**TODAY'S GAMES:** Sugar Land concludes their only series in Reno against the Aces on Sunday afternoon. Reno has claimed the series by winning four of the first five contests.

**ABOUT SATURDAY NIGHT:** The Space Cowboys scored four in the first on a two-RBI single from Joe Perez and a two-RBI double from Dixon Machado, and pushed back to a 6-2 lead over Reno thanks to a solo home run by Michael Sandle. The Aces moved ahead with a four-run bottom of the fifth. Sugar Land tied the game on a single by JJ Matijevic, but a three-run homer in the seventh put Reno in front for good.

**FLOWERS FOR FRANCE:** RHP JP France was recognized as the Pacific Coast League Pitcher of the Week on Monday for the Week of April 18 through 24. France made one appearance during the week, pitching five scoreless innings out of the bullpen in a 5-1 Space Cowboys win on Saturday night. The right-hander faced the minimum, allowing just one hit that was immediately canceled out on a double play. All told, France struck out six and generated nine swings and misses, throwing 60 pitches, 40 of them for strikes. It's the third time France has been recognized as the PCL Pitcher of the Week.

**ROSTER MOVES:** INF Rolando Espinosa promoted to Sugar Land from Fayetteville. RHP Misael Tamarez placed on the 7-Day IL retroactive to 4/29.

**HOME GROWN TALENT:** Sugar Land's roster has 13 players drafted by the Astros, four international signings and two players signed as non-drafted free agents in the five-round 2020 MLB Draft.

**PROSPECTING:** The Space Cowboys boast seven of the Astros Top 30 Prospects according to MLB Pipeline, even after an adjustment following C Yainer Diaz graduating from prospect status. They include C Korey Lee (#5), OF Pedro León (#6), OF Justin Dirden (#7), RHP Misael Tamarez (#11), INF Joe Perez (#14), RHP Forrest Whitley (#19), RHP Shawn Dubin (#23)

**YOUR FAVORITE UNCLE:** Astros' OF Michael Brantley began a rehab assignment with the Space Cowboys on Sunday afternoon. Brantley is returning from right-shoulder surgery in August.

**404 - PAGE NOT FOUND:** On Thursday and Friday night, the Space Cowboys committed 7 total errors, 4 on Thursday night and 3 on Friday night. Prior to that, in their first 22 games, Sugar Land had committed just 9 errors, the fewest in the Pacific Coast League and tied for the third fewest in Minor League Baseball.

**THREE TD'S AND A FIELD GOAL:** Sugar Land allowed 24 runs on Thursday night against the Reno Aces, the most runs allowed in a single game in Space Cowboys franchise history. The previous high was 16 runs given up May 25, 2022 in a 16-8 loss to El Paso at Southwest University Park. Offensively, Sugar Land has scored 24 runs in a game once their time as the Triple-A affiliate of the Astros, topping El Paso 24-15 on June 20, 2021.

**MADRIS MAGIC:** Bligh Madris is currently on a 16-game on-base streak for Sugar Land (.276/.417, 16-58, 14 BB), the longest of the year for any Space Cowboys' player. His on-base streak is tied for the fifth longest streak in the Pacific Coast League this season (Michael Stefanic - 24)

**GOT 'EM!:** C Korey Lee threw out Ali Sanchez in the second inning on Friday night. Lee has now registered 8 caught stealing in 21 total attempts. His 8 caught stealing are the most in the Pacific Coast League. So far this season, Lee has three of the four highest velocity throws among Triple-A and Major League catchers, with a max throw of 90.8 mph, the fastest throw of any catcher in 2023. In 2022 with Sugar Land, Lee was tied for fifth in the Pacific Coast League in caught stealing, throwing out 17 of 62 attempted base stealers (27.4%)

**GRAE ALL DAY:** Grae Kessinger continues to get on base at a great clip for the Space Cowboys, reaching in 19 of his first 24 games with Sugar Land while recording hits in 13 of 24 contests. The former second-round pick out of Ole Miss has worked 19 walks this year, tied for the sixth most in the Pacific Coast League, and leads Sugar Land with a .417 on-base percentage

**HARD CONTACT:** So far this season, there have been nine batted balls over 110 mph by Space Cowboys hitters. Pedro León has accounted for four of them, including the hardest hit ball on 4/16 @ OKC, a 113.7 mph double. Coincidentally, just two of the 110 mph+ hits has gone for a home run (Korey Lee, 110.2 mph on 4/1 @ ELP & Michael Sandle, 100.3 mph on 4/29 @ RNO)

**BIG HIT WANTED:** Through their first 20 games, the Space Cowboys hit .193 (34-176) with runners in scoring position, the lowest mark in the Pacific Coast League. In their six-game series against Las Vegas, Sugar Land went 8-for-44 (.182) with runners in scoring position. During their first two games against Reno, Sugar Land went 11-for-28 (.393) with runners in scoring position, but have gone 6-for-32 (.188) in the three games since.

