LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn opened its 12-game home stand on Tuesday night with a 5-0 victory over Wilmington, good for its second shutout of the season...Two-way player **Nolan McLean** showcased a strong performance on the hill in his third start of the season...The former Oklahoma State Cowboy tossed five two-hit innings, allowing only two hits and a walk while striking out nine...McLean was far from the only Cyclone arm to have success...RHPs **Dakota Hawkins** and **Joey Lancellotti** slammed the door shut, combining for four shutout three-hit frames...C **Drake Osborn** crossed the plate three times, while 1B **Nick Lorusso** logged a career-high tying three hits, including a triple.

YIPPEE KI-YAY: TWP **Nolan McLean** has been a revelation for the Cyclones so far in 2024...The 22-year-old has picked up at least one extra-base hit in all five games he has appeared as a position player and became the first Brooklyn starter to earn a victory in 2024 on Tuesday...At the dish, McLean is 7-for-20 (.350) with six runs scored, four doubles, two home runs, and four RBI...On Saturday, the Willow Springs, N.C. native registered a career-high three hits — including a pair of doubles — and an RBI...Offensively, McLean enters the day tied for sixth in the South Atlantic League with six extra-base knocks, despite at least 23 fewer plate appearances than any of the players tied or ahead of him...On the mound, Nolan is 1-1 with a 4.91 ERA (6 ER in 11.0 IP) with 12 strikeouts in three starts.

LOVE THE DRAKE! C **Drake Osborn** has been unstoppable at the plate to start the 2024 season...On Tuesday, the 25-year-old reached base four times thanks to a single, a double, and a pair of walks...Osborn has reached base safely in all eight games he's played, hitting an eye-popping .458 (11-24) with a 1.289 OPS and adding three doubles, a home run, and three RBI...Among players in the South Atlantic League with at least 30 plate appearances, the Corpus Christi, Texas native leads the circuit in batting average (.458), on-base percentage (.581), slugging percentage (.708), and OPS (1.289).

GLORIOUS LORUSSO: INF **Nick Lorusso** has quietly been one of the top hitters in the South Atlantic League in 2024...The former Maryland Terrapin tied a career-best with three hits in Tuesday's victory, adding a triple and a career-high three RBI...Entering play on Wednesday, Lorusso is fifth in the SAL in slugging percentage (.568), sixth in OPS (.950), tied for sixth in total bases (24), eighth in ISO (.256), and 10th in wRC+ (.167).

TIME TO MAKE THE DONUTS: RHPs **Nolan McLean**, **Dakota Hawkins**, and **Joey Lancellotti** combined on Brooklyn's second shutout of the season, a 5-0 win vs. Wilmington on Tuesday...RHPs **Brandon Sproat**, **Jordany Ventura**, and **Justin Lawson** united on a five-hitter vs. Asheville on April 9...Both of the Cyclones' blankings have been in the first game of their two home series...Entering play on Wednesday, Brooklyn is the only New York Mets affiliate to register multiple shutouts in 2024...The Cyclones set a franchise record with 11 shutouts in 2023.

CANARSIE'S OWN: IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** returns to his native Brooklyn to start a minor league rehab assignment on Tuesday, recovering...The 23-year-old grew up in the Canarsie neighborhood, roughly 10 miles northeast of Maimonides Park...Palmer also attended Holy Cross High School in Flushing, Queens, approximately five miles east of Citi Field...The right-handed swinger has appeared in at least one game with Brooklyn each season since 2021 and enters the day as the franchise's all-time leader in games played (201), runs scored (100), walks (108), stolen bases (49), and hit-by-pitches (17).

CLIFF NOTES: 1B/OF **Ryan Clifford** had his personal and team season-high 12-game on-base streak snapped on Tuesday...The on-base streak stretched since April 9...During that span, Clifford was 11-for-38 (.289) with five extra-base hits — including a home run — four RBI, and 11 walks...While his seven-game hit streak was snapped on Sunday, the 20-year-old also worked a franchise-record-tying four walks in the victory...The feat was also accomplished twice last season by 3B **Jaylen Palmer** (4/7 vJS) and LF **Rhyian Thomas** (8/23 @ASH)...Clifford enters play tied with teammate INF **William Lugo** and two others for second in the South Atlantic League in walks (13).

WALK IT OUT: The Cyclones coaxed a season-high 11 walks in their 5-2 victory over Jersey Shore on Sunday afternoon...The 11 free passes are tied for the third most in a single game in franchise history...Brooklyn earned 12 walks in a 7-4 win vs. Vermont on August 11, 2016, and matched the mark in their 9-8 triumph vs. Jersey Shore in 11 innings on Opening Day, April 7, 2023.

HIT 'EM UP: Brooklyn's offense erupted for a season-best nine runs on 14 hits in Saturday's 9-7 victory over Jersey Shore...The Cyclones' previous high-water marks were six runs and nine hits in Thursday's 6-4 win...Brooklyn's nine tallies were the most for the franchise in a single game since a 13-12 victory at Asheville last August 24...The 14-knock performance was the

vs. WILMINGTON: Brooklyn opens their first two-week homestand of the season against the Nationals' High-A affiliate...The Blue Rocks possess three of Washington's top 30 prospects per Baseball America: OF **Daylen Lile** (11), INF **Kevin Made** (24), and INF **T.J. White** (28)...Wilmington swept a three-game season-opening set against Brooklyn, winning the last two games on walk-offs from OF **Jared McKenzie**...In 30 meetings during the 2023 campaign, Brooklyn posted a 16-14 record against Wilmington, but just a 9-9 record at Maimonides Park...The Cyclones were 7-5 last year against the Blue Rocks at Frawley Stadium...Including 2024, the 'Clones are 43-41 (.512) all-time against the 'Rocks.

