- ✘ **STARLYN WALKS IT OFF:** Saturday, **Starlyn Nunez** blasted a walk-off three-run home run in the bottom of the ninth inning, giving the Yaks their first walk-off win of 2026. Nunez also recorded Salem's previous walk-off hit on August 10, 2025, when he delivered a walk-off single against the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers. The homer snapped a 1,448-day drought since Salem's last walk-off home run, hit by Tyler Miller on May 22, 2022 against the Lynchburg Hillcats.
- ✘ **HAMMERING HEYMAN:** Catcher **Luke Heyman** has been red hot at the dish over his last 13 games. Since April 28, Heyman is 12-for-46 (.261) with five home runs, 14 RBI, 30 total bases and a 1.049 OPS. The 14 RBI since April 28 are the second most in the Carolina League trailing just Handelfry Encarnacion who has 16 RBIs over his last 15 games.
- ✘ **OFFENSIVE TURNAROUND:** Salem was held scoreless through the first 16 innings of the series before breaking through with three runs in the eighth inning of last night's 3-1 victory. Over the first 15 innings, the RidgeYaks went just 7-for-47 (.149) with two walks at the plate. In the last 12 innings of this series however, Salem's offense has come alive, going 15-for-47 (.319) while drawing 12 walks and adding a pair of hit-by-pitch's.
- ✘ **FINLEY FINESSE:** Right-hander **Leighton Finley** has been dealing as of late. The Richmond Hill, Georgia native has gone at least five innings in each of his last three appearances and has allowed just one earned run over 10 innings pitched in May (0.90 ERA). Finley is 2-0 over his last three outings and has struck out 10 batters across his last 15 innings of work.
- ✘ **SERIES OPENERS:** Salem has now won the series opener in five of its seven series this season. The RidgeYaks have outscored opponents 50-23 in their six series openers this season. Three of Salem's eight total double-digit scoring games of the season have come in series openers. In fact, Salem's 45 runs on Tuesday's this season is fourth best in Single-A trailing Fresno (60), Fredericksburg (52), and San Jose (50).
- ✘ **SIT DOWN:** Salem's pitching staff have struck out 373 opposing batters this season which is good for fourth most in the Carolina League behind the Charleston RiverDogs, Hill City Howlers, and Delmarva Shorebirds. In 17 of the last 20 games, Salem pitchers have struck out 10 or more batters, something they've done 24 times this season.
- ✘ **ELECTRIC ILAN:** Over his last six games since May 3, infielder **Ilan Fernandez** has been a beast at the plate. Hitting .389 (7-for-18) including a four hit performance last Sunday at Wilson for the first time in his career, Fernandez has four extra-base hits over his last six games.
- ✘ **ORTIZ ON BASE:** Infielder **D'Angelo Ortiz** snapped a team best 15-game on-base streak two weeks ago. Dating back to last season, Ortiz has successfully reached in 28 of his last 32 games. Since August 29, 2025, Ortiz is 34-for-114 (.298) with a .367 on-base percentage.
- ✘ **MAYERS SHUTDOWN:** Right-hander **Jacob Mayers** have been dealing as of late. The LSU product hasn't allowed a run to score over his last three outings spanning across the last 11.1 innings he has pitched. Mayers has struck out 13 and allowed just four walks and five hits over his last 11.1 innings pitched since April 22. The last run Mayers allowed came on April 15 at Hickory.
- ✘ **OPATA ON THE PATHS:** Outfielder **Andrews Opat** leads the team with 17 stolen bases on the season. The first year player has been thrown out just three times, good for an 85% stolen base percentage. Opat enters play sixth in the Carolina League in stolen bases and ninth in all of Single-A in stolen bases.
- ✘ **RIDGEYAK SPEEDSTERS:** Through the first 36 games of the season, Salem has swiped 70 bases and been thrown out just 21 times (76.9 SB%). For context, after 36 games last season, Salem had just 27 stolen bases.