**SUGAR LAND TO THE SHOW:** The Astros Opening Day roster featured 10 players that spent time in Sugar Land in 2021 and 2022, including reigning ALCS and World Series MVP Jeremy Peña, RHP Bryan Abreu, RHP Ronel Blanco, RHP Hunter Brown, RHP Seth Martinez, C Yainer Diaz, C Cesar Salazar, INF David Hensley, OF Corey Julks and OF Jake Meyers

**SOME PEOPLE CALL THEM:** Opening Day of 2022 was the first-ever game for the Astros' Triple-A affiliate under the Sugar Land Space Cowboys brand. The Astros re-branded their Triple A affiliate on Jan. 29, 2022, following the purchase of the Sugar Land franchise in 2021. Sugar Land had played under the "Skeeters" brand for the first 10 years of its existence. They spent 2012-20 as members of the independent Atlantic League and rose to the Triple-A level for the 2021 season.

**WHERE TO FIND US:** Once again in 2023, all 150 Space Cowboys games can be heard on ESPN 92.5 FM (Gow Media). An audio streaming link is also available at slspacecowboys.com. All Space Cowboys games can be seen on MiLB.TV. Garrett Greene begins his first year as the 'Voice of the Space Cowboys' and will be on the call for all game, home and away. He'll be joined by longtime Houston area broadcaster Gerald Sanchez for home games.

**NOW HERE'S A STOREY:** Mickey Storey returns for his fourth season as the manager of the Astros' Triple-A affiliate and his third with Sugar Land. Storey joined the Astros organization as a coach in 2016 and has managed with Single-A Quad Cities (2018) and Triple-A Round Rock (2019), along with two seasons in Sugar Land. Storey appeared in nine seasons at the professional level as a right-handed pitcher, including stints at the Major League level with the Astros (2012) and Blue Jay (2013). He appeared in four collegiate seasons at Florida Atlantic and was selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 31st round of the 2008 MLB Draft.

**THAT FRAME WAS ON FIRE:** The Space Cowboys set a franchise record by scoring 17 runs in the sixth inning of the second game on August 19, 2022 against the Oklahoma City Dodgers. It was the most runs scored in an inning in Space Cowboys history and the 21 runs scored in the contest are the third highest in franchise history, trailing only a 24-run effort on June 10, 2021, in El Paso & 23 runs on August 23, 2022 in Las Vegas. Here are more details regarding the historic inning:

- Per Minor League Baseball, the 17 runs scored were the most scored in a single inning since they officially archived stats with Stat Search since 2005. The only other Minor League Baseball team to score more runs in an inning were the Dominican Summer League Yankees, who did so on two occasions (7/27/2017, 7/19/2019)
- The inning featured 108 total pitches and lasted 58 minutes. Korey Lee, Alex De Goti, Scott Manea, David Hensley and Yainer Diaz each made five plate appearances in the inning.
- Yainer Diaz experienced all three "True Outcomes" in the inning, homering, walking and striking out through his three plate appearances.
- Per MLB.com, the Minor League Baseball record for runs scored in an inning is 18, set by the Waco Cubs vs. the Beaumont Exporters in 1930.
- The Space Cowboys collected a franchise record 10 hits in the inning, while also drawing a franchise record nine walks in the single frame. A total of 23 players came to bat in the inning, with eight of the nine players in the lineup reaching twice in the inning.

**TO INFINITY AND BEYOND:** Key elements of the Space Cowboys brand include the Mission Patch, Horizon Gradient and Primary Space Cowboys Logo.

- **Primary Logo:** The primary logo features the Space Cowboy donning a traditional cowboy hat, a bandanna and a blast shield over his face that is peppered with space dust and has a starburst at the eye.
- **Horizon Gradient:** Inspired by a shot of the horizon of the earth from space, the color palette and gradient feature light blue, navy, orange, gray and black notes that are prominent in the franchise's logo and uniforms. The colors represent the ever-expanding Sugar Land community and an exciting new chapter on the horizon.
- **Mission Patch:** This patch will be featured on all three uniforms and serves as an alternate logo. It intertwines elements from the Texas state flag, with a rocket superimposed over the front ready to launch.

**READY TO RIDE:** The Space Cowboys brand pays respect to elements that are key to the identity of Greater Houston. The NASA Johnson Space Center is located in Houston and the Cowboys element is a nod to the rugged, Western roots that are embedded in Houston as Texas' largest city.

