**TODAY'S GAMES:** After clinching their first Pacific Coast League Title, the Sugar Land Space Cowboys are in Las Vegas for the one-game Triple-A National Championship against the Omaha Storm Chasers (Kansas City), the winners of the International League.

**ABOUT WEDNESDAY NIGHT:** RHP Miguel Ullola pitched around two men in scoring position to throw a scoreless first... After Jesús Bastidas was hit by a pitch to start the bottom of the first, Pedro León launched a two-run homer to give Sugar Land an early 2-0 lead... Ullola would throw four shutout frames, giving up just two singles... In the third, Trey Cabbage and Cooper Hummel cracked back-to-back solo homers, building a 4-0 lead for Sugar Land... Adrian Del Castillo homered in the sixth and a walk and two singles brought in another run, but RHP Logan VanWey stranded the tying run on base... A sac fly from Cabbage pushed Sugar Land back in front 5-2, and scoreless efforts from RHP Forrest Whitley, RHP Luis Contreras and RHP Wander Suero closed out Sugar Land's championship clincher.

**ROSTER MOVES:** 9/27 - INF Zach Dezenzo recalled by Houston... INF Shay Whitcomb optioned to Sugar Land... 9/24 - RHP Shawn Dubin recalled by Houston... RHP Conner Greene reinstated from the development list... 9/23 - RHP Seth Martinez optioned to Sugar Land... 9/21 - RHP Seth Martinez recalled... 9/19 - RHP Shawn Dubin reinstated from the IL... RHP Conner Greene placed on the development list... 9/17 - RHP Miguel Ullola promoted to Sugar Land... C César Salazar recalled by Houston.

**HOW THE TEAM WAS BUILT:** Sugar Land's active roster has 10 players that were drafted by the Astros, five free agent signings, four players acquired in trades, two non-drafted free agents, three international free agents, one waiver claim and one MiLB Rule 5 Draft Pick.

**PROSPECTING:** With MLB Pipeline's post-draft adjustment, the Space Cowboys roster sports eight of the Astros' Top 30 prospects, including: OF Jacob Melton (#1), INF Brice Matthews (#3), RHP Miguel Ullola (#7), RHP AJ Blubaugh (#9), LHP Colton Gordon (#11), INF Shay Whitcomb (#14), OF Pedro León (#21) and OF Kenedy Corona (#22)... Melton ranks in MLB Pipeline's Top 100 Prospects at #93.

**CHAMPIONSHIP SECURED:** By sweeping the Reno Aces in their best-of-three series, the Space Cowboys clinched their first Pacific Coast League title, winning a championship in their fourth season in the league after joining the affiliated ranks as the Astros' Triple-A affiliate in 2021... As a part of Independent Baseball, the Sugar Land Skeeters were Atlantic League Champions in 2016 and 2018... By winning the PCL, the Space Cowboys are playing in the Triple-A National Championship Game for the first time.

**WANDERED INTO THE HISTORY BOOKS:** RHP Wander Suero racked up 37 saves in 39 opportunities this season in 67 overall appearances, all leading MiLB... After a save on 9/7 to secure a 4-1 win against Oklahoma City, the Space Cowboys closer took sole possession of the PCL single-season saves record at 34, surpassing Chris Hatcher (2013 - New Orleans) and Ryan Speier (2007 - Colorado Springs)... Including the postseason, Suero has converted 30 consecutive saves since May 30.

**CLIMBED HIGH:** After clinching their 93rd win on the last day of the regular season, the Space Cowboys became the first team in the Pacific Coast League to win more than 92 games since the Albuquerque Dukes, who won 94 games in 1981... Sugar Land also won the most games in the regular season in Minor League Baseball, becoming the only team to surpass the 90-win mark in 2024... Their 48 road victories this year were also the most by any team in Minor League Baseball.

