PITCHING, DEFENSE LEADS TO 3-1 WIN

Ryan Weathers, Freddy Tarnok and Seth Martinez dominated on the mound and the Jacksonville defense helped to limit Syracuse to just one run in a 3-1 win on Thursday. All three Jumbo Shrimp runs came in the second inning. Jacob Berry got the scoring started with an RBI double and Derek Hill added a two-run base hit. The lone Mets run came in the seventh on a Yonny Hernandez RBI single. Weathers fired 5.0 shutout innings, Tarnok went 3.0 frames and Martinez pitched a perfect ninth inning to earn his fourth save.

JACK OF ALL TRADES

Jumbo Shrimp infielder **Jack Winkler** played in just four of the club's first 11 games, going just 2-for-14 with seven strikeouts at the plate. The Littleton, Colo., native has appeared in 20 games since then, racking up seven multi-hit games. Over his last 20 contests. Winkler is 25-for-74 at the plate, slashing .338/.364/.473/.873 with four doubles, two home runs, six RBIs, three walks, 11 runs scored and eight

MEET THE METS

For the first time since the Jacksonville Suns were a New York Mets affiliate from 1966-68, Northeast Florida will welcome in a Mets minor league team on Tuesday when the Jumbo Shrimp host the Syracuse Mets at VyStar Ballbark. These six games, however, are not the first meeting between the clubs; Jacksonville split a series with the Mets in Syracuse from July 12-17, 2022. The 1966-68 Suns featured legendary Mets Tom Seaver, Nolan Ryan, Jerry Koosman and Tug McGraw, with the '68 team winning the International League title.

MEN OF STEAL

After failing to steal a base in the 2025 season opener, Jacksonville has recorded multiple stolen bases in 21 of their last 35 games. In fact, the Jumbo Shrimp have six games with at least five stolen bases, including a club record (2005-present) seven steals in game two of a doubleheader on April 12 vs. Charlotte: Jacksonville notched five stolen bases in a game just twice over the 2022-24 seasons combined. The Jumbo Shrimp currently rank fourth in the minor leagues and first Triple-A with 87 stolen bases.

BULLPEN BOUNCEBACK

Jacksonville relievers came into their series at Durham last week leading Triple-A in ERA by more than a full run at 2.40. Against the Bulls, the Jumbo Shrimp bullpen combined to surrender 30 runs, all earned, on 37 hits in 26.0 innings for an 10.38 ERA (12 BB, 31 K), seeing their season ERA rise all the way to 3.75. In the first three games of their set against Syracuse, however, the club's bullpen has bounced back to their old ways. Jacksonville relief pitchers have combined to work 18.2 innings, yielding just five runs, two earned, on nine hits for a 0.96 ERA. They have combined to total 19 strikeouts against five walks.

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

Of the Jumbo Shrimp's last 27 games, a whopping 22 have been decided by three runs or fewer. Jacksonville is a remarkable 15-7 (.682) in these closely-decided affairs during this stretch. On the season, the Jumbo Shrimp are 17-8 (.680) in games decided by no more than three runs, including a 11-4 (.733) mark in one-run games. Those 11 one-run victories are tied with Chesapeake and Oklahoma City for the most of any team in MiLB.

HOME IS WHERE THE HEART IS

The Jumbo Shrimp are an extraordinary 18-3 at home this season, outscoring their opponents by a 95-56 margin at VyStar Ballpark and claiming the Minor League Baseball lead for home wins. The road, however, for Jacksonville has been a different story. The Jumbo Shrimp are 5-10 on the road, getting outscored by an 87-59 margin. Jacksonville has a team OPS of .739 (19th in Triple-A) and at home compared to .657 on the road (27th). Their team ERA is 1.96 at home (1st) and 5.64 on the road (26th).

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville has taken the extra base on 48.7 percent of opportunities this season, above the MLB average of 42.0 percent... The Jumbo Shrimp have four of the top 12 players in the International League in stolen bases, led by Jakob Marsee's league-leading 22... Marsee ranks third in the circuit in walks with 25, with Maximo Acosta placing in a tie for fifth with 22 walks... Over the last three games, Jacksonville starters have gone 11.1 innings, yielding four runs, three earned, on eight hits for a 2.38 ERA.

ABOUT ADAM

-Mazur was originally selected by the San Diego Padres in the second round of the 2022 draft out of the University of Iowa. He made his major league debut for the Padres on June 4, 2024, tossing 6.0 innings of one-run ball at the Los Angeles Angels. Mazur was later included in the July 30 trade along with left-hander Robby Snelling and infielders Graham Pauley and Jay Beshears in exchange for left-hander Tanner Scott and right-hander Bryan Hoeing.

-Mazur began his collegiate career at South Dakota State University before transferring to Iowa. He made 15 starts for the Hawkeyes in 2022, going 7-3 with a 3.07 ERA. Over 93.2 innings, he yielded only 60 hits and 30 walks while striking out 98 to earn Big Ten Pitcher of the Year honors. His 98 strikeouts ranks as the fourthmost in a single-season in program history, and he ranked eighth nationally in hits allowed per nine innings (5.8).

-When he made his MLB debut on June 4, 2024, Mazur became the fourth former Hawkeye to pitch in a big league game since 2000, joining Wes Obermueller (2002), Matt Dermody (2016) and Nick Allgeyer (2021).

-As a second-round pick (53rd overall), Mazur was the highest-drafted Hawkeye since Tim Costo was picked eighth overall by Cleveland in 1990.

-Mazur is an alumnus of Woodbury High School in Woodbury, Minn, where he was a finalist for the Minnesota Mr. Baseball Award. He was high school teammates with former Jacksonville and current Miami Marlins right-hander Max Meyer.

In addition to his baseball prowess growing up, Mazur earned four letters in basketball and two in football.

-The youngest of three boys, Adam's older brother Brandon played college baseball at Grand View.

2024 SEASON

-Mazur began the season with Double-A San Antonio before earning a promotion to Triple-A El Paso. He had his contract selected by San Diego on June 4 and made his major league debut that night against the Angels.

-Mazur was named the International League Pitcher of the Week for August 20-25 after tossing 6.0 scoreless innings with one hit and one walk against four strikeouts in a 5-0 victory over Nashville on August 21.

2023 SEASON

-In 174 plate appearances, Mazur held right-handed hitters to a .208/.236/.286/.522 line compared to a .298/.332/.418/.750 batting line in 220 plate appearances for left-handed hitters.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-As a senior at Woodbury High School, Mazur compiled a 0.58 ERA with 112 strikeouts and only 12 walks in 72.1 innings. He also played shortstop, batting .377 with five doubles, one home run and 40 RBIs.
