NEWS AND NOTES		
BETTER CALL SAL: Major League rehabber Sal Frelick went 1-for-2 with a double, two walks, and a hit by pitch to reach base four times on Wednesday night. He has posted a hit in three straight games during his rehab assignment and added his 15th double of the season (14 w/MIL) and the 19th career double with the Sounds (90 G). He has recorded a .273 batting average (3-for-11), a double and three runs in his rehab assignment with Nashville. Frelick has posted a .310 batting average (111-for-358), 28 XBH and 43 RBI in three seasons with Nashville ('22, '23, '26). Among all Brewers' minor leaguers with at least 200 games played since 2021 when Frelick was selected 15th overall by the Brewers, he leads the organization in AVG (.314) and tied for 10th in triples (10). BOJANGLES: Bo Naylor collected two RBI on Wednesday night, going 1-for-5. His 2-RBI night was his first multi-RBI game in six games played with Nashville and his first since July 30 at Toledo with the Columbus Clippers (CLE). Wednesday night was the 104th overall multi-RBI game of his professional career. He has posted a .239 AVG (394-for-1650), added 169 XBH, 270 RBI, and 265 runs across his regular season minor league career. He's played 177 games in Triple-A and owns a .246 AVG (159-for-646) with 38 doubles, four triples, 35 HR, and 123 RBI.	DINGERS & DIGITS: Colton Gordon allowed three home runs in his fifth start of the season for Nashville on Wednesday night. Two of which were hit by Nick Yorke, who has hit all three of his home runs this season for Indianapolis (27 G) over the first two games of the series. It was the second time in the last four games that an opponent has recorded a 2+ HR game against the Sounds along with Ramon Urias on August 8 at Memphis. Gordon retired 12-of-the-next-15 batters he faced after allowing the second home run to Yorke in the top of the third inning, allowing a single, a walk, and seeing a runner reach on one of the two Nashville errors for the game. Wednesday night was the fourth time a Sounds pitcher has allowed 3 home runs in a game this season, and the first time since Lyon Richardson against Charlotte on July 9. The three home runs allowed tied Gordon's single-game career-high. It was the fifth time in his career, and the second this season, including his June 3 start at El Paso. Four of the five 3-HR games Gordon has allowed have now come during his 64 games in Triple-A since 2023. The other was with Houston on August 2, 2025, at Boston. 11 different Nashville pitchers have allowed 2+ HR in a game this season. As a pitching staff, Nashville has allowed the fewest home runs in the International League this season (96). The next closest is Lehigh	Valley (PHI) who has allowed 117. Nashville has the second-fewest home runs allowed in Triple-A this season behind Sacramento (94). Since the start of the 2021 season when Nashville joined the International League, the Sounds have allowed the fewest home runs in all of Triple-A, allowing 765; Oklahoma City ranks second over the same span with 858. WALK ON HOME: The Sounds 6-5 walk-off win against the Indians Tuesday night was the fifth of the season and first since Luis Matos' 2-RBI double in game one of a doubleheader against Jacksonville on July 4. The five walk-off wins are tied for the ninth-most in the International League this season (T-12th in Triple-A). Through 116 games, the Sounds five walk-off wins are tied for the sixth fewest in any season since 2005. The club set a season-high with 13 over the same span in 2023 and have 138 walk-off wins to rank sixth among all Triple-A teams and T-15th across all Minor League Baseball since 2005. Akil Baddoo is the fifth different Sound to record a walk-off hit this season, and Tuesday night marked the fifth walk-off hit of his professional career and second in Triple-A. He also walked off the Indians with a RBI single on August 22, 2021 with the Toledo Mud Hens.
