DOUBLE DIP: The Sounds will play their sixth doubleheader of the 2025 season and second against the RailRiders. The Sounds swept the doubleheader at First Horizon Park on May 21 with a 3-0 and 2-1 win. The Sounds are 8-2 in doubleheaders so far this year and 3-1 in road twin bills. RHP Chad Patrick will make his fourth Triple-A start of the season in game one while RHP Tobias Myers will make his first Triple-A start since working a six-inning scoreless quality start on July 4 on the road in Memphis before being named International League pitcher of the Week. Myers has worked two scoreless relief appearances for the Brewers since, working 3.0 IP with a hit allowed and four strikeouts July 23 on the road in Seattle and on July 25 against the Marlins.

FIVE AWAY: Tuesday night's series opening win over the RailRiders places Sounds' manager Rick Sweet five wins shy from passing Buddy Bailey for the third-most managerial wins in Minor League history. Sweet owns a career record of 2,413-2,213 for his career and he is already the Sounds all-time winningest manager.

BEEN AWHILE: The last 1-0 shutout loss suffered by the Sounds prior to Wednesday night came back on June 4, 2021, on the road in Charlotte. On that day, the Sounds were held to just two hits - a double by Weston Wilson and a single by Luke Maile. The Knights were held to four hits (all singles) on seven strong innings from Aaron Ashby (2 H, R, 11 K, BB) and two hits allowed by Quintin Torres-Costa, who struck out the side in the bottom of the eighth. Nashville had gone 645 regular season games between 1-0 shutout losses.

MAMBA MENTALITY: Tyler Black extended his hitting streak to a team-best nine games and pushed his on-base streak to 14 games with a two-out single in the top of the ninth inning Wednesday night against the RailRiders. His nine-game hitting streak is tied for the third-longest of the season by a Nashville player. He joined Daz Cameron who saw his nine-game streak come to an end last Thursday when the Sounds were shutout against Charlotte. **Since beginning his current hitting streak on June 9, Black is hitting .316 (12-for-38) with a double, triple, two home runs, and has eight RBI.** He also had a three-game stint with the Brewers mixed in there where he went 2-for-6 with a double and RBI in his only Major League action of the season so far. Black's 14-game on-base streak is tied for the seventh-longest of the season for a Nashville player.

KAHLE YOU DIG GIT: Nick Kahle produced the only extra-base hit of the night for Nashville after lacing a double off Brendan Beck in the top of the sixth inning on Wednesday night. Kahle's hitting streak is up to 6 games, second-longest active streak on the team behind Tyler Black (9 G). The six-game streak extends what is already a career-best hitting streak for the catcher who has played in just 17 games on the season. After not getting a hit in his first five games, Kahle has a hit in 10 of his last 12 games and has a hit in five of the eight road games he has played in this year. **Over his last six games, the former fourth-round pick is hitting .350 (7-for-20) with three doubles and a RBI.**

RISPY BUSINESS: The Sounds were 0-for-6 with runners in scoring position on Wednesday night and left all four runners stranded. The Sounds are tied for third in the International League this season, hitting .273 with RISP along with the Charlotte Knights. Lehigh Valley currently leads the circuit hitting .286 with 100 more chances than Nashville after Wednesday's loss. On the flip side, Nashville pitchers combined to hold the RailRiders without a hit in seven opportunities with runners in scoring position to keep the game within striking distance. Opponents are hitting just .234 off Nashville with RISP this year, the third-best mark by a pitching staff in the International League behind Jacksonville (.219) and Durham (.224).

IN PLAY, OUTS: Nashville had just five strikeouts while at the plate on Wednesday night, the 13th time this season with five or fewer strikeouts in a game. It was just the fourth game this year in which the Sounds and their opponents had struck out 9 or fewer times combined in the same game. The Sounds and Gwinnett combined for just six strikeouts on April 30th in Gwinnett when Nashville had four at the plate and just two on the mound.

FAR FAR AWAY: Jorge Alfaro rocketed a go-ahead solo home run in the top of the fifth on Tuesday for his 14th longball of the season, and first home run since his solo blast against the Memphis Redbirds on July 6. Through 13 games in July, Alfaro is hitting .340 (16-for-47) with seven multi-hit performances. After going homerless in June, Alfaro has three homers in July. His 14 home runs are the fifth-most he has had in a single season over his career. The Sounds have been very successful in games that Alfaro has homered in, sporting a 10-3 when he has hit a home run.
