LAST OUTING: Woodruff last pitched on May 27 at St. Louis and went 4.0 innings in Milwaukee's 4-2 loss. He allowed two runs on two hits and one walk. He threw 41 of his 61 pitches for strikes and was tagged with his third loss of the season. He left the start early due to a right ankle sprain.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Woodruff has faced Memphis four times in his career, with two of those outings coming at AutoZone Park. The last time he squared off against the Redbirds was June 27, 2018 when he was pitching for Triple-A Colorado Springs.