After being held scoreless through the first 16 innings of the series, Salem has struck for 9 runs in the last 11 innings the last two nights

- ✦ **MUSETT AT FIRST:** Wednesday night, catcher **Andrew Musett** played his first game at first base this season. That start marked the first time since July 18, 2024 that Musett made an appearance at first. It was the 12<sup>th</sup> time in his career he played first and the inaugural time in his Single-A Career last night.
- ✦ **STRUGGLES ON THE ROAD:** Salem has struggled away from home this season, posting a 5-10 road record. RidgeYaks pitchers own a 4.39 ERA on the road compared to a 4.12 mark at Carilion Clinic Field. Offensively, Salem has scored just 61 runs in 15 road games (4.1 runs per game), the second-lowest total in Single-A. By comparison, the RidgeYaks have plated a Single-A best 138 runs in 21 home games (6.57 runs per game). Salem is also batting just .211 on the road compared to .240 at home.
- ✦ **PLAYING IT CLOSE:** Last season Salem and Fredericksburg met 23 times, of those meetings 18 were decided by three runs or less and all but one were decided by four runs or less.
- ✦ **HISTORY VS FRED NATS:** On April 21, Salem beat the FredNats 12-2 with the 12 runs against Fredericksburg, marking the most runs and the largest margin of victory Salem has seen against Fredericksburg since a 14-2 win at home September 4, 2021.
- ✦ **NUNEZ IN CENTER:** Infielder **Starlyn Nunez** has been penciled in to play center field 10 times this season. The Dominican Republic native has appeared in 223 career minor league games across four seasons, however prior to this season, had never played the outfield before.
- ✦ **WELCOME TO THE SHOW:** Salem has seen three former coaches earn the call to join interim manager Chad Tracy's staff in Boston for the 2026 season. Portland Sea Dogs manager **Chad Epperson**, the former 2009 manager of the Salem Red Sox, became the new interim third base coach of the Boston Red Sox after opening the season with Portland. In addition, Salem's 2026 hitting coach, **Nelson "Pepe" Paulino**, also received the call to join the big league club as the interim hitting coach on May 1. Paulino is the longest-tenured coach in Salem baseball history, having spent 10 years in Salem. Finally, 2025 Salem Red Sox assistant hitting coach **Jack Simonetty** joined Boston's staff as an interim hitting assistant. At just 26 years old, Simonetty began the 2026 season in Salem as the interim hitting coach before Nelson Paulino's arrival following the first two series.
- ✦ **BOSTON TO ST. LOUIS:** This offseason former chief baseball officer of the Boston Red Sox **Chaim Bloom** moved from Boston to the St. Louis Cardinals organization. The new president of baseball operations for the Cards has already traded to acquire 2025 Salem pitchers **Blake Aita** and **Yhoiker Fajardo**. And as of last weekend, Bloom made another move acquiring right hander **Patrick Galle** in the Sonny Gray trade.

## WHAT IS A RIDGEYAK

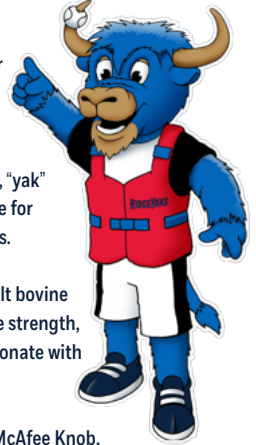
The name "**RidgeYaks**" is a creative and symbolic reflection of the Southwest Virginia community and carries a double meaning:

**Ridge:** A tribute to the scenic Blue Ridge Mountains that tower beyond the outfield wall at Salem Memorial Ballpark, a nod to the beautiful, rugged landscape that defines the region.

**Yak:** The name carries two layers of local-flavor meaning. First, "yak" plays off the slang for kayak, a subtle salute to the region's love for kayaking and other outdoor recreation on the area's waterways.

A Yak is also a real animal. The Yak is a long-haired, heavily built bovine native to high-altitude mountains. The Yak comes to symbolize strength, resilience, stability, and a hardworking spirit, qualities that resonate with both the team and the broader Salem community.

