Racing 'Round the Bases... The Bowling Green Hot Rods stole nine bases in Thursday night's 10-3 win over the Hub City Spartanburgers. Bowling Green has swiped 247 bases this season, needing 16 more to break the franchise's single-season team-record. The 2024 Hot Rods team set the record with 262 steals.

Run, Tony, Run!... Infielder Tony Santa Maria logged his 45th stolen base on Thursday. Santa Maria paces the 2026 South Atlantic League, two steals ahead of Rome Emperors infielder John Gil. The 45 swipes marks the fifth-most by a Hot Rods player in a single season.

Ryan's Rampage Rolls On... First baseman Ryan McCoy delivered his fifth multi-home run game this season on Thursday. The 24-year-old has belted 16 home runs and 22 doubles this season. He leads the SAL with a .591 SLG.

K's For Days... Bowling Green pitching racked up 13 strikeouts in Thursday's victory. RHP Trevor Harrison's seven strikeouts was one away from tying his career-high. LHP Jackson Lancaster fanned five to match his career-best. Thursday marked the 20th time that Bowling Green has posted 13 or more strikeouts this season.

Jack Attack... Jack Kartsonas starts for the Hot Rods on Friday. Kartsonas leads qualified Bowling Green pitchers with a 12.47 K/9 in starts this season. The right-hander has punched out 79 batters across 57.0 frames during his 12 starts with the Hot Rods.

Lucky No. 7... Infielder Nicandro Aybar extended his hitting streak to seven games with a single on Wednesday night. The 21-year-old starred in his first series with the Hot Rods, going 11-for-19 (.579 AVG) with five RBI and six runs scored against the Greensboro Grasshoppers.

Salami For Summerhill... Outfielder Brendan Summerhill drilled a grand slam on Wednesday night for his first High-A home run. It marked the seventh grand slam hit by Bowling Green during the 2026 season.
