FIRST PLACE FREDDIES: After slugging their way to a fourth victory out of five games played this week last night, the FredNats are now in first place by one game in the Carolina League North. They've won this series and the total season series with the Fayetteville Woodpeckers, Single-A affiliate of the Houston Astros. The two West Palm Beach facility neighbors are now 4.0 games apart in the standings heading into play tonight. RHP Luke Johnson gets the start for FBG, aiming to bounce back from a recent rough stretch in which he has allowed nine earned runs over his last two starts.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** Fredericksburg got its third grand slam of the series from Angel Feliz in the second inning, and never looked back en route to a 9-5 win over the Woodpeckers on Friday night. The two teams combined for 19 walks in the game. Feliz also set a single-game season high for any FredNat with six RBI. Brenner Cox had an RBI double and drove in two runs, and Eli Willits was on base three more times in his second professional game. Liam Sullivan pitched very well, earning the win in five scoreless innings with six strikeouts.

**SLUGGIN' GUS:** On this current two-week home stand, the FredNat offense has been the best in the Carolina League. Since the start of the home stand on August 12, Fredericksburg leads the Carolina League in runs (75), hits (97), home runs (8), total bases (143) and team OPS (.781). The FredNats are also 21-for-22 stealing bases on this home stand. The team has seven hitters hitting over .300 during this stretch, led by Kevin Bazzell at .407.

**WOWED BY WILLITS:** 17-year-old Eli Willits - the number one overall pick in the 2025 MLB Draft - made his professional debut Thursday night, and in his first two games is 4-for-6 with two RBI, two walks, a stolen base and several stellar defensive plays at shortstop. Willits, Washington's No. 1 prospect and the 18th best in all of baseball, won't turn 18 until December. He became the youngest FredNat ever, the youngest player in the Carolina League this season, and is currently the second youngest active player in full-season Minor League Baseball. Andrew Salas of the Jupiter Hammerheads is four months younger than Willits. Willits comes from a baseball family, his father Reggie played six seasons in the Major Leagues and is currently the Associate Head Coach at the University of Oklahoma, where his older brother Jaxon is the starting shortshop.

INSTANT IMPACT: The members of Washington's draft class that are already with Fredericksburg have had exceptional starts to their professional careers. 2nd rounder Ethan Petry (South Carolina) has played nine games with Fredericksburg, and is 15-for-41 (.366) with a home run, two doubles, a triple, six RBI and eight walks for an OPS of 1.006. 15th rounder Jacob Walsh (Oregon) hit his first professional home run Wednesday night, and 14th rounder Nick Hollifield (UAB) has been a clutch force with the bat for the FredNats. On this home stand alone, Hollifield has five game-tying RBIs in the 6th inning or later, plus a walk-off single on Sunday. Hollifield is 8-for-15 with runners in scoring position to begin his FredNat career, driving in runs in five out of his last six games.

**START EARLY, HOLD ON LATE:** The FredNats are 58-55 overall this season, but are 19 games over .500 (34-15) when scoring first in 2025. In the first two innings this season, Fredericksburg has been outscored 90-118 (-28). Fredericksburg has also been exceptional at holding on to late-game leads this year. The team is 42-1 when leading after seven innings, and 35-1 when leading after eight.

WHY TRY IT?: Fredericksburg's MiLB-leading caught stealing total is up to 88, eight ahead of Fayetteville, who is second in the category. Heading into play today, Kevin Bazzell leads MiLB by five with 56 caught stealings and owns the best CS% of all MiLB catchers who have played at least 400 innings this year, throwing out 40% of would-be base stealers. 16 of the caught stealings this season have come against the Woodpeckers.

THE STAFF: After Jake Lowery's third season as Manager of the FredNats ended in a Carolina League championship in 2024, the FredNats welcome Billy McMillon as the third Manager in Fredericksburg franchise history. McMillon, 53, has spent the last three seasons in the Nationals organization as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. He also played parts of six seasons in the Major Leagues with Oakland, Detroit, Philadelphia and Florida. He's joined on the staff by returning Pitching Coach Justin Lord, returning Hitting Coach Mike Habas, Development Coach Luis Ordaz, returning Athletic Trainer Jacob Meyer, Strength & Conditioning Coach Mike Reiskind, and Performance Analyst Samantha Unger.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024, defeating the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers two games to one to win the title at Virginia Credit Union Stadium.