**ONE-TWO-THREE PUNCH:** RHP Ryan Gusto, LHP Colton Gordon and RHP AJ Blubaugh dominated the league during the regular season and finished at the top of the leaderboards in PCL pitching, including being top three in ERA (Gusto - 3.70, Blubaugh - 3.83, Gordon - 3.94), top three in BAA (Gordon - .238, Gusto - .242, Blubaugh - .250), top four in WHIP (1st, Gordon - 1.22, 2nd, Gusto - 1.27, 4th, Blubaugh - 1.35), top three in win percentage (1st, Gordon - .800, 2nd, Blubaugh - .750, 3rd, Gusto - .571) and top five in strikeouts (1st Gusto - 141, 3rd, Blubaugh - 128, 5th, Gordon - 124)... The last time a team held the top three spots in ERA in the Pacific Coast League was the 2005 Memphis Redbirds with Kevin Jarvis (3.38), Chris Gissell (3.54) and Anthony Reyes (3.64)

**TALE OF TWO HALVES:** During their run to a First Half PCL Title, Sugar Land sported the best offense in baseball, leading both Major and Minor League Baseball in runs scored (507), averaging 6.7 runs per contest... They also led MiLB in homers, knocking 116 in their first 75 games and had a collective .850 OPS, the highest in full-season MiLB.

In the second half of the season (since 6/25), Sugar Land had the best pitching staff in Triple-A, registering a 3.70 ERA as a staff... They were the only team in Triple-A to record an ERA under 4.00 during the second half of the season (next - Columbus, 4.07)... The Space Cowboys also led Triple-A in batting average against (.222) and saves (26), were tied for the lowest WHIP (1.30 - Scranton W/B) and were fourth in strikeouts (693, most in the PCL)... Overall, the Space Cowboys finished 2024 with the best ERA in the Pacific Coast League, pitching to a 4.41 ERA while allowing the fewest hits (1231) and finishing second in K's (1379).

**COOP GOES CRAZY:** Designated Hitter Cooper Hummel was almost perfect at the plate during the Pacific Coast League Championship Series, going a combined 7-for-9 with two doubles, a home run, two RBI and three runs scored.

**BLAST OFF!:** In the PCL Championship Series, Sugar Land launched five homers in two games and hit .338 (23-for-68) as a team, outscoring Reno 19-4... Trey Cabbage homered in both games for Sugar Land, with Jacob Melton going deep in Game 1 and Pedro León and Cooper Hummel homering in Game 2

**HEY, I'M WALKIN'!:** In the seventh inning on 4/26, the Space Cowboys drew seven walks in a singular frame, their most this season, helping to propel them in a seven-run inning to take the lead against Reno... Also, on 5/29 at Las Vegas, the Space Cowboys drew 15 walks, a single-game franchise record, after previously breaking it on 4/9 in Albuquerque... The Space Cowboys worked 718 walks in 2024, tied for the most in the PCL and the second most in Baseball (Major or Minor League).

**TRIPLE DOUBLE:** In the second inning on 6/20 @ ELP, Blair Henley induced a 5-4-3 double play to get out of the frame... It is the second 5-4-3 triple play Sugar Land has turned in 2024, with both coming at Southwest University Park... They are the first MiLB team to turn multiple triple plays in a season since 2021 (Memphis and Tri-City)... The Space Cowboys other triple play came on 5/3 in the eighth inning against El Paso.

**ON-BASE KING:** Shay Whitcomb put together a 44-game on-base streak from April 7 to June 4, the longest on-base streak in Space Cowboys franchise history and the longest on-base streak in the Pacific Coast League this year.

**GOING BACK-TO-BACK:** The Space Cowboys ran a home run clinic on 5/3 against the Chihuahuas, knocking five long balls out of the park... More notably, they hit back-to-back home runs two different times in the game, one set from Cooper Hummel and Quincy Hamilton in the second inning and the other from César Salazar and Shay Whitcomb in the fourth inning.

**TRIPLE THE FUN:** In the eighth inning on 5/3, after the RHP Dylan Coleman gave up back-to-back walks to put runners on first and second with no outs, Óscar Mercado hit a grounder to Shay Whitcomb, who quickly stepped on third base and passed it to second baseman Jackson Loftin, who lasered it to first baseman David Hensley to complete the first triple play in the 2024 Minor League season.

