Dayton is 10-7 against the Black Rhinos this season, 7-4 in Lansing, outscoring their hosts 46-18 in winning four of the first five games of this series. Lefty **Jack Owen** makes his professional debut for the Black Rhinos, and is expected to be followed by a debuting **Kyle Virbitsky**.

Last Night: Dragons 11, Locos 4. Dayton third baseman **Juan Martinez** hit a two-run double in a five-run eighth inning, and then another two-run double in a three-run ninth, as Dayton turned a tight, pitching-contested 3-1 game into a Saturday night rout in front of 7,232 on Latino Night.

On Deck: Following a league-wide off day, Lansing takes to the road to play at Great Lakes from August 17-22 before returning home against West Michigan from August 24-29.

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Black Rhinos' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, Lansing moved up to the High-A Central and the ballclub accepted an invitation to affiliate with the A's, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Royals (1996-98), Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

Lansing Lugnuts at Great Lakes Loons

LUG•NOTES: HEADLINES AND POINTS OF INTEREST

Welcome Aboard: Right-hander **Kyle Virbitsky** and southpaw **Jack Owen** make their Lansing debuts today, becoming the 50th and 51st different Lugnuts to suit up this season and the 854th and 855th Lugnuts all-time. Virbitsky was drafted in the 17th round in July from Penn State University, joining third baseman Brett Harris (7th round, Gonzaga) and shortstop Drew Swift (8th round, Arizona State) as 2021 draft picks on the Lugnuts' roster. Owen was signed as an undrafted free agent in July from Auburn University; he becomes the 17th different starting pitcher for Lansing this season.

First Blood: Dayton has scored first in all five games played in this series.

Versatile Vance: Super utilityman **Cobie Vance** started at a different position in each of the first five games of this series: second base on Tuesday, shortstop on Wednesday, right field on Thursday, third base on Friday, and left field last night.

Trouble With the Longball: Dayton has hit 11 home runs in the first five games of this series. Lansing, on the other hand, has hit two.

Streak Extended: **William Simoneit** went 0-for-4 with an HBP yesterday, extending his on-base streak to 16 games.

Jordan Rules: 21-year-old **Jordan Diaz**, the youngest player on Lansing's roster, went 2-for-4 with a double yesterday and now is tied for third in the High-A Central with 22 doubles, fifth with 34 extra-base hits, and tied for fifth with 138 total bases.

Tough Acton: Reliever **Garrett Acton** pitched a perfect 9th on Thursday night, striking out two Dragons. In his last three outings, batters are 0-for-11 against him with seven strikeouts. Acton has only allowed one run with Lansing after getting called up from Low-A Stockton, a Micah Pries homer on August 3.

2021 Alumni Report: 2021 Lugnuts outfielder **Jake Suddleson** is currently riding a 16-game on-base streak for the Double-A Midland RockHounds, going 2-for-5 last night with two doubles in the Hounds' 7-4 10-inning loss to San Antonio.

All You Need is Glove: **Brett Harris** was named the 2021 West Coast Conference Defensive Player (in addition to being honored as First Team All-Conference, leading the Bulldogs with a .355 average, 1.027 OPS, 52 runs, 70 hits and 18 extra-base hits in 52 games, committing only two errors) and **Drew Swift** was named the Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Year, the first Sun Devil so honored, and received the 2021 ABCA/Rawlings Gold Glove as the nation's top defensive shortstop.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2015: D.J. Davis went 0-for-4 to end his 26-game on-base streak, and the Lugnuts were shut out, 3-0, at Kane County. It was the first time that the Lugnuts had been shut out all year – they were the last team in professional baseball to go without a shutout.

2018: On the very first pitch of the game at West Michigan, Reggie Pruitt hit a fly ball to deep left. Whitecaps left fielder Dylan Rosa leaped to make a spectacular catch, only to lose both his glove and the ball over the wall for a leadoff home run. The Nuts fell, 7-6, however, losing leads of 4-0, 5-1 and 6-4.

Root, Root, Root for the Home Team: July 4th's Lugnuts/Dragons series finale drew a season-high attendance of 10,109. That's higher than the average attendance in MLB for the Baltimore Orioles, Pittsburgh Pirates, Tampa Bay Rays, Miami Marlins and Oakland Athletics. Only nine of the 119 other Minor League teams have drawn a larger crowd to a game this season: Albuquerque, Nashville, Salt Lake, Charlotte, Fresno, Indianapolis, Round Rock, Durham and Las Vegas.

