The Beloit Sky Carp completed a five-game sweep of the Nuts, winning both games of a Sunday doubleheader in Wisconsin. The Nuts' overall record fell to 1-10 all-time at ABC Supply Stadium and 2-15 vs. the Sky Carp.

LUG•NOTES

Whitecap (Back) to the Show: Lansing's parent club, the Oakland Athletics, recalled southpaw **Jack O'Loughlin** to the Major Leagues today. The native Australian pitched for the Whitecaps each of the last three seasons, totaling 41 appearances (20 starts) and 109 1/3 innings. This is his first season with the A's; he made his MLB debut on May 26, 2024, becoming the 23,205th all-time Major Leaguer, and has tossed seven scoreless innings in the Majors across three appearances.

A Lugnut Gets More Athletic: 2019 Lansing shortstop **Jordan Groshans**, the Toronto Blue Jays' first-round selection in 2018, was acquired by Oakland via trade from the New York Yankees on Sunday in exchange for infielder J.D. Davis. Groshans was assigned to the Double-A Midland RockHounds.

Team Effort: This is a meeting between the team with the No. 1 batting average in the Midwest League (Lansing, .259) against the team with the lowest batting average in the MWL (West Michigan, .221). The Nuts' offense also ranks 1st in the league in runs (358), total bases (908), doubles (119), triples (28), and OPS (.751), and is tied for 1st in on-base percentage (.350) and ranks 2nd in base hits (586) and slugging percentage (.401).

Streiking: **Euribiel Ángeles** brings a nine-game hitting streak into tonight, tied with **Cam Masterman** and **Luke Mann** for the longest on the team this season. **Brayan Buelvas** enters the series on a 12-game on-base streak, the longest current streak, though it trails Masterman's 18-game streak for longest streak of the season.

Prospecting: Lansing has five MLB Pipeline Top 30 Athletics prospects: pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2), outfielder **Henry Bolte** (No. 10), first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 24), southpaw **Will Johnston** (No. 27) and outfielder **Brayan Buelvas** (No. 29).

Nothing but Goose Eggs: 2022-23 Lugnuts pitcher **Grant Holman** has pitched 28 2/3 scoreless innings between Double-A and Triple-A this season, 19 1/3 with Midland and 9 1/3 innings with Las Vegas, the most scoreless innings for any MiLB pitcher. Holman tossed 2 1/3 scoreless innings last night, fanning two.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2010: Trailing 4-2 to the Dayton Dragons entering the ninth inning, the Lugnuts used RBI singles from Kenny Wilson and Ryan Goins to tie the score. Dayton recaptured the lead at 6-4 in the 11th inning, but this time it was little-used catcher Karim Turkamani who played the hero, dumping a broken-bat game-winning single into left field to cap a three-run rally and set off a jubilant celebration in front of a crowd of 7,916 on the first day of the second half.

2016: Tayler Saucedo had allowed 14 hits and eight runs in five innings in his previous start against West Michigan. He was much better here, needing 109 pitches for a nine-hit, two-walk, complete-game shutout, 6-0, over the Whitecaps at Cooley Law School Stadium.

Minor League Path: Made pro debut in the Arizona Complex League in 2022 with a pair of scoreless innings, moving up to Stockton for two relief appearances by year's end... spent all of 2023 with the Ports, serving as their relief ace (11 saves in 15 chances) and only allowing three home runs in 61 1/3 innings... limited left-handed batters to .198 batting average / .530 OPS; right-handers hit .305 with .753 OPS.

In a Nutshell: Excelled in his Lugnuts debut on May 2 vs. South Bend, becoming the club's 11th different starting pitcher this year and the 939th all-time player to put on the Lansing uniform... replaced the demoted Eduardo Rivera and tossed five scoreless two-hit innings, striking out six Cubs... followed up with eight strikeouts in three hitless innings with his mother in attendance at Great Lakes, May 8... grew up idolizing Max Scherzer... enjoys the great outdoors... notable splits:

- Home: 3.71 ERA, 17 IP, 1.29 WHIP, .258 avg. | Road: 4.91 ERA, 14 2/3 IP, 1.36 WHIP, .241 avg.

Prospecting: Rated the A's No. 27 prospect and No. 12 pitching prospect by MLB Pipeline... grades: fastball 50, slider 45, change-up 55, control 50, overall 40... they write, "With low expectations, Johnston began his first full season of pro ball at age 23 with Single-A Stockton, but he threw so well out of the gate he earned a quick promotion up to High-A Lansing at the end of April... Johnston has shown a better feel for his three-pitch arsenal than some expected given his college numbers. He adds and subtracts from his fastball, throwing it typically in the 89-94 mph range, though he's shown in the past the ability to reach back for a 95 or 96-mph heater on occasion. The pitch has played up a bit because he can pitch north and south with it. His best pitch is now his split-changeup, which flashes plus and can be a true out pitch at times. His low-80s breaking ball can be on the slurve side, but it can be effective."

Stockton Sensation: Opened 2024 with the Class A Ports... made two relief appearances and two starts, facing 46 batters and whiffing 26 of them ... debuted with 4 2/3 hitless innings with eight strikeouts on April 6... followed up with three perfect innings with 7 K on 4/12.
