NOTES

CLIFFORD CRUSH: Mets No. 4 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 75 overall prospect **Ryan Clifford** crushed a walk-off two-run home run in the ninth inning on Friday night. It marked Clifford's sixth Double-A home run and he tied his career highs and set Double-A career highs with four runs batted in and four runs scored in the contest, while reaching base all five times on a two-run homer, RBI double, two walks, and an RBI hit by pitch. Clifford's walk-off home run marked the third walk-off win for Binghamton this season and its first walk-off home run since Tanner Murphy hit a walk-off two-run shot against Akron on April 29, 2023.

THE MONTH OF CLIFFORD: Ryan Clifford has been on a tear since the calendar turned to June. In 11 games this month, the 20-year-old is slashing .281/.489/.844/1.333 with five home runs, 12 runs batted in, 13 runs scored, and 15 walks with just eight strikeouts. The Mets acquired Clifford from the Houston Astros in the Justin Verlander trade at the deadline last season.

CLIFFORD THE DOUBLE-A DOG: After reaching base five times on Friday night, **Ryan Clifford** has reached base in 15-straight games and in 20 of his last 21 games. Over his 15-game on-base streak, Clifford holds a .475 OBP and 1.220 OPS with five homers, 14 RBIs, and 18 walks. Clifford drew two walks last night and is now tied for the most walks (54) in Minor League Baseball with MLB Pipelines #1 prospect Jackson Holliday. Clifford has drawn a walk in 19 of his 26 games at the Double-A level. In 26 games in Double-A, Clifford has 16 hits, including 13 extra base hits (seven 2B, six HR).

JORDAN'S BRAND: Infielder **Rowdey Jordan** doubled, walked, and scored two runs on Friday night. He extended his hitting streak to six games. Over his six-game hitting streak, Jordan is hitting .364 (8-for-22) with a homer, a double, three runs batted in, six runs scored, three walks, and two stolen bases. Jordan was in the midst of an 0-for-20 stretch in the six games prior to his six-game hitting streak.

JACKSON HITS JACKS: Infielder Jeremiah Jackson belted a go-ahead two-run homer in the sixth inning against Blane Abeyta on Friday night, for his team-leading eighth homer. Jackson also homered against Abeyta in Game One of the 2023 Eastern League Division Series. Jackson is riding a threegame hitting streak and is hitting .333 with a 1.000 OPS, a HR, and 3 RBIs.

LAST TIME DUT: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies beat the Somerset Patriots on a walk-off two-run homer from **Ryan Clifford** in the ninth inning on Friday. The Ponies led five separate times in the victory. **Jeremiah Jackson** and **Nolan McLean** homered in the game. **Brandon Sproat** started and struck out eight batters over 3.2 innings of one-run ball.

COWBDY OHTANI: Mets No. 19 prospect two-way **Nolan McLean** is slated to start on the mound for Binghamton tonight. McLean crushed an opposite-field solo home run as the designated hitter on Friday night, which marked his second Double-A home run. In his last two starts on the mound at Bowie last week, McLean struck out 14 batters and did not issue a walk over 7.2 innings. The Mets drafted him in the third round of the 2023 draft.
