Play Time Ended
Tirso Ornelas put the San Antonio Missions (26-36) on the board with a solo blast in the first inning, giving them a 1-0 lead that lasted until the eighth inning. A two-run error jumped the Frisco RoughRiders (34-26) ahead in the eighth before they erupted for eight runs in the ninth, led by a bases-clearing triple and two homers, to win 10-1 on Toy Story Night.

Getting Away Late
The Missions and RoughRiders through the first five innings are tied at 8-8 this week. From the 6th inning on in games, the Riders have outscored the Missions 23-3.

Feels Right at Home
Tirso Ornelas homered off the scoreboard last night, his 6th of the year. Ornelas now has 24 home runs as a Mission dating back to 2022.

Has Been Great
Josh Mallitz picked up his 2nd win with 3 strikeouts in 2 perfect innings Friday. After beginning the season on the injured list, Mallitz gave up 11 ER in his first two outings of 2026. Since then, the right-hander has been dominant, allowing just 2 ER in 17 IP (1.06ERA) with 18 strikeouts.

Hard to Beat
Andrew Moore struck out 2 more in 2 scoreless innings Thursday. Over his last 13.2 IP, Moore has struck out 30 batters with an .073 opposing average. After allowing 3 hits on April 30, he has allowed 3 hits in 11 outings since.

Run Right to Second
Tirso Ornelas leads the Missions and is third in the Texas League with 16 doubles.

Going the Longest
Jagger Haynes (62.0) and Ian Koenig (60.2) are 1st and 2nd respectively in the Texas League in innings pitched.

His Bat is Back
After a rare rough patch in which he went 7-48 (.145) across 12 games, Carson Tucker ended the week in Wichita on a 4-game hit streak, going 8-18 (.444) with 3 doubles and 3 stolen bases. Tucker (.299) is 6th in the Texas League in batting average.

Better and Better
San Antonio's 245 runs are tied for the fewest in Double-A, and their 43 home runs are the fewest. However, over the last 35 games, they have scored 151 runs (4.31 R/G) and hit 25 home runs. They are 19-16 in that stretch.

Looking to Cash In
The Missions have stranded 462 runners on base, the 4th-most in Double-A, and their .199 AVG with RISP is the worst at the level. Yesterday, the Missions went 0-1 with RISP and stranded 4 runners.

Taking Their Time
San Antonio's 74 stolen bases are the 6th-fewest in Double-A and are 2nd-fewest in the Texas League. However, their 17 times being caught are the 2nd-fewest. The Missions have 3 players with at least 10 stolen bases. Ethan Salas is 12-14 while Carson Tucker and Kai Roberts are perfect, 13-13 and 17-17 respectively.

Give It Another Go
22-year-old Victor Lizarraga starts for San Antonio. Lizarraga is 2-6 with a 6.89 ERA in 12 games (910starts) with 32 walks and 41 strikeouts in 47 innings. On Tuesday, Lizarraga had 5 scoreless innings before allowing 5 runs in the 6th. He ended up going 5.1 innings with 9 hits, 5 runs, 1 walk and 3 strikeouts. He picked up two wins out of the bullpen piggybacking MLB All-Star Lucas Giolito, going 5 scoreless innings on May 5 and winning with 3 innings of 1-run ball on May 10. In the month of May, Lizarraga went 2-2 with a 2.66 ERA allowing just 7 earned runs in 23.2 innings with 8 walks and 21 strikeouts. The righty spent much of the past two seasons with the Missions, going 9-16 in 46 games (44 starts). Last year, Lizarraga went 4-10 with a 6.21 ERA in San Antonio before wrapping up the year with two solid starts at Triple-A El Paso, going five innings both times and allowing just one earned run in each start. Lizarraga was born in San Diego, but grew up in Tijuana, Mexico, and signed with the Padres for \$1 million while just 17-year-old. This will be the 9th time Lizarraga faces Frisco. He is 0-6 with a 9.09 ERA in 8 starts with 14 walks and 30 strikeouts in 31.2 innings.

