### SERIES HISTORY (532 GAMES)

Omaha and Nashville played each other regularly from 1985-1997 (American Association) and 1998-2019 (Pacific Coast League).

In the modern PCL (2005-2019), the teams had 16 games scheduled against each other each season, typically 8 in Omaha and 8 in Nashville.

With a move to the International League for both teams, they did not play each other in 2021and again were not scheduled for games in 2022, despite playing in the same division.

The last series Omaha and Nashville played was August 26-29 at Werner Park, with Omaha taking the first two games and Nashville winning the last two.

NASHVILLE, TENN. – Despite leading by four runs in the 2nd inning, Omaha fell in walkoff fashion for the 2nd straight night, losing to Nashville in 10 innings Saturday, 6-5.
Omaha opened the game dramatically in the top of the 1st with four runs, as Nick
Loftin plated Samad Taylor on a Nashville error, then Freddy Fermin cranked a threerun homer to left field in his first game back with the Chasers for an early 4-0 lead.

After the Sounds sent seven to the plate in the bottom of the 1st and tagged Omaha
starter Mike Mayers for a run, the Chasers responded with a run in the 2nd on back
to-back to back doubles from Taylor and Maikel Garcia, for a 5-1 lead.

Mayers only lasted two innings in his 6th start of the year and after throwing 34 pitches
in the 1st, had to labor in the 2nd as he allowed three runs on four hits and a walk, with
62 pitches over two innings of work, charged with four runs on six hits and three walks.

Omaha remained ahead 5-4 for the next several innings, thanks in large part to the
strong relief efforts of Marcelo Martinez and Brooks Kriske ... Martinez threw a
season-high 3.2 innings without allowing a run, before Kriske took over and retired
all four batters he faced for 1.1 perfect innings, standing a trio of inherited runners.

Still leading by a run in the eighth, Collin Snider faced three batters and put two
runners on and handed the ball off to Nick Wittgren ... A sacrifice fly allowed by
Wittgren scored one of Snider's runners to tie the game at 5-5, forcing extra innings
as neither team could score and Wittgren worked a scoreless ninth inning.

Omaha put runners on the corners in the top of the 10th with one out, but ended the
inning with a double play without scoring ... Evan Sisk was tasked with the bottom of
the 10th, but after a groundout moved the placed runner to third base, surrendered

### **ROLLING IN THE DEEP**

A two-inning outing yesterday from Mike Mayers snapped the stretch of 10 straight

A two-inning outing yesterday from Mike Mayers snapped the stretch of 10 straight games where Omaha's starting pitcher has throw at least 5.0 innings, after just two starts of 5.0 IP or more in the first 13 games.

Despite the short outing yesterday, 28.2 innings from Storm Chasers starters since April 18 lead all of Minor League Baseball (next closest: Modesto Nuts, 57.2 IP).

The last 11 games have featured four quality starts, from Mike Mayers (4/18), Jonathan Heasley (4/19), Austin Cox (4/27) and Drew Parrish (4/28).

The last stretch Omaha pitchers had of 10 straight starts of 5.0+ innings pitched was from August 11-21, 2019, a feat that has happened now 7 times in the last 10 years.

Even when they go deep into games, receiving run support has been a challenge for Omaha starters, who are averaging just 2.38 runs of support per game ... when receiving at least 3 runs of support. .. the team is 8-1 when recording at least 10 hits, but 1-14 when getting 10 hits or less ... yesterday's 5 runs of support for Mike Mayers were the 3rd-most in a game this season. Mayers were the 3rd-most in a game this season.

### **LATE GAME LOSERS**

Yesterday's loss marked the third straight game where Nashville scored in the 8th inning, with 8 of their 24 runs (1/3) coming in the 8th inning this series.

Of Omaha's 15 losses so far, 7 could be considered "blown" leads, where they were winning at some point in the game and came around to lose.

Yesterday's four-run lead surrendered in a losing effort was the largest margin of lead given up in a loss this season, topping a pair of three-run leads they had lost earlier this season.

On the flip side, Omaha has four come-from-behind wins, where they came back to win after trailing.

### **COUNT THE ZEROS**

Relief pitchers have thrown 23.0 of Nashville's 46.0 innings this week and held Omaha scoreless in that span, all 13 of the Storm Chasers' runs this week have been scored against Sounds starters.

