Jesus Castillo tossed 4.1 scoreless innings and Andy Otero hurled 3.0 scoreless frames to get the win... The Shuckers broke the game open in the sixth with a four-run frame, highlighted by Lutz' three-run homer.

At the Plate: Brice is Nice: Since May 15, Turang is slashing .316/.368/.456, 6 2B, 2 3B, 2 HR, 17 RBI, 17 R, 6-10 SB... He has also hit safely in 22 of his last 25 games and has 11 multi-hit games in his last 22 played.... The Brewers 2018 first-round pick was on an 15 game hitting streak, which was broken on 6/12 by MIS... It tied the longest hitting streak in Shuckers history, and is the longest streak recorded in the AA-South this season

Shy-cle: Both Tristen Lutz and Luis Castro both came a triple shy of the cycle on Thursday night... Lutz went 3-for-6 with four RBI and Castro went 3-for-5 with 2 RBI and 2 runs scored... There has still never been a cycle recorded in Biloxi Shuckers history.

Hitting Henry: Payton Henry recorded three RBI on Tuesday night, going 2-for-5 with a triple and a run scored... It was Henry's 10th multi-hit gameand his fourth multi-RBI game of the year... Henry then went 2-for-4 with a double on Wednesday night... Henry has reached base safely in his last 14 games... In the month of June, Henry is hitting .388 (19-of-49), 3 2B, 3B, 7 RBI, 7 R

Triple, Double: Luis Castro snapped an 0-for-27 streak on Tuesday night, going 3-for-4, HR, RBI, K and followed it up on Thursday night by going 3-for-5, 2B, HR, 2 RBI, 2 R... During Castro's 2019 Cal League Co-MVP season, the first baseman had 15 three-hit games and one four-hit outing.

On the Mound: It's a Small World: Lefty Ethan Small was named the Double-A South Pitcher of the Week on 6/7 after making two appearances against the Biscuits... Over 10.2 innings, Small allowed just three hits and struck out 19 batters, the most by any pitcher during the week in Minor League Baseball... Small set a new career-high with 12 strikeouts on Saturday night against Mississippi, which tied the franchise record for strikeouts in a game (Alec Bettinger and Bowden Francis - '19, Freddy Peralta - '17, Taylor Jungmann - '16).

Otero Comes To Town: Andy Otero turned in another scoreless long relief appearance for the Shuckers on Thursday night, pitching 3.0 innings while picking up his first Double-A win... Since joining the Shuckers on May 20, Otero has made 7 scoreless appearances and pitched at least two innings in each of his last five outings.

Long Ball Blues: Biloxi has allowed 65 home runs this year, the 4th most in all of Minor League Baseball (1st - Las Vegas: 78) and the most in Double-A... Biloxi did not allow a home run on Thursday night, the eighth game this season that they did not allow a homer... In those games, the Shuckers are 6-2.

What's Shuckin: Together Again in the Rocket City: The Biloxi Shuckers return to Huntsville for the first time since May 25, 2015, when the Shuckers defeated the Birmingham Barons 7-2 at Joe Davis Stadium while waiting for the completion of MGM Park as part of their 54 day, 52 game road trip... During that stretch, the Shuckers went 9-6 at Joe Davis... 3-2 vs. BIR, 4-1 vs. JAX, 2-3 vs. MOB

But That Late Rally Tho: Over their last 10 games, the Shuckers have outscored their opponents 18-4 in the eighth and ninth inning.
