BACK ON THE HOME STEAD: After dropping four straight winnable games in Salem last week, the FredNats return home to the friendly confines of Virginia Credit Union Stadium for the first of 21 meetings this season with the Lynchburg Hillcats, Single-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. Lefty Jake Bennett makes his second rehab start for the FredNats after three innings of one-run ball in his 2025 debut last week in Salem. Bennett, Washington's 17th best prospect according to MLB Pipeline, had Tommy John surgery in August of 2023 and is just ramping back up to get back to Wilmington or potentially Double-A Harrisburg. He faces Lynchburg lefty Rafe Schlesinger, who is a returning Hillcat from last year's Cleveland draft class. Schlesinger made two of his three starts in 2024 here in Fredericksburg, pitching a combined 5.1 innings of four earned run ball with nine strikeouts. Schlesinger is once again slated to start twice this week, he is also the probable starter on Sunday for the Hillcats.

ABOUT LAST GAME: Fredericksburg got an inside-the-park home run from Elijah Nunez and a three-run shot from Nate Ochoa, but could not recover from allowing eight runs in the 6th inning to lose 9-6 in the finale of what ended up being a five-game series with Salem after Saturday's rainout. Davian Garcia pitched well again for Fredericksburg, throwing five innings of four-hit, one earned run ball with five strikeouts and three walks.

THAT WAS UNFORTUNATE: Last week in Salem, the FredNats lost three games in a row in which they had great chances to tie or take the lead in the 9th. In Wednesday's game, Fredericksburg had the tying runs in scoring position in the 9th inning when Moises Gallardo was called out on a pitch clock violation to end the game. On Thursday, the FredNats scored four runs in the 9th inning to cut a 5-0 deficit to 5-4, and then with the tying run at third base and one out, the Freddie's weren't able to get the tying run in. Then in Friday night's game, Fredericksburg had a 2-1 lead in the 9th disappear after a solo homer and then a walk-off single in the 10th.

OFFENSIVE STRUGGLES: The FredNat offense has sputtered the last two weeks. In these last two weeks, the FredNats have the lowest team batting average in the Carolina League (.204) and OPS (.595). On the other side of the ball, the team has the third lowest team ERA in the Carolina League in that time span.

DON'T EVEN TRY IT: The FredNat catching duo of Kevin Bazzell and Nate Rombach have been prolific at throwing out potential base stealers to start the season. Bazzell is throwing out 39.6% of base runners this year which is first in Single-A, and he ranks second in Single-A with 11 caught stealings. Rombach is right behind Bazzell, throwing out 37% of potential base stealers, and he's tied for 10th in Single-A with 10 caught stealings. Fredericksburg's 21 total caught stealings from the catchers ranks third in Single-A behind Charleston and Fayetteville.

THIS BULLPEN, MAN: The FredNat bullpen continues to be a dominant unit for Fredericksburg. After four more innings last night, the bullpen ERA stands at 3.69, which is the second best in the Carolina League and third best in all of Single-A baseball. If you take out bullpen innings from normal starting pitcher Angel Roman, the bullpen ERA is 3.04, which would be the best in Single-A and fourth-best in all of Minor League Baseball. The bullpen did have its worst week of the season last week in Salem, blowing two late game leads.

2024 CHAMPIONS: The 2024 Fredericksburg Nationals won the franchise's sixth total Carolina League championship last September, defeating the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers two games to one to capture the crown. It was the franchise's first since moving to Fredericksburg in 2020, and the first since the Potomac Nationals won the Carolina League in 2014. The FredNats broke the Charleston RiverDogs' run of three titles in a row, and became the first non-Charleston team to win the league since MiLB realigned to its current leagues in 2021.

NEW SKIPPER IN TOWN: After Jake Lowery's third season as Manager of the FredNats ended in a Carolina League championship in 2024, the FredNats welcome Billy McMillon as the third Manager in Fredericksburg franchise history. McMillon, 53, has spent the last three seasons in the Nationals organization as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. Prior to joining the Nationals, he coached for over a decade in the Boston organization, managing at all four full-season levels and also spending three seasons (2016-18) as the organization's base running and outfield coordinator. He also played parts of six seasons in the Major Leagues with Oakland, Detroit, Philadelphia and Florida. He's joined on the staff by returning Pitching Coach Justin Lord, returning Hitting Coach Mike Habas, Development Coach Luis Ordaz, returning Athletic Trainer Jacob Meyer, Strength & Conditioning Coach Mike Reiskind, and Performance Analyst Samantha Unger.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024.

