**YESTERDAY:** The Captains suffered a 4-0 loss in game three of their six-game series at Lansing. After scoring 25 runs over the first two games, the Captains were held scoreless on five hits by Shohei Tomioka (4 IP) and Jack Cushing (5 IP). Cleveland's 2019 first round pick **Daniel Espino** struck out nine Lugnuts over four innings, but surrendered two runs on three hits and three walks to take the loss. Cushing picked up the win for Lansing. The Lugnuts scored on a first-inning RBI single by Jordan Diaz, a fourth-inning sacrifice fly by Cobie Vance, a fifth-inning balk by Captains reliever **Kevin Coulter** and a fifth-inning RBI single by Michael Guldborg.

**RECORD-SETTING NIGHT:** The following records were set on Wednesday night in the Captains' 17-10 win over the Lansing Lugnuts.

- Most HBP (MWL/HAC all-time record): 7 (broke record of 6 - last occurred 6/10/19 by LC hitters vs. LAN)
- Longest 9-inning game (LCC club record): 4:25 (broke record of 4:18 set 5/6/21 at LAN)
- Most runs, game (2021 LCC record): 17 (broke record of 14 set 6/6 vs. DAY)
- Most hits, game (2021 LCC record): 19 (broke record of 17 set 5/13 vs. FW)
- Most LOB, game (2021 LCC record): 16 (broke record of 12 set 6/15 vs. WM)
- Most individual times on base (2021 LCC record): 6, Rocchio (broke Nova's record of 5, set 7/6 at FW)
- Most individual HBP (2021 LCC record): 3, Donovan (broke Valera's record of 2, set 6/23 at GL)
- Most individual runs, game (2021 LCC record): 4, Rocchio (broke record of 3 - last occurred 7/6 at FW)
- Most individual strikeouts, game (2021 LCC record): 5, Holmes (also ties all-time LCC record)

**ROCCHIO REACHES:** **Brayan Rocchio** has reached base 11 of 15 plate appearances in this series. Rocchio has six singles, two doubles, one walk and two hit-by-pitches. He reached base in each of his first 10 plate appearances in the series. Cleveland's #7 prospect has a .733 on-base percentage during the series.

**ROCCHIO ON A ROLL:** **Brayan Rocchio** is on a nine-game hitting streak, during which he has hit .436/.511/.564 (1.075 OPS). Rocchio has five multi-hit games during the streak, including a four-hit game on July 13 at Lansing. In the month of July, Rocchio is hitting .353/.441/.451 (.892 OPS).

**SUPER NOVA:** **Victor Nova** has hit .400/.472/.900 (1.372 OPS) in July with four home runs in nine games. Over the first two months of the season, he hit .179/.295/.241 (.536 OPS) with one home run in 37 games.

**BRENNAN BASHING:** Captains OF **Will Brennan** has led off two games with a home run in the last week. He hit a home run on the first pitch of the game at Fort Wayne on Wednesday, July 7 and homered on the fifth pitch of last night's game at Lansing. Brennan enters today third in the High-A Central League (HAC) with 18 doubles, tied for sixth in batting average (.286), tied for seventh in hits (58), tied for ninth in extra-base hits (23) and tied for ninth in extra-base hits (90).

**HOME COOKIN' TASTES BETTER:** The Captains are 18-6 at home, compared to 14-23 on the road. Captains pitchers have experienced the biggest home/road disparity. Lake County has a 3.01 ERA at Classic Park and a 4.88 ERA on the road.

**HOT LAVA:** **Bryan Lavastida** is riding a 16-game on-base streak. Over the last 16 games (since June 24), Lavastida is hitting .407/.456/.712 (1.168 OPS) with four homers and six doubles. Lavastida has seven multi-hit games during that span, including three three-hit performances.

**PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE:** **George Valera** has increased his walk-rate recently. Valera walked at an 8.9% rate in June, but has walked at a 15.4% rate in July.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Burns held Fort Wayne to just one run on four hits last Friday, but ran a high pitch count (92) due to a career-high four walks and lasted just 4.2 innings as a result. The only run against Burns came in the fourth inning when the TinCaps ran a double steal play, in which Adam Kerner broke for second and Grant Little scored from third when catcher **Bryan Lavastida** threw to second base. Kerner got into a rundown and Little crossed home before Kerner was tagged out to end the inning. Burns stranded three other runners in scoring position that night. The right-hander nearly made it through five innings, but was pulled after allowing a two-out single in the fifth, making him ineligible for the victory in a 3-1 Captains win.

**COLLEGE ACCOLADES:** After a solid freshman campaign, Burns broke through in 2019 and was named a third team All-American by *Perfect Game*. Prior to the 2020 season Burns was Named Preseason All-SEC, Preseason All-America by *Baseball America*, *Collegiate Baseball*, *D1 Baseball* and *Perfect Game*. In just four games in 2020 Burns was off to a hot start striking out 12.9 per nine innings and had a 3-1 record with a 2.42 ERA.

**TEAM USA:** In 2018, Burns was selected to the USA Collegiate National Team. Burns appeared in four games allowing five runs over 7.2 innings. He allowed nine hits, struck out six and walked one. Also on the team were back to back first overall draft picks **Adley Rutschman** (2019) and **Spencer Torkelson** (2020).

**2020 DRAFT:** Cleveland selected Burns in the CBA round (36<sup>th</sup> overall) of the 2020 draft, which was shortened to five rounds. Burns was Cleveland's second selection in the draft, following SS **Carson Tucker** (1<sup>st</sup> Round – 23<sup>rd</sup> overall).

**PREVIOUSLY DRAFTED:** Originally drafted by the New York Yankees in the 37<sup>th</sup> round of the 2017 draft out of Decatur High School (Decatur, AL).

**MR. ALABAMA:** Burns was named Mr. Alabama his senior season of high school. Along with being one of the top pitchers in the state he hit .467 with 16 homers, 10 doubles, four triples and 46 RBI as a senior in High School.

**RECRUITING BATTLE:** A highly sought after recruit in Alabama, Burns originally committed to the University of Alabama but decided to weigh other options when Crimson Tide Head Coach Mitch Gaspard resigned in 2016, eventually committing to Auburn. Burns grew up an Alabama fan and only committed to the Tide's arch-rival Auburn due to Head Coach Butch Thompson's experience developing pitchers. He says he took a lot of heat for committing to Auburn from friends he grew up with.

**STAR MENTORS:** While at Auburn, Burns had a variety of people with great track records to learn from. Auburn Head Coach Butch Thompson has had 16 of his former pitchers make the big leagues including 10 since 2014. He previously worked as the Associate Head Coach and Pitching Coach at Mississippi State. Among the stars coached by Thompson is 2018 number one overall pick Casey Mize. Burns worked closely with Mize at Auburn, and was throwing partners with Mize during his freshman year of 2018. He took over the premier role in the rotation from Mize, operating as the teams Friday night starter in 2019 and 2020. Tim Hudson joined Thompson's staff in 2020 as a volunteer assistant and pitching coach, also getting the chance to mold Burns' game. The former Auburn great and 17 year MLB veteran worked with Burns for a short time in 2020 before the season was shortened but Burns says the two will have a relationship for the rest of his life.

**FUTURE DEVELOPMENT:** Kevin Goldstein of *FanGraphs* says Burns brings "big stuff out of a small package" with good secondary pitches to go with solid velocity (sits 93-94) on his fastball. Eric Longenhagen, also of *FanGraphs*, describes Burns as "an org based bet." Longenhagen sees Burns as someone who's future value mostly revolves around Cleveland's recent ability to develop pitchers. "I've always been a little lower on him due to his middling velocity and projectionless frame, but he executes his secondary stuff very consistently" Longenhagen said. *Baseball America* sites Burns offspeed pitches as potential plus pitches, especially his curveball and slider. Burns earns praise for his dedication, makeup and desire to learn.
