An eight-run first inning and strong relief pitching in the second half of the game combined to propel the Northwest Arkansas Naturals to a 8-6 win over the Wichita Wind Surge on Opening Night at Arvest Ballpark.

- The first eight Naturals of the game all reached base and came around to score, the only runs the team scored all night. The bottom of the first inning opened with a Maikel Garcia walk and Nick Loftin single. Michael Massey singled Garcia in, then he and Loftin came around on a Wichita error that put Sebastian Rivero on first base ... Seuly Matias walked prior to Rivero reaching and after the error, John Rave singled to load the bases. Nate Eaton singled home Matias and with the bases still loaded, Jake Means doubled everyone home, at the time pushing the Naturals lead to 7-0. Means scored on a single from Loftin, his second of the inning to put the Naturals up by eight in the first.
- Asa Lacy started on the mound for Northwest Arkansas, striking out six across four innings in his Double-A debut. The Wind Surge struck Lacy for three runs in the fourth and then reliever Dante Biasi for three more in the fifth, but Biasi kept them off the board over the sixth and seventh to earn the win. **Ándres Sotillet** entered the game in the eighth and pitched two scoreless frames to pick up his first save of the year.
- The Naturals' 8-run first inning was their largest since scoring 10 against Wichita in the 2nd inning on September 9 at Riverfront Stadium.

This Day in Naturals History

The Naturals are 4-7 all-time when playing on April 12

On April 12, 2009, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals edged out the Corpus Christi Hooks, 6-5 in 10 innings at Whataburger Field. Northwest Arkansas homered three times, the first coming from Brian McFall, a threerun shot in the sixth inning. Jeff Howell went 4-for-4 and homered in the top of the ninth inning to tie the game and force extra innings, then Mario Lisson homered in the 10th to give the Naturals the 6-5 lead that held for the final score, as **Greg Holland** pitched a second scoreless inning to earn his first win of the year.

THE CHAMPS ARE HERE!

Of the 28-man roster the Naturals rolled out for the Double-A Central Championship Series in 2021, seven players are on the Naturals' 2022 active roster, with a total of 10 returning players with the Naturals this season.

- Pitchers Yefri Del Rosario, Drew Parrish, Andrés Sotillet, Stephen Woods Jr. and Angel Zerpa were all a part of the championship celebration last year, as was catcher Tyler Cropley and outfielder Seuly Matias.
- Additionally, development list player Holden Capps was on the Naturals' championship Series roster, while development list player Gavin Stupienski and pitcher Alec Marsh both played for the Naturals in 2021.

STAR-STUDDED ROTATION

All five of the Naturals starting pitchers to open the season are consensus top prospects in the Royals' organization, with all five listed in MLB Pipeline's Top-30 rankings for Kansas City.

- LHP Drew Parrish started Friday, April 8th for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 30 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 38.
- LHP Anthony Veneziano started Saturday, April 9th for the Naturals ...
 MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 18 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 21.
- LHP Angel Zerpa started Sunday, April 10th for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 14 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 21.
- LHP Asa Lacy started Tuesday, April 12th for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him No. 72 overall in baseball, No. 4 in the system and the No. 5 left-handed pitching prospect, while Baseball America has him at No. 2 in the Royals' minor league system, the No. 4 left-handed pitching prospect.
- RHP Alec Marsh starts today, Wednesday, April 13th for the Naturals ...
 MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 13 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 11.

FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in *Advanced Rookie* Burlington (2019) and *High-A* Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 19 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 10 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas:
 Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Michael Massey, Jake Means, Drew Parrish, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter, John Rave and Angel Zerpa.

OPPOSITES... ATTRACT?

The first four games of the 2022 season for the Northwest Arkansas Naturals have been... chaotic and paint a fascinating statistical picture.

- A .312 team batting average (34-for-109) is third both in the Texas League and among Double-A teams and ranks fifth in all of Minor League Baseball,.
- On the flip side, the Naturals' pitching staff has an ERA of 9.53 (36 ER in 34.0 IP) and 2.00 WHIP (29 BB + 39 H in 34.0 IP) ... their ERA ranks as the worst in Minor League Baseball, while the WHIP is 4th-worst ... 29 walks issued is the most of any Double-A team, while 24 strikeouts is the fewest of any team in the Minors, 10 less than the next closest Double-A team (San Antonio Missions, 34).

