LAST TIME OUT

Samuel Basallo homered and drove in 3 RBI for a second consecutive game, including the go-ahead two-run double in the eighth. John Rhodes and Dylan Beavers both drove in two RBI each and Connor Pavolony homered in the victory. Kade Strowd earned the win after two strong shutout innings of relief to seal the Tuesday night win over Frie.

SIZING UP THE SEAWOLVES

The Erie Seawolves suffered their first series loss of the season this past week, dropping three of five to Harrisburg at home. Sunday's finale was postponed due to inclement weather. Entering this series, Erie owns the second lowest ERA (2.56) in the league but has scored the fewest runs in the league (71). The defending Eastern League champion's roster includes five of the Tigers' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline - RHP Jackson Jobe (No. 3), RHP Troy Melton (No. 11), IF Hao-Yu Lee (No. 14), RHP Tyler Mattison (No. 27), and OF/INF Trei Cruz (No. 30).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Jackson Jobe gets the start for Erie today. The Tigers No. 3 prospect is coming off his first scoreless start of the season last week vs Harrisburg after pitching four hitless innings with only one walk and a season-high six strikeouts. The 3rd overall pick in the 2021 Draft out of Heritage Hall HS in Oklahoma is Detroit's top pitching prospect. The 21-year-old is in his first full season with the SeaWolves after pitching one six inning start last year. Jobe threw 64 innings and struck out 84 batters to an 2.81 ERA across three levels (A, A+, AA) last season.

BASALLO HITS BOMBS

After C Samuel Basallo recorded his first multi-homer game of the season and his first multi-homer game in Double-A in Richmond on Sunday, the Orioles No. 2 prospect homered again last night, his fourth of the season. The 19-year-old also drove in three RBI for a second consecutive game. In his last two games, Basallo is 5-for-9 at the plate with three homers, a double, and six

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF **Dylan Beavers** is amongst the Eastern League leaders in batting average and on-base percentage in his second season with the Baysox. The Orioles No. 27 prospect is batting a third-best .329 and has the seventh-best on-base percentage (.415) to go along with fifth-most hits (23) in the league. The 22-year-old recently had his 15-game on base streak come to an end last weekend, which was the longest active on-base streak in the Fastern League at the time.

COUNTRY RHODES

Over his last six games, OF **John Rhodes** has three multi-hit games and three multi-RBI games after going 2-for-4 yesterday with a pair of RBI driven in. The Orioles No. 23 prospect got off to a slow start going 4-for-30 but in his last 10 games, Rhodes is batting .313 (10-for-32) with three doubles, two homers, nine RBI, with nine walks over six strikeouts.

LONG TOSSIN'

RHP Ryan Long gets the start for the Baysox this afternoon. This will be his 10th career start with the Baysox and his fourth this season. The 24-year-old is coming off his first scoreless start at Double A last Thursday at Richmond after going four innings, allowing two hits and two walks with a season-high seven strikeouts in a no decision. Over Long's last two starts, he has given up just one earned run across 8.2 innings pitched. The 24-year-old right-hander was drafted in the 17th round out of Pomona-Pitzer in the '21 Draft, a Division III school in Southern California. Last year, Long pitched for Team Great Britain in the World Baseball Classic and punched out Angels All-Star Mike Trout against Team USA during pool play.

CATCHER IN THE RYE

C Silas Ardoin has been arguably the best defensive catcher in the league, thus far. The 23-yearold has caught a league leading 11 base runners stealing and has allowed only eight stolen bases, tied for the lowest total amongst the top 10 Eastern League catchers. Ardoin has also not committed an error behind the plate nor has he allowed a passed ball. Last season, he caught seven out of 30 base stealers in his first 26 games at Double-A.

The "Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake" are an alternate identity of the Baysox, as a part of Mil.B's "Copa de la Diversión $^{\text{TM}}$ " or "Fun Cup $^{\text{TM}}$ " During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet activation Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stencilized outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince Geroge's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticuthe began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent Itime as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.

CHASE SEBBY

Fundamentals Coach

Sebby joins the Baysox staff as the Fun damentals Coach in 2024. Sebby was the fundamentals coach in Aberdeen last season and was a development coach within the Orioles' organization in 2022. Sebby played collegiately as a catcher at Cypress College and Ball State.
