TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER: The Curve hook up for another series with the Akron RubberDucks, who took 4-of-6 games from the Curve in the first full week of the season. Akron is loaded with returners like RHP Aaron Davenport and Tommy Mace in the rotation. INF Travis Bazzana, the No. 1 overall pick in 2024 out of Oregon State, highlights their prospect group. Bazzana was born in Austrailia and made history with Chase Burns (Italy, selected No.2 overall by Cincinnati) as the first pair to be born overseas and selected at the top of the draft.

On the mound, former Florida Gator Tommy Mace matches up with the Curve for a second time this season. Mace walked 5 batters and allowed 1 run in 5.0 innings against the Curve on April 10. Mace faced Altoona six times prior to this season going 3-2 with a 5.34 ERA, walking 13 and striking out 20 in 30.1 innings. Mace was the 69th overall selection by Cleveland in 2021 out of the University of Florida. The Tampa native attended Sunlake High School in Florida and uses a 5-pitch arsenal that includes the addition of a cutter in his final season at Florida.

SCAN THIS BARCODE FOR OUTS: Lefty Hunter Barco has tossed 20.2 consecutive scoreless innings to begin the season, the longest stretch to begin a season sincé Roansy Contreras tossed 18.2 scoreless to begin the 2021 season. The longest scoreless streak in franchise history belongs to lefty Jared Lakind who threw 25.1 scoreless innings during the 2016 season.

Barco was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week for the week of April 21-27 after striking out 16 batters in 7.2 innings across two outings against the Baysox. Mace is one of 3 qualified pitchers in the minors with a 0.00 ERA entering play on Saturday.

JEBBING: Utilityman Mitch Jebb has a reached in 10 straight games, during which he's batted .417 (15-for-36) with 5 BB and 7-7 SB. His .404 on-base percentage this season is 7th in the Eastern League.

SAMMY SLAMS: Outfielder Sammy Siani has reached in 13 straight games, the longest stretch of his Double-A career. Since April 16, he's batting .306/.404/.490 with a .894 OPS, 2 2B, 2 3B, 1 HR, 12 RBI and 7-7 SB.

ENTER SANDMAN: Righty Cam Sanders leads all minor league relievers with 7 saves entering play on Thursday, May 1.
Sanders is the first Curve reliever to pick up 7 saves in a calendar month since Matt Eckelman saved 8 games in June of 2019.
Justin Kaye (June, 2005) and Matt Peterson (June, 2007) hold the record for saves in a month by a Curve pitcher with 9.

ON THE MEND: Infielder Spencer Horwitz made his organizational debut with the Pirates Sunday at Chesapeake, he is 1-for-8 with 2 walks in 10 plate appearances during his rehab.

Horwitz was acquired from the Cleveland Guardians in exchange for RHP Luis Ortiz, LHP Michael Kennedy and LHP Josh Hartle this past off-season and is rehabbing an injured wrist. Horwitz, like Isiah Kiner-Falefa last year, will play for the Curve before he plays for the Pirates. Horwitz made his major league debut in 2023 for Toronto and last season led all qualified MLB rookies with a .357 on-base percentage last season. He recorded a .790 OPS in 97 games for the Blue Jays.

A YOUNG MAN'S GAME: Infielder Termarr Johnson <u>opens as the youngest position player in the Eastern League at 20 years</u> old, just two days younger than Reading's Aidan Miller. Among Double-A players, he is the 7th-youngest player at the level; the youngest is San Antonio's Ethan Salas (SD, 18.8 years old). Johnson has reached base safely in 27-of-36 games with the Curve and has a hit in 16-of-22 games to begin the season. Johnson was 10-for-31 (.323) with a double and pair of solo home runs during his seven-game hitting streak that ended on Tuesday, July 29.

OUT FOR A WALK: Altoona hitters are 4th among all Double-A clubs with 115 walks in 25 games this season.

IT'S ABOUT HOW YOU START: Curve starters tossed 15 scoreless innings to begin the season (Barco, Dotel, Solometo, Chen). Overall, Curve starters held a 1.05 WHIP, 3rd among Double-A staffs and 3.19 ERA, 5th among Double-A clubs through play on May 2.

THE PIRATES ARE THIEVES: Altoona enters play on Saturday, May 3, 3rd among Double-A clubs with 46 stolen bases in 54 tries. Mitch Jebb leads the club with 12 steals, 1st in the Eastern League, T-1st among Double-A players.

WE'LL SEE THEM ALL: For the first time since the 2019 season and the creation of the six-game series, the Curve will face every team in the Eastern League this season. Altoona will face New Hampshire and Bingnamton on the road only, while

Andy Fox Manager (1st Season) Career Record: 45-94

Andy Fox is the 16th manager in Curve history. Fox's coaching ca-reer has seen him serve in several roles, including time with the Rang-ers, Mariners, Marlins, and Red Sox. He spent the last 14 years in Boston's system, serving as the team's infield coordinator and first base coach. Prior to his time in Boston, Fox served as a first base coach for the Marlins and managed the Rangers Single-A Clinton team in 2006. Fox was drafted in the 2nd round of the 1989 Draft by the Yankees and won two World Series in his nineyear Major League career with New York (1996) and the Florida Marlins (2003) as an infielder.

Matt Ford **Pitching Coach** 1st season/12th overall

Ford joins the Curve in 2025 after serving as the Pitching Coach for Low-A Bradenton in 2024. This is his 12th season serving as an in-structor in the Pirates system, pre-viously serving in the FCL (2022), Greensboro (2021), as the team's Rehab Pitching Coordinator (2019-20), Bradenton (2017-18), both West Virginia clubs (2015-2016) as well as with Bristol (2014). Ford was Toronto's third round pick in 1999 and made his Major League debut with the Brewers in 2003. He pitched in 25 games and made four starts in his lone Major League season. He began his coaching career at the University of Akron in 2012.

Scott Seabol Hitting Coach 1st season/10th overall

Seabol comes to Altoona after spending the 2024 season as the Hitting Coach in Bradenton. This is his second season as a Pirates minor league instructor. He joined the Pirates after four seasons as a hitting instructor in the Miami Marlins system (2020-2023) and the New York Yankees (2016-2019). 