**A LITTLE ABOUT US:** Through its first nine seasons, Sugar Land played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. They won the Atlantic League Championship in '16 and '18 and appeared in the postseason in five of nine seasons. Sugar Land still holds Atlantic League single-season records for wins (95) and winning percentage (.679) from its '13 season. Sugar Land was managed by former Major Leaguers Gary Gaetti (2012-17) and Pete Incaviglia (2018-20). As an independent team, Sugar Land went 601-502. Notable people to appear for Sugar Land include: LHP Scott Kazmir, RHP Roger Clemens, IF Rafael Palmeiro, Tracy McGrady, IF James Loney, C Derek Norris, OF Willy Taveras and RHP Felipe Paulino.

**REST OF THE CREW:** Joining manager Mickey Storey on the Space Cowboys coaching staff are pitching coach Erick Abreu, hitting coach Aaron Westlake and development coach Wladimir Sutil. Abreu returns for his third season in Sugar Land as the pitching coach for the Astros' Triple-A affiliate. He's previously worked as the pitching coach for Astros affiliates at the Single A, Short-Season, Appalachian League, Gulf Coast League and Dominican Summer League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014. Westlake spent 2022 as the hitting coach in Double-A Corpus Christi and worked as a development coach for the Florida Gulf Coast League Astros in 2021. Sutil enters his second season on the Space Cowboys staff after serving as the manager for the Astros' Florida Complex League team in 2021. He's worked as a manager for Astros affiliates at the Short-Season and Gulf Coast League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Spun 3.2 innings and allowed just one run on Tuesday night, picking up the win against Reno. Murray struck out five.

**AGAINST RENO:** Today will be Murray's second appearance of his career against the Aces.

**STARTING ON THE RIGHT FOOT:** Murray made his Space Cowboys debut on April 1 at El Paso, delivering 5.0 innings of one-run relief out of the bullpen, as Sugar Land topped El Paso 7-3.

**IN SPRING:** Made three appearances, one start, in Major League Spring Training as a non-roster invitee with the Astros. In 8.0 innings, did not allow a run and gave up just two hits with two walks and five strikeouts.

**IMMACULATE DEBUT:** The righty made his Triple-A debut while still with the Tampa Bay Rays organization in 2022, pitching one outing for the Durham Bulls on July 15 against the Gwinnett Stripers. In the second inning, Murray struck out the side and tossed an immaculate inning.

**TO THE 'STROS:** Acquired by Houston in a trade from the Tampa Bay Rays on August 1 as part of a three-team trade. Houston acquired Murray from Tampa and 1B Trey Mancini from Baltimore, while sending OF Jose Siri to Tampa Bay and RHP Chayne McDermott to Baltimore.

**WITH TAMPA:** Was originally selected in the 23rd round of the 2019 draft by the Tampa Bay Rays.... Was named the High-A East Pitcher of the Month in June and the Double-A South Pitcher of the Month in August in 2021 while with Bowling Green and Montgomery respectively... Led Minor League Pitchers in 2021 in WHIP (0.71) and had the third best ERA (2.16) among starters with at least 90.0 IP... Was also third among Rays' Minor League pitchers in wins and tied for eighth in strikeouts (96).

**QUALITAY:** In 2021, did not allow more than three earned runs in any of his 20 starts. Also walked more than two batters once, when he walked three on July 21 vs. Pensacola.

**COLLEGE:** Pitched collegiately at Dixie State University, which has since changed their name to Utah Tech... While at Dixie State, he set the single-season school record for strikeouts (92) & strikeouts per nine (9.93) during his senior year in 2019.

**BACK IN THE SADDLE:** On Opening Night, Hansen started for the Space Cowboys and went 3.1 innings... It was his first appearance since August 5, 2021 at Round Rock... The righty missed the entire 2022 season while recovering from Tommy John Surgery

**AGAINST RENO:** Hansen is making his second career appearance against Reno.

**IN SPRING:** Appeared three times for the Astros in Spring Training in West Palm, all three in relief... Went 0-0, 4.76 ERA, allowing three runs in 5.2 innings pitched with four walks and five strikeouts... All three of his outings were over 1.0 IP (1.2, 1.1, 2.2)... In his final outing of Spring Training, spun 2.2 scoreless innings, giving up two hits and two walks while striking out two.

**DOUBLE DIGITS:** Hansen recorded his two 10+ strikeouts in a game during the 2019 season... The first came in his first start of 2019 when Hansen struck out a career-best 11 batters in 5.0 scoreless innings on April 9... He then struck out 10 hitters on May 6, 2019 @ Lansing, giving up just one hit and two walks across a career-best 7.0 frames.

**HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR:** The righty was named a New-York Penn League Midseason All-Star in 2018 before earning a Midwest League Midseason All-Star nod in 2019.

**VALLEYCATS STRIKE:** Hansen had an impressive professional debut with the then Class-A Short Season Tri-City ValleyCats, posting a 1.76 ERA with 45 strikeouts in 14 appearances, all but two in relief, spanning 30.2 innings.

**TO THE 'STROS:** Drafted in the 8th round of the 2018 draft by the Astros out of the University of Oklahoma.