**LUKE WARM:** Lucas Emanuel Johnson...promoted to Fredericksburg for the second time this season on 7/23. The Nationals selected Johnson in the 10th round of the 2024 MLB Draft out of the University of Maryland, Baltimore County (UMBC).

**LAST TIME OUT:** For the second start, Johnson struggled to finish the fifth inning after getting the first two outs. After setting down the first two Salem batters, the next four reached and Johnson was chased from the game. He got a no decision, allowing nine hits and six earned runs in 4.2 innings.

**PALM BALL:** In two long stints, Johnson excelled in the Florida Complex League to begin his professional career this year. The righty made 14 appearances and two starts, posting a 1.23 ERA across 36.2 IP. He allowed only five earned runs, tallying 36 strikeouts to just 14 walks. He won the FCL's Pitcher of the Week award at the end of May.

**GOLDEN RETRIEVER:** Johnson pitched four seasons for the UMBC Retrievers, completing his career as UMBC's all-time program leader in strikeouts. He won the America East Pitcher of the Year award twice, becoming the only player in the award's 34-year history to win it outright twice. He posted a career 4.61 ERA in 288.2 IP with 279 K's. As a Junior in 2023, he had an ERA of 2.96 in just under 80 innings. His selection marked the first time a Retriever was selected in the MLB Draft since 2016.

# **BILLY MCMILLON - MANAGER**

1st Season | Previously: Development Coach, Triple-A Rochester

McMillon, 53, joined Washington in 2022 and has spent the last three seasons as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. McMillon played parts of six Major League seasons with four different organizations, including the Oakland Athletics (2001-04), Detroit Tigers (2000-01), Philadelphia Phillies (1997), and Florida Marlins (1996-97). The former Clemson Tiger was a three-time International League All-Star and the 1996 IL Rookie of the Year with Charlotte, earning him induction into the IL Hall of Fame in 2019 and Charlotte's Round Table of Honor in 2022. McMillon was initially selected in the eighth round of the 1993 MLB Draft by Florida. He replaces Jake Lowery, who managed the FredNats the last three seasons, culminating in a championship last year. Lowery will manage High-A Wilmington in 2025.

Prior to joining Washington, McMillon coached in the Boston Red Sox organization for over a decade. He managed the Worcester Red Sox (Triple-A) in their inaugural season in 2021 after managing Boston's former Triple-A affiliate Pawtucket in 2019. He was set to lead the PawSox again in 2020 before the cancellation of the MiLB season. Prior to managing at the Triple-A level, McMillon was the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for Boston from 2016-18 after managing for six seasons in the organization with Double-A Portland (2014-15), High-A Salem (2012-13), and Single-A Greenville (2010-11). His coaching career began in 2008 when he was Greenville's Hitting Coach.



#### JUSTIN LORD - PITCHING COACH

3rd Season | Previously: Pitching Coach, Double-A Harrisburg

Lord, 45, returns to Fredericksburg for a third season in 2025 after leading the FredNats' championship pitching staff last season, including the 2024 Carolina League Pitcher of the Year Travis Sykora.

This is Lord's fifth total season coaching in the Washington organization after a six-year professional playing career and several seasons coaching in the Baltimore system. The Alabama native and Florida State alum was scheduled to be the Fredericksburg Pitching Coach in the canceled 2020 season, and was the Pitching Coach for one season in Double-A Harrisburg prior to joining the FredNats in 2023.



#### MIKE HABAS - HITTING COACH

Habas, 34, returns to Fredericksburg from the 2024 championship staff for his second season with Washington after leading the FredNat offense to a highly successful season, finishing in the top third of the league in virtually every meaningful offensive category.

Prior to joining the Nationals, he spent spending the previous four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization, most recently as the Hitting Coach for the ACL Brewers in 2022 and 2023. Prior to joining Milwaukee, he was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats. While coaching with Gary, he was also the Head Coach at Prairie State College, a Junior College in the Chicago area.



#### LUIS ORDAZ - DEVELOPMENT COACH

Ordaz, 49, joins the FredNat coaching staff in the Development Coach role after managing the Florida Complex League Nationals in 2024.

He played parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues, appearing in 206 career games with the St. Louis Cardinals, Kansas City Royals and Tampa Bay Devil Rays. Ordaz has coached in the Washington organization for over a decade, and was the Hitting Coach for the Potomac Nationals for four seasons from 2016-19. He replaces Carmelo Jaime, who will manage the FCL Nationals in 2025 after three seasons in Fredericksburg.
