SOMERSET PATRIOTS NOTES

- The Somerset Patriots defeated the Akron RubberDucks in the game four of a six-game series at Canal Park in Akron, Ohio on Friday by a score of 7-6 in 11 innings.
 - \circ $\;$ The Patriots won their first game in extra innings this season.
 - \circ $\;$ Somerset played in the 11 $^{\rm th}$ inning for the first time this season.
 - The Patriots took five separate leads in the game to win their first game of the series.
- **RHP Baron Stuart** (4.2 IP, 2 H, 1 R, 4 BB, 3 K) posted a season high in innings pitched in his fifth start of the season and did not factor into the decision.
- RHP Jordany Ventura (1.2 IP, 3 H, 3 R, 1 ER, 0 BB, 1 K) picked up his first win in his eighth appearance of the season.
- **RHP Harrison Cohen** (0.1 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 1 K) struck out the final batter of the game to earn his second save in his team-leading 12th outing this season.
- **CF Garrett Martin** (2-for-4, 2B, SF, RBI, K) brought in George Lombard Jr. on a sacrifice fly in the first inning and a double in the sixth.
 - Martin's sacrifice fly ended Somerset's 28-inning scoreless streak.
- **2B George Lombard Jr.** (2-for-4, 3 R, RBI, BB) scored his first Double-A run and collected his first Double-A RBI.
 - \circ $\;$ Lombard Jr. picked up his first multi-hit game at Double-A and his eighth this season.
- **3B Alexander Vargas** (2-for-4, 3B, RBI, BB, K) drove in a run on a single in the ninth inning and scored the final run for Somerset on Max Burt's single.
- **SS Max Burt** (1-for-5, 2B, 2 K) extended his hit streak to eight games with a game-winning RBI double in the 11th.
 - \circ $\;$ His eight-game hit streak is tied for the second-longest active streak in the Eastern League.
 - \circ During this hit streak, Burt is 11-for-29 (.379/.424/.483) with 5 R, 6 RBI, and 3 BB.
 - Burt has hits in 10 of his last 11 games of which he is 14-for-39 (.359/.409/.487) with 7 R, 7 RBI, and 4 BB. Nine of those games are with Double-A Somerset, while two of them are with Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre.
- **DH Dylan Jasso** (2-for-5, 2B, RBI, 2 K) picked up his team-leading 10th multi-hit game of the season.
- **LF Tyler Hardman** (1-for-5, 2 K) made his first career appearance in the outfield in his 342nd career game.