The new mascot, named **Mac the Yak**, takes inspiration from McAfee Knob, one of the region's most iconic natural landmarks, linking the team's identity not only to athletic grit, but to local heritage, outdoor adventure, and mountain pride.

- Led Division III nationally in both strikeouts and wins in 2025 and set Kean single-season program records in both categories
- Struck out career best 14 batters against No. 1 Johns Hopkins on May 31, 2025
- Joined Kean draft alumni Kevin Herget (2013, STL), Chris Eickhorst (2001, TB), Mike Piercy (1999, PIT), Jon Ciravolo (1997, ATL), Michael Murray (1984, CWS) and Mike Manfre (1981, CIN).
- Was named Division-III National Pitcher of the Year in 2025 by both the ABCA and D3baseball.com. Became the first player in Kean program history to earn a major national award from D3baseball.com and the first pitcher in program history to earn a major regional award from either organization
- Started his pro ball career by hurling six innings of scoreless baseball through his first three outings
- Allowed his first earned run in his last outing against Delmarva on May 9, threw a career long 53 pitches while striking out a career best seven hitters
- Today is his first ever pro start and the first start for Gilman since May 31, 2025 when he tossed a nine inning complete, with a college career high 14 strikeouts in an elimination game against Johns Hopkins University in the D-III Baseball World Series

- Fourth season of pro ball, and first full season in the Red Sox organization
- Signed at age 17 by the Giants for \$47,500 as an international free agent in January 2023
- Opened last season in Phoenix with the Arizona Complex League Giants, pitching in eight games and posting a 1-0 record with a 2.00 ERA across 18.0 innings prior to June Rafael Devers trade

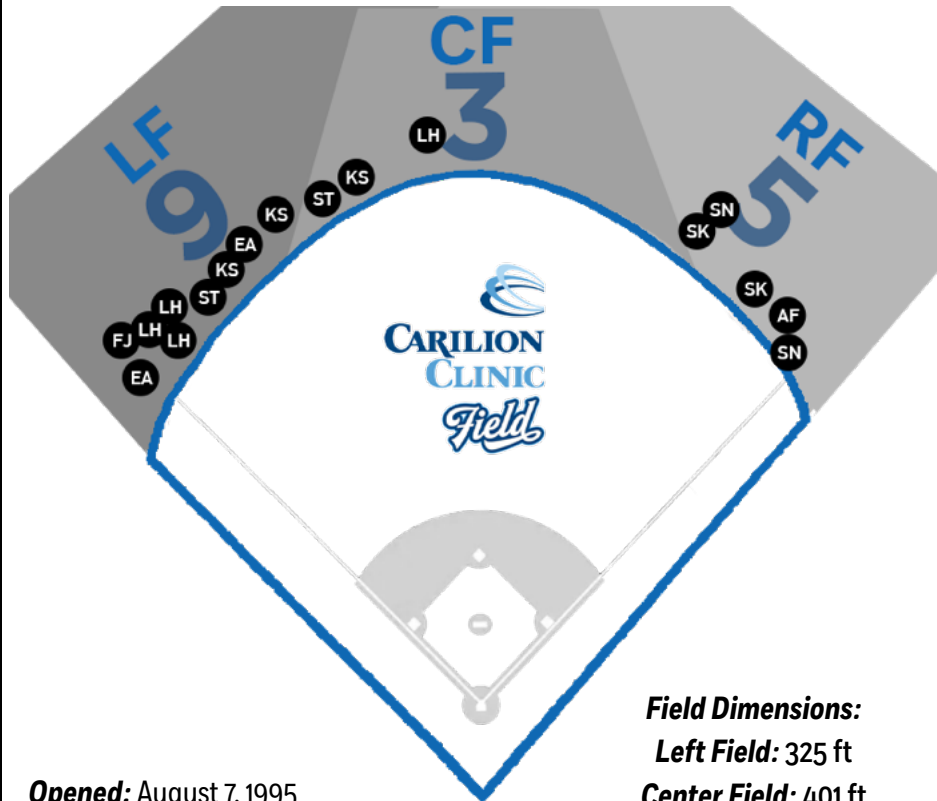