BENNETT'S BACK: William Jacob Bennett makes his return to the FredNats on a rehab assignment, pitching for the first time since 2023. Bennett began his professional career in Fredericksburg back in 2023 as the Opening Day starter, posting a 1.93 ERA in nine starts. He struck out 54 hitters in 42.0 IP before getting a promotion to A+ Wilmington in early June.

RECENT YEARS: After six starts in 2023 at Wilmington, Bennett underwent Tommy John surgery, which sidelined him from for the rest of 2023 and all of the 2024 season. Last week, he made his first minor league appearance since August 30, 2023.

HOT COMMODITY: The Nationals wanted Bennett so badly that they drafted him twice. Washington selected the lefty in the 39th round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Bixby HS in Oklahoma and then took him again in the second round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of the University of Oklahoma. At OU, Bennett posted a 3.69 ERA across 117.0 IP as a junior in 2022, striking out 133 to a miniscule 22 walks. A second-team All-American, he went 10-4 in 20 appearances (19 starts).

GOOD BUDS: Bennett played both high school and college ball with fellow Nationals prospect Cade Cavalli. Cavalli ranks seventh in the Washington organization (MLB Pipeline) and Bennett ranks 17th. Cavalli made his first rehab start in 2025 with the FredNats two weeks ago in Fayetteville, tossing four scoreless, one-hit innings.

BILLY MCMILLON - MANAGER

1st Season | Previously: Development Coach, Triple-A Rochester

McMillon, 53, joined Washington in 2022 and has spent the last three seasons as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. McMillon played parts of six Major League seasons with four different organizations, including the Oakland Athletics (2001-04), Detroit Tigers (2000-01), Philadelphia Phillies (1997), and Florida Marlins (1996-97). The former Clemson Tiger was a three-time International League All-Star and the 1996 IL Rookie of the Year with Charlotte, earning him induction into the IL Hall of Fame in 2019 and Charlotte's Round Table of Honor in 2022. McMillon was initially selected in the eighth round of the 1993 MLB Draft by Florida. He replaces Jake Lowery, who managed the FredNats the last three seasons, culminating in a championship last year. Lowery will manage High-A Wilmington in 2025.

Prior to joining Washington, McMillon coached in the Boston Red Sox organization for over a decade. He managed the Worcester Red Sox (Triple-A) in their inaugural season in 2021 after managing Boston's former Triple-A affiliate Pawtucket in 2019. He was set to lead the PawSox again in 2020 before the cancellation of the MiLB season. Prior to managing at the Triple-A level, McMillon was the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for Boston from 2016-18 after managing for six seasons in the organization with Double-A Portland (2014-15), High-A Salem (2012-13), and Single-A Greenville (2010-11). His coaching career began in 2008 when he was Greenville's Hitting Coach.



JUSTIN LORD - PITCHING COACH

3rd Season | Previously: Pitching Coach, Double-A Harrisburg

Lord, 45, returns to Fredericksburg for a third season in 2025 after leading the FredNats' championship pitching staff last season, including the 2024 Carolina League Pitcher of the Year Travis Sykora.

This is Lord's fifth total season coaching in the Washington organization after a six-year professional playing career and several seasons coaching in the Baltimore system. The Alabama native and Florida State alum was scheduled to be the Fredericksburg Pitching Coach in the canceled 2020 season, and was the Pitching Coach for one season in Double-A Harrisburg prior to joining the FredNats in 2023.



MIKE HABAS - HITTING COACH

2nd Season | Previously: Hitting Coach, ACL Brewers

Habas, 34, returns to Fredericksburg from the 2024 championship staff for his second season with Washington after leading the FredNat offense to a highly successful season, finishing in the top third of the league in virtually every meaningful offensive category.

Prior to joining the Nationals, he spent the previous four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization, most recently as the Hitting Coach for the ACL Brewers in 2022 and 2023. Prior to joining Milwaukee, he was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats. While coaching with Gary, he was also the Head Coach at Prairie State College, a Junior College in the Chicago area.



LUIS ORDAZ - DEVELOPMENT COACH

1st Season | Previously: Manager, FCL Nationals

Ordez, 49, joins the FredNat coaching staff in the Development Coach role after managing the Florida Complex League Nationals in 2024.

He played parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues, appearing in 206 career games with the St. Louis Cardinals, Kansas City Royals and Tampa Bay Devil Rays. Ordez has coached in the Washington organization for over a decade, and was the Hitting Coach for the Potomac Nationals for four seasons from 2016-19. He replaces Carmelo Jaime, who will manage the FCL Nationals in 2025 after three seasons in Fredericksburg.