Pitching is an Art... and So is Sculpting: Blake McFarland, who pitched for the 2012 Lansing Lugnuts, is now a professional sculptor who competed on NBC's reality show "Making It," hosted by Nick Offerman and Amy Poehler, but was eliminated in the fifth episode.

Major League Lugnuts: Five former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season - pitcher **Ty Tice** '18 (Toronto, now with Arizona), outfielder **Josh Palacios** '16-'17 (Toronto), pitcher **Taylor Saucedo** '16-'17 (Toronto), pitcher **Conner Greene** '15 (Baltimore) and pitcher **Kirby Sneed** '16-'17 (Toronto). Tice and Palacios made their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: **Carlos Febles** and **Carlos Beltrán** for the Kansas City Royals. Sneed most recently debuted, appearing in relief for the Blue Jays on July 28.

Star of Stars: The 2021 MLB All-Star Game MVP Award was won by 2017 Lugnut **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.**, who went 1-for-3 with two RBIs, including a 468-foot home run, in the American League's 5-2 victory. Fellow 2017 Lugnut **Bo Bichette** came off the bench for the A.L. as reserve shortstop.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Stolen Bases: On June 15, **Max Schuemann** broke **Samad Taylor's** franchise single-game record of four steals in a game (set July 1, 2018) with five stolen bases against the Great Lakes Loons.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Home Runs Allowed: On June 20, **Stevie Emanuels** broke the franchise single game record, tied many times before, of three homers served up in a game, giving up four HRs to the Loons - two apiece by Deacon Liput and Andy Pages.

Record-Setting, Single Game, HBPs: On July 14, Lansing Lugnuts pitchers hit seven Lake County Captains, breaking the franchise single game record, and the second-highest single game HBP total for a team plunked by one pitching staff behind the 1993 Gulf Coast League Braves, who were hit eight times on June 18, 1993.

Representing His Country: 1B/3B **Jordan Diaz** played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach **Don Schulze** was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations **Billy Beane** was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman **Patrick McColl** set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

International Appeal: Seven nations are represented on the Lugnuts' roster: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa (**Anthony Phillips**) and Venezuela (**Javier Godard**).

Finally: Pitchers **Jeff Criswell**, **Stevie Emanuels** and **Shohei Tomioka**, catchers **Jared McDonald**, **Drew Millas** and **William Simoneit**, first baseman **Patrick McColl**, and outfielder **Michael Goldberg** have all made their pro debut this season with the Lugnuts.

So Many Starters: The Nuts have used 16 different starting pitchers this season entering Sunday's game, **Brady Basso**, **Reid Birlingmair**, **Charlie Cerny**, **Jeff Criswell**, **Jack Cushing**, **David Leal**, **Stevie Emanuels**, **Richard Guasch**, **Jorge Juan**, **Rafael Kelly**, **Bryce Nightengale**, **Colin Peluse**, **Leudeny Pineda**, **Seth Shuman**, **Shohei Tomioka** and **Brock Whittlesey**.

Three Nuts Go to Washington: On July 30, catcher **Drew Millas** and pitchers **Richard Guasch** and **Seth Shuman** were traded by the Athletics to the Washington Nationals in exchange for catcher **Yan Gomes** and utilityman **Josh Harrison**.

Turning Pro: Had originally been drafted in the 21st round in 2019 by St. Louis, but turned down the Cardinals' offer in order to return to Auburn... signed as an undrafted free agent with the Athletics following the 2021 draft.

Glory Days: Attended Junipero Serra ("JSerra") Catholic High School in San Juan Capistrano, California... named 2015 Perfect Game Pitcher of the Year and 2015 Perfect Game Underclass National Championship Most Valuable Player... 2016 Second Team Louisville Slugger High School All-American... 2017 West Coast League Pitcher of the Year... 2017 Summer Collegiate Second Team All-American... coming out of high school, was ranked the No. 2 left-handed pitcher in California.

Star-Studded Alumni: Others from JSerra include the 1st overall pick of the 2017 draft, Royce Lewis, as well as former TinCaps catcher Austin Hedges, and star soccer player Trinity Rodman (Dennis Rodman's daughter) of the Washington Spirit, the second overall pick of the 2021 NWSL draft and the youngest player to be drafted in the NWSL.
