**PLAYOFF PREVIEW:** Tonight begins the North Division Championship Series between the Brooklyn Cyclones and the Aberdeen IronBirds for a best-of-three series beginning at Maimonides Park. Game Two and Game Three (if necessary) will be held at Aberdeen's Leidos Field at Ripken Stadium in Maryland on Thursday and Friday. Aberdeen won the First Half of the North Division with a 43-23 recording, winning by 7.5 games over Wilmington. Brooklyn won the Second Half of the North Division with a 40-26 record, winning by two games over Hudson Valley. The team that wins the series faces the South Division Champion in a three-game series starting Sunday.

**RECENT PLAYOFF HISTORY:** This season marks Brooklyn's first playoff berth in the South Atlantic League era that began in 2021. Brooklyn won the 2019 New York Penn League Championship in the final year of the league as a Short Season Class A club, clinching the first-ever outright title in the franchise's history. Since 2001, Brooklyn has made the playoffs 11 times, including this year's berth.

**PITCHING & DEFENSE:** Brooklyn ended the regular season having allowed 510 runs, ranking as the second-fewest in Minor League Baseball and the fewest in the South Atlantic League. Only the Minnesota Twins affiliate, the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels of the Low-A Florida State League allowed more (502).

**BEST STRETCH:** Brooklyn ended the season with a 14-4 record in its final 18 games, outscoring opponents 111-51 (+60). Brooklyn's offense averaged 6.2 runs per game and the pitching staff and defense has allowed 2.8 runs per game over the stretch.

**CHAMPIONS AGAIN?:** The 2022 Cyclones have two players from the 2019 NYPL Championship roster, including C **Jose Mena** and INF **Jose Peroza**.

**vs. ABERDEEN:** The Baltimore Orioles affiliate went 43-23 in the first half to win the North Division Title and then 35-31 in the second half. On the current roster, the IronBirds host six of the Orioles Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline, including 2022 Draft picks OF Dylan Beavers (No. 8), 3B Max Wagner (No. 16), and OF Jud Fabian (No. 23). Aberdeen also hosts prospects OF Heston Kjerstad (No. 10) and SS Frederick Bencosme (No. 26).

**JOSE! JOSE! JOSE!** After bottoming out with a .199 batting average on June 29, INF **Jose Peroza** hit an astounding .336 over the final 58 games of the season, raising his batting average from .199 to .271.

**AN 'A' FOR ALEX:** OF **Alex Ramirez** finished his regular season with 140 hits, ranking most among Mets minor leaguers and 18th all of Minor League Baseball, finishing 17 hits behind leader OF **Will Brennan** (Triple-A Columbus -- Cleveland). Ramirez, just 19 years old, played 67 games with St. Lucie, collecting 77 hits with a .284 batting average before his July 4th promotion to Brooklyn where he played 54 games with 63 hits and a .278 batting average. Ramirez also ended his regular season with a Mets MiLB-best 30 doubles and seven triples.

**ELECTRIC FACTORY:** OF **Joe Suozzi** hit a memorable home run on Friday night in Winston-Salem, giving Brooklyn a 1-0 lead en route to a victory that clinched the division. The Long Island native who grew up in Glen Cove and played high school baseball at Chaminde High School in Mineola, is playing for a Mets organization he grew up rooting for.

**LUIS MORENO:** Brooklyn starter RHP **Luis Moreno**, who takes the mound tonight, has posted a Mets-best 2.84 ERA among qualified starters in 2022, pitching with both Low-A St. Lucie and High-A Brooklyn. Moreno finished his regular season second in innings pitched (117.1 IP), third in WHIP (1.19), and fourth in strikeouts (107) despite making just 17 starts.

**QUALITY TIME:** Moreno spun a seven innings for the second-consecutive time, beating Winston-Salem.

**BEST DOWN HERE:** Moreno has a full-season best 2.84 ERA, leading all qualified Mets minor leaguers. The next-best qualified pitcher is Brooklyn RHP Dominic Hamel who has a 3.25 ERA. Moreno also ranks third in WHIP (1.19) and fourth in strikeouts (107).

**PITCHER OF THE WEEK:** Luis Moreno won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the week for his performance at Hudson Valley between July 25-31.

**MORE-K-NO:** Moreno struck out a career-high nine batters at Hudson Valley on July 2 in his first appearance against the Yankees affiliate.

**WELCOME:** Moreno earned the promotion on June 1 coming to Brooklyn with fellow St. Lucie Mets pitcher LHP Nathan Lavender. The promotions from RHP Hunter Parsons and RHP Jordan Yamamoto to Double-A Binghamton made room for two new arms.

**BIG YEAR:** The Dominican righty has made three starts and six relief appearances with Low-A St. Lucie, striking out eight over six innings in relief against the Daytona Tortugas on May 31 before the promotion. Moreno tossed consecutive outings which would qualify as “quality starts.”

**2022:** With St. Lucie, Moreno posted a 3.56 FIP and a 2.68 ERA with a 22% strikeout rate and a 12% walk rate, compiling 40 1/3 innings in the Florida State League.

**ELIMINATING HOMERS:** Moreno’s 2021 season with Low-A St. Lucie featured nine home runs allowed in 73 innings and 21 games, leading to a 6.20 FIP and 5.42 ERA. This season, Moreno allowed just one home run in 40 1/3 innings at the same level.

**JUMP IN:** Moreno signed with the New York Mets in June of 2019 at 20 years old. While young pitchers usually sign with teams at either 16 or 17 years old, Moreno signed and pitched with the DSL Mets1 and DSL Mets2 in 2019.
