SATURDAY: Brett Baty's big day at the plate including his first Binghamton home-run and a career-high 6 RBI capped off the Ponies win in a 14-13 slugfest Saturday night at Mirabito Stadium. Baty hit a two run go ahead double in the bottom of the 7th to put the Ponies up 12-11 before Mark Vientos singled home two more runs to extend the lead to 14-11. The Seawolves would score 2 runs in the 8th to cut the Ponies lead to 14-13 and load the bases in the ninth before Tommy Wilson struck out the final two Erie hitters to earn the save.

BATY'S CAREER DAY: Brett Baty reached base in all five plate appearances last night going 4-4 with 2 doubles, a HR, a walk, three runs scored and 6 RBI. Baty's HR was his first at the AA level and his 8th of the season between Brooklyn (A+) and Binghamton. The six runs driven in were the most in Baty's career and tied with Wagner Lagrange for the most in a single game this season.

LAGRANGE HITTING STREAK CONTINUES: Ponies OF Wagner Lagrange continued his hitting streak going 2-5 with a double and a home-run last night. Lagrange has hit safely in his last nine starts including six multi-hit games during that span.

VIENTOS COMING UP CLUTCH: After breaking a scoreless tie with a long solo shot in the 8th on Friday night, Vientos drove in what would prove to be the winning run on a 2-run single Saturday night in the 7th inning. Vientos is now tied for 6th in the Northeast league with 46 RBI.

THAT'S A FIRST: Last night's 14 runs were the most scored by the Rumble Ponies in a game since April 22nd 2019 when they won 16-3 in Akron. The 27 combined runs were only 4 off the franchise record of 31 runs set on April 11th 2008 when the Ponies defeated the Seawolves 18-13 in Erie.

SLUGFEST: Last night's seven combined home-runs are tied for the most this season and the second time it has happened this series. This series is also the first to feature two grand slams (David Rodriguez on Tuesday night and Dillon Dingler Saturday night) this season.

REMATCH WITH RODRIGUEZ: The Ponies have faced today's Seawolves starting pitcher Elvin Rodriguez in three starts already this season. Rodriguez went 5.1 innings allowing 5 runs striking out six in the Ponies 12-7 loss on Tuesday. The righty is 2-0 with a 4.74 ERA in 15.2 innings against the Ponies this season.

KERRY-ING THE OFFENSE: Seawolves OF Kerry Carpenter continued hitting well against Ponies pitching last night going 2-4 with a double and a HR. Carpenter has hit .349 with 4 HR and 12 RBI in 11 games against the Ponies this season.

COMING UP: Today is the season series finale against Erie. The Rumble Ponies will begin a six-game road trip against the Hartford Yard Goats on Tuesday night at 7:05.