In the 23.0 scoreless innings, Nashville's bullpen has held Omaha to 10 hits and 7 walks with no runs allowed an 28 strikeouts ... on top of a 0.00 ERA, their relievers have a combined 0.74 WHIP, 135 opponents' batting average and 4.00 K/BB. All 13 runs Omaha has scored this week have come in 23.0 innings off Sounds starters, for a 4.70 ERA, which is very middle-of-the-pack in the Minors this week ... their starters have a 1.13 WHIP and .235 opponents' average though.

### **WELCOME (BACK) TO THE JUNGLE**

After hitting 28 homers in the first 19 games of the season (1.47/game), Omaha has been held to just two home runs this week, both were hit by returning Storm Chasers in their first at-hat back.

Thursday 4/28 was **Nate Eaton**'s first game with the Chasers this season after being optioned to Triple-A and he promptly hit a home run in his first plate appearance, a solo shot in the top of the second ... he has a pair of two-hit games already and is 4-for-12 (333) with Omaha in his three games.

After being optioned back to Omaha, **Freddy Fermin** returned to the lineup

yesterday and hit a three-run homer in his first at-bat back in the top of the first.

# MANAGER: Mike Jirschele • #23

- Mike Jirschele returns for his 15th season as Omaha's manager, his 18th season managing in Minor League Baseball and 32nd season overall with the Royals organization, named to the position of Storm Chasers manager on January 13, 2023, after previously managing Triple-A Omaha from 1995-97 and 2003-13.
- Jirschele served on the Kansas City Royals coaching staff as the Third Base Coach from 2014-19 and won the World Series in 2015. Jirschele most recently served as the bench coach under manager Chris Widger during the 2022 season with the Double-A Northwest Arkansas Naturals. He spent the 2021 season as Widger's bench coach for the High-A Central champion Quad Cities River Bandits and served as Special Assistant to the General Manager in 2020.
- In his second stint as Omaha's manager, over 11 years from 2003 to 2013, he led the team to four division titles, three consecutive trips to the Pacific Coast League Championship Series (2011-2013), two PCL titles (2011, 2013) and the team's first of two Triple-A National Championships in 2013.
- He earned the 2011 Mike Coolbaugh Award for outstanding baseball work ethic, knowledge of the game and skill in mentoring young players on the field and he is a four-time recipient of the Dick Howser Award (1992, 1994, 2005, 2011), recognizing outstanding work in player development within the Royals organization.
- Prior to his time with Omaha and Kansas City, he served as the Royals Minor League Infield Coordinator for four years, from 1998-2002, and he held managerial positions with Wilmington (1994), Rockford (1993) and the Gulf Coast Royals (1992).
- He appeared 999 games in the Minor Leagues across 13 years, between 1977 and 1990, including 22 games with the Omaha Royals between 1988 and 1989.



# PITCHING COACH: Dane Johnson • #59

- p Dane Johnson enters his fourth year in the Royals organization and as the Storm Chasers pitching coach, after joining Kansas City ahead of the 2020 season. 2023 marks his 24th season coaching overall.
- g He previously spent one season in the Miami Marlins organization (2019) as a Pitching Consultant and 19 seasons with the Toronto Blue Jays as a Minor League Pitching Coach from 2000-03, Pitching Coordinator from 2004-14 and Major League Bullpen Coach from 2015-18.
- Prior to entering coaching, spent 15 years as a player, including over 280 games in the Minor Leagues and parts of three seasons in the Majors with the Chicago White Sox (1994), Blue Jays (1996) and Oakland Athletics (1997), also playing two seasons (1990-1991) in the Chinese Professional Baseball League.
- Johnson and his wife, Gina, reside in Palm Harbor, Florida. They have two children: a daughter, Madison (31), and son, Cobi (27).

- **Bijan Rademacher** (bi-ZHON RAH-de-moch-err) joins the Royals as the Omaha Storm Chasers Hitting Coach this year after spending the last two years with the Arizona Diamondbacks as their Minor League Hitting Coordinator (2021) and ACL Hitting Coach (2022).
- Prior to coaching, he spent eight years playing professionally (2012-2019), spanning seven seasons in the Chicago Cubs organization (2012-18) and slashed .280/.361/.402 over 702 career MiLB games, reaching as high as Triple-A. 