SNIDER DEBUTS AND EARNS THE DUB!

Saturday, right-handed pitcher **Collin Snider** made his Major League debut for the Kansas City Royals, the 111th Naturals alum to reach the Majors.

- Snider is one of 16 former Naturals on the Royals' 28-man Opening Day roster, one of 15 that has made their MLB debut after playing in Northwest Arkansas.
- Snider's first MLB appearance was a high-leverage situation, as he came on to pitch the 10th inning of a game tied 0-0 at Kauffman Stadium against Cleveland. He kept the Guardians off the board, with some defensive help from fellow 2021 Natural and 2022 debutante Bobby Witt Jr. and after the Royals walked it off in the bottom of the 10th for a 1-0 win, Snider was awarded his first MLB win in his debut.
- The full list of former Naturals on the Royals' active roster is: Scott Barlow, Jake Brentz, Dylan Coleman, Hunter Dozier, Cam Gallagher, Jackson Kowar, Nicky Lopez, Whit Merrifield, Adalberto Mondesi, Ryan O'Hearn, Salvador Perez, Brady Singer, Collin Snider, Gabe Speier, Josh Staumont and Bobby Witt Jr. ... note that Barlow pitched in MLB before he played for the Naturals.

FALL LEAGUE PHENOMS

The Kansas City Royals sent nine players to the Arizona Fall League in 2021 to play for the Surprise Saguaros ... of those nine, seven are on the Naturals roster.

- Zach Haake pitched in six games (five starts) and went 1-1 with a 6.61 ERA (12 ER in 16.1 IP) and 14 strikeouts ... Asa Lacy made four starts and went 2-0 with a 2.35 ERA (2 ER in 7.2 IP) and 15 strikeouts ... Alec Marsh made one start and went 1-0 with a 27.00 ERA (4 ER in 1.1 IP) and three strikeouts ... Stephen Woods Jr. pitched in 10 games (one start) and went 0-0 with a 4.67 ERA (9 ER in 17.1 IP) with 17 strikeouts.
- Nate Eaton played in 20 games, hitting .317 (26-for-82) with a .815 OPS and 13 runs batted in, he finished fourth on the team with 38 total bases ... Seuly Matias played in 22 games, hitting .188 (15-for-80) with a .712 OPS, six home runs and 20 runs batted in, both of which were tied for the team lead ... Jake Means played in 19 games, hitting .171 (12-for-70) with a .515 OPS and five runs batted in.

#36 CHRIS WIDGER • Manager

- Chris Widger will manage the Naturals after guiding the River Bandits to a High-A Central championship in their first season as a Kansas City affiliate in 2021. In doing so, he was named the Minor League Manager of the Year by Baseball America following the 2021 season.
- 2022 marks Widger's seventh year in the Royals' organization, as he was slated to manage Advanced-A Wilmington in 2020 and led Burlington to the Appalachian League Championship Series in his first season as Manager in 2019. Prior to that, he was Wilmington's Bench Coach from 2016-18.
- Before joining the Royals organization, he managed the Independent League Camden Riversharks in 2015 and was their Pitching Coach from 2012-14.
- A third-round pick by Seattle in the 1992 Draft, Widger played in parts of 10 seasons in the Majors with the Mariners (1995-96, 2000), Expos (1997-2000), Yankees (2002), Cardinals (2003), White Sox (2005-06) and Orioles (2006), winning a World Series with Chicago in 2005.

- He was the Royals first-round pick in the 2010 MLB Draft, scored the winning run in the 2014 AL Wild Card game and had the game-winning hit in the title-clinching Game 5 of the 2015 World Series.
- After being drafted in 2010, Colón ascended to Northwest Arkansas by 2011 and between 2011, 2012 and 2014, played 202 games for the Naturals ... in 2011, Colón led the Texas League in sacrifices (21), while leading the team in at-bats (491) and hits (126). His 21 sacrifices that season are the most a Naturals player has ever recorded in a single season, while 28 overall are tied for the club record.
- During his playing career, he made stops in Miami (2017) and Cincinnati (2019-20) ... spent 2021 with the Rich Baseball-owned Buffalo Bisons (Triple-A, Toronto) before announcing his retirement.
- He also played in parts of four seasons in the Puerto Rican Winter League.