From the Pacific Northwest
23-year-old Dylan MacLean starts for Frisco. The Portland, Oregon native is 4-0 with a 4.56 ERA in 10 starts with 13 walks and 43 strikeouts in 47.1 innings. Last Sunday against Springfield, MacLean allowed 4 runs on 6 hits with 0 walks and 2 strikeouts. MacLean spent all of 2025 with High-A Hub City, going 4-1 with a 3.34 ERA in 21 games (10 starts) with 15 walks and 65 strikeouts in 72.2 innings. The Texas Rangers drafted MacLean in the 4th round of the 2020 MiLB Draft out of Central Catholic High School in Portland. On May 24 against San Antonio, MacLean allowed 1 run on 5 hits with 1 walk and 2 strikeouts in 6 innings.

San Antonio Missions Coaches

Manager - Chris Tremie

Chris Tremie begins his first season in the San Diego Padres organization and as manager of the San Antonio Missions. He spent 13 seasons as a manager in the Cleveland Guardians organization and the last seven seasons as the minor league field coordinator for the Cincinnati Reds.

“Fans should expect to come out and see a team that’s going to compete on a daily basis,” Tremie said. “It will be a good brand of baseball. We’re going to play the game the right way.”

Tremie debuted as a catcher for the Chicago White Sox in 1995. He later played for the Texas Rangers, Pittsburgh Pirates and Houston Astros across a total of 22 Major League Baseball games. Tremie retired in 2005 as a member of the Round Rock Express, the Astros’ Triple-A affiliate at the time, and began his managing career in 2006 with the Cleveland organization. His time with Cleveland included two years of managing Double-A Akron and six years leading Triple-A Columbus.

The Houston native attended the University of Houston, where he helped lead the Cougars to two 40-win seasons before being drafted by the White Sox in the 39th round of the 1992 MLB Draft. As a minor leaguer in the White Sox organization, Tremie played with NBA legend Michael Jordan on the Double-A Birmingham Barons as Jordan attempted to play professional baseball.

Hitting Coach Eric Del Prado

Eric Del Prado returns for his second season as hitting coach in San Antonio. He previously worked as a hitting coach at the Arizona Complex League (ACL) in 2023 before taking on the hitting coach role with Single-A Lake Elsinore during the 2024 season.

A native of El Segundo, California, Del Prado attended Willamette University and coached for four years at Lewis & Clark College in Oregon.

Pitching Coach Erick Abreu

Erick Abreu, a native of Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic, pitched for nine years in the minor leagues with the New York Yankees and Houston Astros, even making a stop with the Texas League’s Corpus Christi Hooks. Abreu then became a pitching coach in the Astros’ system for nine seasons, spending time in six different levels.

Over the last two seasons, Abreu served as the major league bullpen coach for the Atlanta Braves.

Bench Coach Brian Burres

Brian Burres brings recent leadership acumen from within the Padres organization, working as the manager for Single-A Lake Elsinore in 2025, as a pitching coach at the Arizona Complex League in 2024 and as an assistant coach with High-A Fort Wayne in 2023.

Burres also boasts the most extensive major league playing career on the staff, pitching in over 100 games for the Baltimore Orioles, Toronto Blue Jays and Pittsburgh Pirates across six big-league seasons.

Strength Coach Chandler Craig

Chandler Craig continues for a second season with the Missions after two seasons as strength and conditioning coach with High-A Fort Wayne. This will be his fourth season in the Padres organization.

Craig previously spent two seasons with the Red Sox organization, including time with Single-A Salem. Craig is a native of Lubbock, Texas and graduated from Texas Tech University.

Athletic Trainer Juan Peña

Juan Peña embarks on his second season with the Missions and second with the Padres organization. In 2024, Peña won one of only 14 Minor League Baseball Athletic Trainer of the Year awards for his work with Single-A Lake Elsinore.

Peña worked in the Detroit Tigers organization from 2018-2023, with most of his time spent at the Florida Complex League. He is from Lakeland, Florida, and graduated from East Central University.