Cyclones' best since a 15-hit effort in an 11-9 loss in 10 innings vs. Wilmington on July 25, 2023...That contest was also the last time Brooklyn registered 9+ runs and 14+ hits in the same game.

DE RECORD SETTER: OF **Omar De Los Santos** enters Wednesday's contest 8-for-9 stealing bases to start the season...The eight swipes are tied for fifth in the South Atlantic League...De Los Santos is second on the Cyclones' all-time stolen base list (45)...He is four steals shy of matching IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer's** (49) all-time record...Since the start of 2022, De Los Santos is eighth across the Minors for swipes (115)...He broke INF **Walter Rasquin's** (32) franchise single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023.

GRAB SOME PINE: RHPs **Calvin Ziegler**, **Jordany Ventura**, **Sean Reid-Foley**, **Justin Lawson**, and **Ben Simon** united to punch out 18 Asheville batters in April 14's walk-off victory...RHPs **Calvin Ziegler**, **Josh Hejka**, **Dakota Hawkins**, and **Joshua Cornelli** also combined to strike out 18 Wilmington hitters over 9.2 innings in April 7's loss at Wilmington...The 18 strikeouts by Cyclones pitching are the most for the franchise in a single game since July 23, 2016, vs. Aberdeen...RHP **Justin Dunn** (5), LHP **Kyle Regnault** (2), and RHP **Nabil Crismatt** (11) combined to whiff 18 IronBirds over 9.0 innings in a 7-2 win...The multiple contests with 18+ strikeouts are tied for the most by a Cyclones team since 2005...Brooklyn also accomplished the feat in a pair of extra-inning games in 2016 and two nine-inning games in 2008...The single-game franchise mark for team strikeouts is 22 set in a 20-inning, 3-2 loss vs. Staten Island on June 17, 2016.

KING STANLEY: OF **Stanley Consuegra** is Brooklyn's all-time leader in several categories, including 44 extra-base hits, 29 home runs, and 95 RBI...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C **Francisco Alvarez** for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...Consuegra also surpassed Alvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by **Ronny Mauricio** in 2021.

YOUTH IS SERVED: **Gilbert Gómez** takes over as manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2024...At 32 years of age, the Santo Domingo, D.R. native is the youngest skipper in franchise history...After leading Single-A St. Lucie last summer, Gómez served as manager of Tigres del Licey in the Dominican Winter League (LIDOM)...Became the youngest manager to win a championship in LIDOM history and the second-youngest manager to win a game in Caribbean Series history...Gómez's younger brother, **Dariel**, played at Double-A Binghamton in the Mets' organization last summer and is currently with the Charleston Dirty Birds of the MLB Partner Atlantic League...Older brother, **José**, is a scout for the Tampa Bay Rays and general manager for LIDOM's Leones del Escogido...Older brother, **Héctor**, is a well-known baseball reporter...Gómez also played seven years in New York's farm system, posting a .662 OPS in 537 games.

GENUINE DRAFT: Eight members of last summer's New York Mets' draft class are with the Cyclones early in 2024...Pregent returned to the roster, while second-round selection RHP **Brandon Sproat** and third-round pick two-way player **Nolan McLean** are scheduled to make their High-A debuts...RHP **Noah Hall** (7th), INF **Nick Lorusso** (9th), RHP **Brett Banks** (11th), RHP **Ben Simon** (13th), and RHP **Justin Lawson** (15th) round out the group...RHP **Dakota Hawkins**, who signed as an undrafted free agent, is also with the club.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have four of the Top 30 per BA: **Ryan Clifford** (No. 5), **Brandon Sproat** (11), **Nolan McLean** (15), and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: Clifford (4), Sproat (13), McLean (19), Ziegler (22), and INF **Wilfredo Lara** (23)...MLB Pipeline also considers Clifford the 93rd-best farmhand in all of baseball.

LAST TIME OUT: Picked up a no-decision last Thursday night at Jersey Shore...Yielded only one run on four hits over a career-high five innings...Walked two and punched out a career-high-tying three...Induced a double play...Tossed 64 pitches and 37 strikes (57.8%)...Relieved by RHP **Douglas Orellana** to start the bottom of the sixth with Brooklyn trailing, 1-0...Cyclones would score four in the seventh and two in the eighth to rally and defeat the BlueClaws, 6-4.

PALMETTO POWER: The Charlotte, N.C. native spent two years at the University of South Carolina before joining the pro ranks...Before missing the remainder of the 2023 season with a back injury, Hall collected a 5-1 record with a 3.29 ERA (15 ER in 41.0 IP) and 43 strikeouts in 7 starts for the Gamecocks...The right-hander garnered 121 strikeouts in 117.2 innings over 22 appearances (19 starts) at South Carolina...Described South Carolina as his "dream school since I was a little kid"...Has multiple South Carolina alums on his mom's side of the family and attended their sporting events as early as age 2 or 3.

APP-ETIZER: Prior to spending two seasons at South Carolina, Hall spent the 2020 and 2021 collegiate seasons at Appalachian State University...Serving predominantly as a reliever, the 7th-round pick was named a Freshman All-American in 2021 by Collegiate Baseball...In 28 appearances (5 starts) for the Mountaineers, Hall was 7-1 with a 3.36 ERA (26 ER in 69.2 IP), 4 saves, and 73 strikeouts.

WELCOME TO NEW YORK: Hall was selected by the New York Mets in the 7th round of the 2023 MLB Draft...The right-hander inked his deal with the organization with a \$176,250 signing bonus.

TAKE TWO: Hall was drafted for the second time in 2023 by New York...The Carolina native was the Milwaukee Brewers' 20th-round selection in the 2022 MLB Draft out of South Carolina, but elected not to sign.
