CARDS BLANKED BY HODKS IN SERIES FINALE: The Corpus Christi hooks collected 16 hits and scored in 5 different frames as the Cardinals fell 9-0 on Sunday evening in the series finale at Hammons Field. **Bryan Torres** had 2 of Springfield's 7 hits, both doubles, and the Cardinals drew 5 walks but went 0-for-10 with runners in scoring position. **Nathanael Heredia** made his Double-A debut for Springfield and fired 2.0 scoreless innings with a pair of strikeouts. Despite the loss the Cardinals took 4 of 6 in the series and has won 3 of their last 4 sets.



DPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander **Orlando Ortiz-Mayr** makes his 18th start (19th appearance) of the season for the Drillers...Last pitched on Wednesday, July 24 at Frisco and took the loss, allowing 3 ER on 7 H (3 HR) over 5.0 IP...Has dropped his last two appearances, but began the month of July with 7.0 scoreless innings against Wichita at ONEOK Field on July 5...Has allowed a Texas League-high 16 HR this season...Two worst starts of the season have come against the Cardinals...Took the loss on May 3 at ONEOK Field when he surrendered 6 ER on 5 H with 4 BB over 2.0 IP in game one of a doubleheader, and allowed season-highs 7 ER and 9 H over 3.2 IP on May 25 at Hammons Field...Has pitched much better since, going 2-0 witha 4.62 ERA in 5 June starts and has a 3.18 ERA in 3 July appearances... Made 13 appearances (11 starts) with Tulsa last season and went 3-8 with a 5.79 ERA...Began 2023 with High-A Great Lakes and went 2-4 with a 6.79 ERA...Signed as an undrafted free agent by the Dodgers in 2021 out of Troy...Born in Rio Peidras, Puerto Rico...26 years old

CARDINALS VISIT T-TOWN FOR FINAL TIME IN REGULAR SEASON: The Cardinals head west to pay their final visit of the 2024 regular season to Tulsa, OK for a six-game series against the Drillers (Double-A, Los Angeles Dodgers) this week. Sprngfield won 4 of 5 in Tulsa in a rain-shortened series from April 30-May 5.



CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

CARDS' RADIO HOME

For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

ROAD WARRIORS: The Cardinals have had plenty of success away from Hammons Field. For the season, Springfield has the best road record in the Texas League at 28-16 (.636). The Cardinals' road ERA sits at 3.72 which is good for 3rd-best in the Texas League behind Frisco and Midland, and tops in the North Division. The Cards' ERA at Hammons Field this season is 5.44, the 2nd-worst home ERA in the circuit.

IT'S GETTING HOT IN HERE: After a 1-4 start to the 2nd half of Texas League play, the Cardinals have bounced back and come into play Tuesday as one of the hottest teams in the Texas League. Over their last 16 games since June 30 the Cards are 16-6, tied with the Midland RockHounds for the best record in the Texas League during that time.

POWER SURGE: While the Cardinals have hovered near the bottom of the Texas League in power numbers this season, the Birds have flexed their power muscles during that same stretch. The Cardinals have clubbed 24 homers over their last 22 games, tied with Wichita for 3rd-most in the Texas League, and have homered in 13 of their last 16 games. Springfield has also hit 41 doubles and is 2nd in the league with a SLG of .442 and OPS or .792 during that time. During that stretch the Cardinals have scored 125 runs (5.7/game), 2nd in the league behind Midland (147).

CROOKS CATCHING FIRE: Over his last 21 games dating back to June 23, Cardinals catcher Jimmy Crooks has been swinging one of the hottest bats in the Texas League. During that time the former Oklahoma Sooner is 2nd in the league among qualified hitters with a .346 average while adding 5 HR and 17 RBIs with 4 doubles and a triple. Crooks during that stretch is slugging .615 and has a 1.015 OPS. Among active, qualifited Texas League hitters in 2024, Crooks' .865 OPS and .402 OBP tops in the circuit.

SPRINGFIELD'S HOME RUN KING ...: With his 3-run homer in the bottom of the 5th inning on Friday night, Chandler Redmond etched his name atop vet another Springfield Cardinal career category. Redmond's 60th home run in a Springfield uniform moved him past Xavier Scruggs (2010-13) on the alltime franchise list, giving him the most homers in franchise history. Redmond's historic blast came off Wichita right-hander John Stankoweicz. For good measure, Redmond added another three-run shot on Saturday night off Cory Lewis, giving him home runs in back-to-back games after not leaving the yard in his past 47 contests.

Redmond also holds the Springfield franchise record for RBIs with 225.

... IS HEATING UP: After breaking the record, Redmond has continued swinging a hot bat. During a current 8-game hitting streak, the Cardinals slugger is 14-for-28 (.500) with 3 2B, 2 HR and 8 RBI. In 11 games in July, he is batting .395 (17-for-43) with a team-high 1.052 OPS.

YEAGER BOMBS: With homers in 2 of his last 3 games and a 4th-inning single on Sunday evening, Cardinals INF RJ Yeager has regained his power stroke and run his hitting streak to 9 straight games. The Mississippi State product is batting .300 with 2 2B, 3 HR and 7 RBIs over his last 10 games since July 10. Yeager hit a team-high 5 homers in April before hitting just 2 longballs in May and June combined.

MATTY TWO-BAGS: Cardinals INF/OF Matt Lloyd has been productive all season as the Cardinals' top run-producer. In the month of July he is tied for the Texas League lead with Carson McCusker of Wichita with 8 2B. Lloyd for the month of July is batting .281 with 2 HR and 8 RBIs with a .912 OPS.

SLAM THE DOOR: Cardinals closer Matt Svanson has been lights-out so far in the 2024 campaign in save situations. Svanson is a perfect 16-for-16 and his 16 saves lead all of Double-A.

So far in the 2nd half, the Birds closer has allowed just one earned run in 12.0 IP (0.69 ERA) and is 6-for-6 in save opportunities.
