER/91.2 IP) and 102 SO across 18 G/16 GS, earning a mid-August promotion to Hickory where he posted a 2-1 record, 1.54 ERA (2 ER/11.2 IP) and 13 SO over 3 GS.
