YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost their fourth straight game, falling, 11-7, to the Akron RubberDucks. The Flying Squirrels opened a 4-0 lead in the second with a solo homer by **Brandon Martorano** and a three-run homer by **Will Wilson**. Akron scored three runs in the third inning to close within a run. In the sixth, the RubberDucks put up six runs to open a 9-4 lead. Jonathan Engleman and Mike Rivera hit back-to-back home runs in the seventh to extend Akron's lead to 11-7. In the eighth, Martorano hit a sac fly and **Luis Basabe** hit his first homer as a member of the Flying Squirrels to close the gap to 11-6. Later in the inning, a wild pitch scored **Jacob Heyward** to pull Richmond within four runs.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game series against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. The series is the first of the year between the two teams and the Flying Squirrels' only visit to Canal Park this year. The Flying Squirrels are 16-19 in games against the Southwest Division, including an 8-9 mark in road games. Richmond is 16-16 in games following a loss.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost four straight games after winning 12 of the previous 16. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 5.0 games behind first-place Akron. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked ninth in the league with a .235 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked tied for third in the league with a 3.96 ERA for the season. Since July 2, the Flying Squirrels have gone 12-6 in 22 games. The last two are the first back-to-back losses for Richmond in that stretch.

THE RUBBERDUCKS have won nine of their last 12 games. They are currently in first place in the Southwest Division, 1.0 game ahead of Bowie. Akron's offense is ranked third in the league with a .259 batting average. The pitching staff has the league's second-best ERA at 3.82. The Akron roster includes seven of MLB.com's top-30 Cleveland Indians prospects, including SS Tyler Freeman (No. 2), C Bo Naylor (No. 3), RHP Ethan Hankins (No. 9 - on IL), RHP Carlos Vargas (No. 17 - on IL), LHP Joey Cantillo (No. 21 - on IL), LHP Logan Allen (No. 22) and 2B/OF Richie Palacios (No. 28).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Michael Plassmeyer** makes eighth Richmond start and second of the series against Akron. He faced the RubberDucks on Tuesday and allowed four runs, all in one inning, over 6.0 total innings in a no-decision. After allowing seven runs over 4.2 innings in his Richmond debut on June 15 at Somerset, Plassmeyer has gone 1-2 with a 3.26 ERA (11 ER/30.1 IP) over his last six starts dating back to June 20. Plassmeyer was traded from the Tampa Bay Rays to the San Francisco Giants on June 11 in exchange for right-handed pitcher Matt Wisler. He began the season with Montgomery in the Double-A South. Plassmeyer was originally drafted by the Seattle Mariners in the fourth round in 2018 out of the University of Missouri, but he was traded to Tampa Bay after one professional season. In his first year with the Rays organization in 2019, his first full professional season, Plassmeyer posted a 1.91 overall ERA, which was the third-lowest for a pitcher in Tampa Bay's minor league system in the history of the franchise, trailing only a 1.41 ERA by Blake Snell in 2015 and a 1.77 ERA by Dylan Floro in 2013. **For more on Plassmeyer, see page two.**

FOR AKRON: Left-hander Juan Hillman makes his 14th start and 15th overall appearance of the season. He faced the Flying Squirrels in the series opener on Tuesday, allowing one run on two hits over 4.0 innings. Hillman was selected by Cleveland in the second round (59th overall) in 2015 out of Olympia High School in Orlando, Fla. He was rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 50 prospect in the 2015 draft and the fourth player selected out of Olympia in the top-60 picks in four years. He spent the 2019 season with High-A Lynchburg, going 6-12 with a 3.85 ERA in 25 starts and earning a Carolina League All-Star selection. Hillman is currently ranked sixth in the Double-A Northeast in ERA (3.88), tied for third in wins (6), tied for second in starts (13), third in innings pitched (69.2), seventh in WHIP (1.31) and tied for third in winning percentage (.750).

POWER SURGE: Over the last 17 games since July 6, the Flying Squirrels have hit 27 home runs, which is the most in the Double-A Northeast. **Vince Fernandez** has hit six homers during that stretch. **Heliot Ramos** hit four homers in that span before his promotion to Triple-A. **Diego Rincones** and **Frankie Tostado** have hit three. **Sandro Fabian**, **Will Wilson** and **Brandon Martorano** have two homers. **Andres Angulo**, **Luis Basabe**, **Andy Sugilio**, **David Villar** and **Simon Whiteman** have each hit one homer in that span. For the season, the Flying Squirrels rank tied for sixth in the circuit with 78 home runs. The team is on pace to hit 132 home runs this season in 120 games. The franchise record for the most home runs in a season is 108 in 2013. In 2019, the Flying Squirrels hit 84 homers in 139 games. Fernandez leads the team with 13 home runs this season. In 2019, **Gio Brusa** led the Flying Squirrels with 12 home runs for the season. This year, the team has combined for a .391 slugging percentage, which would be the highest in the franchise's history.

