Game 1: The Fisher Cats won 6-3 in the completion of the suspended game from July 4. Chavez Young knocked in two runs and scored again on a wild pitch.

Game 2: The Fisher Cats survived a seventh inning rally from Portland for a 6-5 win. New Hampshire scored five times in the bottom of the first inning and Maximo Castillo won his league-leading 11th game.

2022 SCHEDULE RELEASE: The Fisher Cats have released a 2022 schedule, featuring home matchups on Father's Day, Fourth of July, and Labor Day Weekend. New Hampshire opens up the year on the road at Portland before their home opener on April 12th against Hartford. New Hampshire will also host Richmond, Erie, and Altoona for inter-divisional play.

BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY: September 2, 2016—The Fisher Cats opened the final series of the season with a 7-4 win over the Sea Dogs. Rowdy Tellez hit his 22nd homer and slo drove in a run with a double. Christian Lopes went 2-for-3 with 2 RBI.

MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: The Blue Jays pushed across a run in the bottom of the eighth to beat Baltimore last night 5-4. Relievers Tim Mayza and Jordan Romano each worked a scoreless inning with Mayza earning the win. Romano picked up his 15th save. Toronto is off tonight before opening a series at Rogers Centre with Oakland...Buffalo's game at Scranton/WB was rained out...Vancouver lost 9-8 at Everett on Wednesday.

TONIGHT'S STARTERS: RHP Elvis Luciano makes his 12th start for the Fisher Cats. 21-year old signed a minor league contract with the Blue Jays after starting the season on Toronto's 40-man roster. He appeared in 25 games out of the Toronto bullpen in 2019 after the Jays took him Rule V from Kansas City. This season, his appearances have been limited by injury. Luciano last worked five innings in a start July 13- has been limited to two innings work since then. Had one of his best stats against the Sea Dogs in Manchester on July 1 when he went four scoreless innings.

RHP Nick Frazee should back up Luciano again in this one. 23-year old is coming off his first New Hampshire win when he went five innings, allowing one run on last Thursday vs. Binghamton. Frazee was selected by the Blue Jays in the 22nd round of the 2019 draft (Texas State).

Portland's Brayan Bello makes his 13th start. 22-year old made his Double-A debut against the Fisher Cats on June 12 at Hadlock. Allowed one run in four innings that day—and allowed two runs in 4.2 innings in each of his other two starts against New Hampshire. RHP from the Dominican Republic.

LAST TIME OUT: Has not pitched since starting the July 18 game here at Dunkin Donuts Park. He left that game after just one inning.

VS. HARTFORD: Has made three starts this season against Hartford, but has not earned a decision even though New Hampshire has won all three. Luciano did go five innings on July 13 in Hartford in an 11-5 win, but allowed three home runs in that start.

2019: Luciano was selected in the Rule 5 draft in December 2018 from the Royals, and spent all of 2019 with the Blue Jays. Made his MLB debut on March 31, 2019. Appeared in 25 games, all out of the bullpen, going 1-0 with a 5.35 ERA.

2018: Was in the Royals system, appeared in 13 games – 2 with Pioneer League Idaho Falls – and 11 (all starts) with Burlington, NC (Appy League). KC had acquired Luciano as part of a trade which sent OF Jon Jay to Arizona.

2017: In Arizona's system, pitched for Arizona League Diamondbacks and Pioneer League Missoula.

Career/Personal Notes: On the opening day roster for the Fisher Cats for the first time. Although he has pitched in the Majors, had not pitched higher than Rookie League level prior to this season.

Obtained: Signed by Arizona as a non-drafted free agent in 2017. Traded to Kansas City, and picked up by Toronto in the Rule 5 draft 12/12/18. On Toronto's 40-man roster.
