The 12 innings tied the longest game of the season for Omaha, which fell to 8-4 in extra-inning games. The Storm Chasers led 3-0 through six innings on a run in the first inning and solo homers from 1B/OF Nick Pratto and 1B/ OF Ryan McBroom, while RHP Brandon Barker threw 6.0 scoreless innings to record his second quality start of the season. Iowa tied the game with two runs in the seventh and one in the eighth. Omaha was held without a hit from McBroom's home run in the sixth inning to the 10th inning, when OF Dairon Blanco recorded a bunt single. lowa scored three runs in the 12th on a bases-loaded double, while Omaha scored two in the bottom of the 12th before stranding the potential tying and winning runs on base.

RECORD-BREAKING RYAN: 1B/OF Ryan McBroom blasted his 31st home run of the season on Friday to break the Storm Chasersera (2011-pres.) record for the most home runs in a single season, previously held by Carlos Peguero (30, 2014). McBroom hit seven home runs in 22 games in May, eight home runs in 25 games in June, three home runs in 23 games in July, seven home runs in 24 games in August, and has hit six home runs in 14 games in September. The 29-year-old has three multi-homer games this season, including a career-best three-homer game on 6/13 @ STP. The Omaha franchise single-season record belongs to Chris Hatcher, who hit 46 home runs in 1998. McBroom's 30+ homer season is the seventh in franchise history, joining Hatcher (46, 1998), Kit Pellow $(35,1999)$, Calvin Pickering $(35,2004)$, Aaron Guiel $(30,2005)$, Craig Brazell $(32,2007)$, and Peguero $(30,2014)$. With 57 home runs between 2019 (26) and 2021 (31), McBroom is tied for second-most in Minor League Baseball over the last two seasons, trailing only Griffin Conine (58). A former 15th-round pick by Toronto in 2015, McBroom was traded to New York (AL) in 2017 before being traded to Kansas City in 2019. Including his 31 home runs this season, McBroom has 133 career home runs in 3000 career minor league at-bats. He has six home runs in 164 career Major League at-bats, all with Kansas City.
I-80 RIVALRY: Omaha and lowa are scheduled to play 41 games in 2021. Through 34 games, the Storm Chasers hold an 18-16 record against the I-Cubs-including a $7-9$ record at Werner Park-batting $.248 / .319 / .475$ with 66 home runs and a 5.20 team ERA during the season series. Omaha holds a 517-485 edge across the 1,002 games played in the history of the two franchises.

HOMER HAPPY: The Storm Chasers lead Triple-A East and Minor League Baseball with 199 home runs, poised to become the first team in Minor League Baseball to hit 200 home runs. C Meibrys Viloria hit the team's 100th home run on $7 / 4$ @ STP. The Chasers are currently on pace to hit 219 home runs in the 130 scheduled games in 2021. While that would not break the franchise single-season record for home runs ( 231 in 141 games in 1999), the 2021 Storm Chasers rate of 1.69 home runs/game would be a franchise record. The Chasers have recorded at least one home run in 93 of 118 games this season, notching a 59-34 record when hitting at least one home run. Omaha has recorded 55 multi-homer games, including five four-homer games, six five-homer games, and one sevenhomer game. Of the team's 633 runs scored this season, $305(48.1 \%)$ have been on home runs.
WUNDERKIND WITT: INF Bobby Witt Jr. enters Friday four stolen bases shy of 30 stolen bases this season, which would give him 30+ doubles, 30+ home runs, and 30+ stolen bases. The only players to record a 30/30/30 season in the last 30 years (since 1990) are Chicago (AL) prospect OF Luis Robert ( 31 2B, 32 HR, 36 SB ) in 2019 and Oakland prospect Grant Desme ( 31 2B, 31 HR, 40 SB) in 2009. The consensus No. 3 prospect in baseball and top prospect in the Kansas City Royals organization, Witt Jr. is batting $.287 / .353 / .611$ with 22 doubles, 16 home runs, 41 RBls, 49 runs, and 12 steals in 53 games with Omaha. On the season, he's batting .291/.362/.589 with 33 doubles, 32 home runs, 92 RBIs, 93 runs, and 26 steals in 114 games. He leads Minor League Baseball in extrabase hits (69), is second in RBIs (92), third in home runs (32), fourth in runs (93), and tied for seventh in total hits (134).
MINOR LEAGUE MASHERS: The Omaha Storm Chasers roster currently includes four of the top nine home run hitters in Minor League Baseball with C MJ Melendez, INF Bobby Witt Jr., 1B/OF Ryan McBroom, and 1B/OF Nick Pratto. Melendez leads all of Minor League Baseball with 37 home runs while Witt Jr. third with 32. McBroom is tied for fourth with 31 and Pratto is tied for seventh with 29. Omaha is the only team in Minor League Baseball with multiple players that have hit 30+ home runs. Should Melendez finish the season with the most home runs in Minor League Baseball, he would become the third Kansas City Royals minor leaguer to win the Joe Baumann Home Run Award, joining Craig Brazell $(39,2007)$ and Mike Moustakas $(36,2010)$.

FOR OMAHA: LHP Jake Kalish makes his 14th start (29th appearance) with Omaha and his fourth start (ninth appearance) against lowa. He threw a season-high 6.2 innings on $9 / 12$ @ STP, allowing two runs on two solo home runs-including a game-tying home run on his final pitch of his outing-while striking out five and walking none. Since joining the Storm Chasers rotation on $7 / 25 \mathrm{vs}$. STP, Kalish has a 4.84 ERA in 44.2 innings across nine starts with 52 strikeouts and 11 walks. In 21.1 innings against lowa, Kalish has a 4.64 ERA. The left-hander has allowed a career-high 27 home runs this season, including at least one home run in eight of his last nine starts.

FOR IOWA: LHP Luis Lugo makes his sixth start with lowa and second against Omaha. He allowed two runs on five hits in 5.0 innings on $9 / 12$ vs. TOL, walking three with zero strikeouts. Against Omaha on $8 / 26$ at Principal Park, Lugo allowed one run on three hits in 5.0 innings while striking out four and walking two in an eventual 3-2 loss.

Struck out 129 in 102.2 innings as a junior in 2018... Was selected by San Diego in the fourth round (111th) overall in the 2018 MLB Draft

Both the Omaha Storm Chasers and lowa Cubs trace their franchise roots back to 1969. While Omaha has always been the Triple-A affiliate of the Kansas City Royals, Iowa was affiliated with Oakland (1969-1972), Chicago (AL)
(1973-1974), Houston (1975), and Chicago (AL) again (19761980) before becoming the Triple-A affiliate of Chicago $(\mathrm{NL})$ in 1981. The I-Cubs affiliation with Chicago (NL) is the second-longest Triple-A affiliation at 41 years, trailing only Omaha's 53 -year relationship with Kansas City.