SWINGING FOR THE VINCE: In his last 17 games since June 30, **Vince Fernandez** is batting .351 (20-for-57) with six home runs, three doubles and 17 RBIs. Fernandez is ranked first on the team with 12 homers this season and second with 33 RBIs. Last Wednesday against the Patriots, Fernandez went 4-for-5 with a homer, a double, a walk and five RBIs, capping his performance with a walk-off single in the bottom of the 11th inning. It was the 18th five-RBI performance by a Flying Squirrels hitter in the franchise's history and the second this season. Last Friday, he hit a game-winning, two-run homer in the bottom of the eighth inning to top Somerset, 6-4. He added a solo home run to center on Saturday night.

SIMON SAYS: **Simon Whiteman** is batting .345 (10-for-29) over his last nine games since July 15 with four doubles, one homer and five RBIs. He has led off each of the last three games with a first-inning single. Whiteman leads the team with 12 stolen bases this season, which is tied for fourth in the Double-A Northeast. For the year, Whiteman has picked up a total of 29 steals in 31 attempts, which includes his time with High-A Eugene, where he played 28 games to begin the season.

STRONG WILLED: Over his last seven games, **Will Wilson** is batting .321 (9-for-28) with two homers, two doubles and seven RBIs. He hit .143 (6-for-42) with one extra-base hit, a double, over his first 10 games at Double-A from July 6-16. Wilson hit his first Double-A home run last Saturday against Somerset, added another on Saturday at Akron and has combined to hit 12 home runs this season between Richmond and High-A Eugene.

BREAKING OUT: **David Villar** has hit .307 (38-for-124) with six homers and 15 RBIs over his last 33 games since June 16. He hit .318 (7-for-22) in six games during last week's series against Somerset, picking up four doubles. He is batting .191 (4-for-21) in the current series. For the season, Villar is second on the team with 11 homers and third with 31 RBIs.

GO, DIEGO, GO! **Diego Rincones** hit his first Double-A home run on Saturday against Somerset, a three-run shot in the second inning that tied the game, 3-3, in a 7-3 Flying Squirrels win. He followed with a two-run, go-ahead homer in the bottom of the eighth inning in the series finale against Somerset last Sunday night in an 8-7 win. On Tuesday, he belted a game-tying three-run homer at Akron. Rincones has picked up 11 RBIs in his last eight games dating back to last Wednesday. In his last seven games since July 17, Rincones is batting .333 (7-for-21) with three homers and 10 RBIs.

LEFT ON BASE: In the current four-game losing streak, the Flying Squirrels have hit .054 (2-for-37) with runners in scoring position and have left 39 runners on base. For the year, Richmond has hit .135 (7-for-52) with the bases loaded, which is the lowest mark in all of minor league baseball this season.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Vince Fernandez** is ranked tied for eighth with 13 home runs. **Frankie Tostado** is ranked tied for ninth with 44 hits. **Simon Whiteman** is tied for fourth with 12 stolen bases. **Frank Rubio** and **Joey Marciano** are tied for fourth in the league with 25 games pitched. **RJ Dabovich**, **Norwith Gudino** and **Patrick Ruotolo** are tied for seventh in the circuit with five saves. **Caleb Kilian** is ranked second in ERA (2.14), 10th in innings pitched (59.0), third in BAA (.213), first in WHIP (0.90), first in complete games (2) and shutouts (1).

WINNING WAYS: The Flying Squirrels' 38-33 record is tied for the second-best record in team history through 71 games, even with the 2015 season. The only season with a better start was 2014, when the team went 40-31. Richmond is looking for its first winning season since 2015, when the team went 72-68.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Will Wilson** (10), **Tristan Beck** (13 - on IL), **Sean Hjelle** (14) and **Jose Marte** (30). **Simon Whiteman** is rated by *Baseball America* as being the "Fastest Baserunner" in the Giants system, Hjelle is rated as having the "Best Control" and **Diego Rincones** is rated as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Four players, including Hjelle (11), Wilson (12), Beck (20) and **Caleb Kilian** (30) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