**SPACE COWBOYS IN THE SHOW:** So far this season, the Space Cowboys have had 13 players called up to the Houston Astros, including 10 players that had their contracts selected (Joey Loperfido, Blair Henley, Wander Suero, Spencer Arrighetti, Joel Kuhnel, Luis Contreras, Bryan King, Pedro León, Zach Dezenzo and Shay Whitcomb)... There have also been 10 players that have made their Major League debut, with RHP Blair Henley debuting on April 8 @ TEX, RHP Spencer Arrighetti debuting on April 10 @ Kansas City, RHP Forrest Whitley making his Major League debut on April 16 vs. Atlanta, OF Joey Loperfido debuting in left field on April 30 vs. Cleveland, LHP Bryan King and RHP Luis Contreras both debuting on June 23, each throwing a scoreless inning, Pedro León debuting on August 3 vs. TB, where he went 1-for-3 with his first MLB hit on a single to left, and Zach Dezenzo on August 6 @ TEX. INF Will Wagner had his contract selected by the Blue Jays and debuted on August 12 @ LAA, going 3-for-4, 2B, RBI, R, and INF Shay Whitcomb made his debut on August 17 in Houston vs. CWS, going 2-for-3, 2B, BB, R.

**HOW SWWWWWEEP IT IS!:** The Space Cowboys clinched their first series sweep in franchise history with six-straight wins against the Salt Lake Bees from June 4-9, their longest win streak this season... In that span, Sugar Land outscored Salt Lake 34-16, and the starters went 3-0 with a 2.51 ERA in 6 starts, giving up just 8 earned runs in 28.2 innings with 25 punchouts.

**ONE-HIT WONDER:** Sugar Land one-hit the Aviators on April 5, hurling their first shutout of 2024 in just their seventh game of the year... It took Sugar Land until September 5, 2023 to throw their first shutout last season (Game 133)... It was the fourth one-hitter thrown in Space Cowboys history.

**WHERE TO FIND US:** All 150 Space Cowboys games can be heard once again be heard on ESPN 92.5 FM (Gow Media). An audio streaming link is also available at slspacecowboys.com. All Space Cowboys games can be seen on MiLB.TV, MLB.TV, the MiLB App and on Bally Live. Garrett Greene returns for his second season as the primary play-by-play broadcaster for Sugar Land and will be on the call for all 150 games. He'll be joined at home and on select road games by Gerald Sanchez, who continues in his fourth season calling games for Sugar Land.

**NOW HERE'S A STOREY:** Mickey Storey returns for his fifth season as the manager of the Astros' Triple-A affiliate and his fourth with Sugar Land, continuing as the only manager in Sugar Land's history since they became affiliated with the Astros. Storey joined the Astros organization as a coach in 2016 and has managed with Single-A Quad Cities (2018) and Triple-A Round Rock (2019), along with three seasons in Sugar Land. Storey appeared in nine seasons at the professional level as a right-handed pitcher, including stints at the Major League level with the Astros (2012) and Blue Jay (2013). He appeared in four collegiate seasons at Florida Atlantic and was selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 31st round of the 2008 MLB Draft.

**REST OF THE CREW:** Joining manager Mickey Storey on the Space Cowboys coaching staff are pitching coach Thomas Whitsett, hitting coach Aaron Westlake and development coach Wladimir Sutil. Whitsett enters his first season as the Space Cowboys pitching coach, replacing Erick Abreu, who joined the Atlanta Braves in 2024 as their bullpen coach. Whitsett was the Astros' Assistant Pitching Coordinator in 2023 and served as the Pitching Coach for Double-A Corpus Christi in 2022. He also worked as a pitching coach for Single-A Fayetteville in 2019 before spending a year out of the Astros organization as the director of player development for pitching at the University of Arizona in 2021. Westlake returns for his second season as Sugar Land's hitting coach and previously was the hitting coach in Double-A Corpus Christi in 2022 and a development coach for the Florida Gulf Coast League Astros in 2021. Sutil enters his third season on the Space Cowboys staff after serving as the manager for the Astros' Florida Complex League team in 2021. He's worked as a manager for Astros affiliates at the Short-Season and Gulf Coast League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014.

**A LITTLE ABOUT US:** Through its first nine seasons, Sugar Land played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. They won the Atlantic League Championship in '16 and '18 and appeared in the postseason in five of nine seasons. Sugar Land still holds Atlantic League single-season records for wins (95) and winning percentage (.679) from its '13 season. Sugar Land was managed by former Major Leaguers Gary Gaetti (2012-17) and Pete Incaviglia (2018-20). As an independent team, Sugar Land went 601-502. Notable people to appear for Sugar Land include: LHP Scott Kazmir, RHP Roger Clemens, IF Rafael Palmeiro, Tracy McGrady, IF James Loney, C Derek Norris, OF Willy Taveras and RHP Felipe Paulino.
