Bush On The Mend: Rehabbing Milwaukee reliever Matt Bush tossed another 0.2 scoreless frames last night, walking one and fanning one in the sixth inning. The 37-year-old has not allowed an earned run (one unearned) in 5.0 innings over six rehab outings with Nashville. He's issued four walks and struck out six. Opponents are batting .063 (1-for-16) against Bush.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville currently has four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 7 prospect, right-handed pitcher Abner Uribe is the No. 9 prospect and left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. $\bar{1}1$ prospect.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 637-550 record during an eight-season span.

LAST OUTING: Pannone pitched strongly on June 14 vs. Gwinnett, spinning 5.0 scoreless frames. He allowed just two hits and walked one. Pannone punched out three, throwing just 72 pitches for 45 strikes. The southpaw picked up his second win of the season in Nashville's 6-3 victory.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Pannone's first career appearance against Norfolk.
