HIGHLIGHTS

BREAKING OUT BLAS: In his first start of the season, Blas Castano threw five shutout innings in Binghamton, allowing only two hits with six strikeouts in a no decision. That was in his second Double-A start. Castano rebounded from his Double-A debut vs. Binghamton on 8/4/22 at TD Bank Ballpark, when he gave up a career-high nine runs on seven hits that included four home runs.

CAN'T STOP, WON'T STOP: Even in a five-inning affair on Saturday night, Patriots third baseman Tyler Hardman ensured that the Patriots have gone each of the first 14 games of the 2023 season with at least one stolen base. Entering the final day of the series, Somerset has now racked up 17 stolen bases in five games this week against New Hampshire. Somerset has at The Patriots have collected 3+ SB in 6 of 14 games this season. Somerset's total of 37 stolen bases rank third in all of Minor League Baseball (Lynchburg, 50; Columbie, 39).

LIVING ON THE EDGE: The last four games in a row between the Patriots and Fisher Cats have been decided by two runs or less. Now, half (7) of Somerset's 14 games played this year have been decided by one run and 10/14 games have been decided by three runs or less (3-7 in those games).

STRANGER THINGS: Entering today, the Patriots have gone four straight games without hitting a home run. The Patriots' 32-inning home run drought is longer than any they endured during the entire 2022 season. The drought began after a three-home run effort in Tuesday's series opener. This season, New Hampshire has allowed just 5 HR in 14 games, the fewest in the Eastern League.

Castano began 2022 in the starting rotation for High-A Hudson Valley, making 15 starts over 16 appearances and going 3-7 with a 3.62 ERA and 74 K compared 26 BB over 79.2 IP. His 79.2 IP led the Renegades at the time of his promotion to Somerset on 8/4/22. Castano started one game for the Patriots, before returning to Hudson Valley for the remainder of the season.

2021

Spent most of 2021 in Single-A Tampa, after beginning the season with a brief stint in the FCL. Combined, Castano went 6-2 with a 4.17 ERA over 45.1 IP.

2019

After three starts in the DSL to begin 2019, when Castano posted a 1.84 ERA over 14.2 IP, he moved to the United States and joined the GCL Yankees West rotation. Castano started 7/11 appearances in the GCL, going 2-5 with a 4.67 ERA.

2018

Castano spent his pro debut season with the DSL Yankees, going 1-5 over 11 appearances that included seven starts with a 5.40 ERA.






