INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Following a back-and-forth affair in the first half of the contest, the Toledo Mud Hens emerged victorious over the Indianapolis Indians in Tuesday night's series opener at Fifth Third Field, 6-5. After Jace Jung sent a ball over the right field wall to open the scoring for Toledo in the first frame, the Indians got on the board in their next at-bat. Billy McKinney doubled ahead of a walk issued to Canaan Smith-Njigba that set up a Nick Gonzales two-run double. Bae then tallied an RBI single to cap the three-run second. In the third, Toledo tied the game at three apiece courtesy of an RBI double off the bat of Kennedy and an RBI single from Jung. Gonzales then broke the tie with an RBI on a fielder's choice in the fourth before Buddy Kennedy launched his second home run of the season to give the Mud Hens a lead they would not relinquish. Jung pushed Toledo's advantage to 6-4 with a run-scoring double in the seventh, but Ji Hwan Bae blasted a solo home run in the eighth to bring the Indians back within one.

BAE BOMB: Utilityman Ji Hwan Bae continued his rehab assignment with the Indians last night and went 2-for-4 with a run, home run, walk and two RBI. He was placed on the 10-day injured list with a strain of his left hip muscle on March 28 (retroactive to March 25) after undergoing an injury during spring training. Bae began his rehab assignment with Single-A Bradenton on April 7 and went 2-for-3 with a double and RBI before being transferred to Indianapolis. He has fared well when returning to Triple-A after making his big-league debut in September 2022, hitting .344 (11-for-32) with nine runs and four extra-base hits in nine games of a rehab assignment with Indianapolis last season.

LIOVER LOVES HITTING: After setting a new career-high in hits on Friday night, Liover Peguero continued raking last night with a 4-for-5 showing at Toledo. In his past four games, he is 11-for-16 with three runs, three doubles and six RBI. His five-hit game on Friday was the 17th five-hit game by an Indian in the Victory Field era and first since Ryan Vilade on 9/19/23 vs. Rochester. The 23-year-old has been off to a hot start with Indianapolis this season, hitting safely in seven of nine games with a .425 batting average (17-for-40) with six runs, five doubles and 10 RBI.

GONZO'S DOUBLES: Nick Gonzales continued his hot stretch to begin the season last night, going 1-for-4 with a run, double and three RBI. Since the season began, he owns a .390 batting average (16-for-41) with 12 runs, six extra-base hits and eight RBI. Six of his 10 games have featured multi-hit performances. He had his six-game hitting streak snapped in Game 1 of Saturday's doubleheader vs. Memphis but walked twice and is now tied with teammate Jake Lamb with 10-game on-base streaks, the second-longest in the International League trailing only Louisville's Conner Capel (11). Gonzales split the 2023 season between Indianapolis and Pittsburgh and logged a season-high 13-game on-base streak with Indy from 4/6-19.

JAKE ON BASE: Jake Lamb has joined Nick Gonzales in jumping out to a hot start to begin the 2024 season, hitting .355 (11-for-31) with three runs, three extra-base hits, five RBI, eight walks, a .487 on-base percentage and 1.068 OPS in nine games. Yesterday, he singled in the top of the first inning to extend his on-base streak to 10 games. He spent the majority of the 2023 season in Triple-A and logged a 24-game on-base streak with Salt Lake from 5/23-23. During that stretch, he hit .337 (30-for-89) with 19 runs, eight extra-base hits, 22 RBI, 20 walks, a .473 on-base percentage and .990 OPS.

CELLY CONTINUES HIS STREAK: After having his seven-game hitting streak snapped on Sunday vs. Memphis, Gilberto Celestino went 1-for-5 yesterday to begin a new one. His streak is currently tied for the fourth-longest in the International League, trailing eight-game streaks by Norfolk's Heston Kjerstad and Kyle Stowers, and Jacksonville's José Devers. In nine games this season, Celestino is hitting .313 (10-for-32) with six runs, three doubles and six RBI. The 25-year-old spent most of an injury-shortened 2023 season with Triple-A St. Paul, hitting .243 (45-for-185) with 17 extra-base hits and 31 RBI in 55 games. In 115 career Triple-A games, he owns a .265 batting average (108-for-407) with 27 doubles, two triples, nine home runs and 61 RBI.

TODAY: After a successful series victory last week vs. Memphis, the Indians will look to continue their winning ways and tie the six-game series at the Toledo Mud Hens at one game apiece tonight. The Indians saw success vs. the Mud Hens in 2023, finishing the season series with a 14-4 record while going 5-1 at Fifth Third Field. Tonight marks the second of 24 meetings between the two teams, with 12 games coming at Victory Field from May 14-19 and July 30-Aug. 4. Continuing the series tonight is LHP Eric Lauer (1-0, 4.05), who makes his first start after back-to-back piggybacking appearances with tomorrow's starter, RHP Paul Skenes. Countering for the Mud Hens is RHP Matt Manning (1-0, 1.80), who is no stranger to the Indians offense. Since 2021, Manning has made four starts against Indianapolis with a 1-0 record, 3.86 ERA (7er/16.1ip) and 16 strikeouts.

HAMMERING THE HENS: The Indians hammered the Mud Hens in 2023, winning the season-series 14-4. Against Toledo, the Indians offense hit .305 (118-for-616) with 118 runs, 75 extra-base hits and a .896 OPS while scoring at least one run in each of the 18 games played. On the flip side, Indians pitching logged a 3.44 ERA (60er/157.0ip) with four shutouts while holding the Mud Hens offense to a .216 batting average, 62 runs, 44 extra-base hits and .645 OPS.

WE KNOW YOU: Former Indians outfielders and team award winners Bligh Madris (2021 Rookie of the Year) and Ryan Vilade (2023 Gold Glove) each are gearing up to face Indianapolis as part of the Mud Hens active roster this week. Madris appeared in 175 games with the Indians from 2021-22, hitting .282 (116-for-589) with 77 runs, 44 doubles, five triples, 16 home runs and 89 RBI. Vilade appeared in 122 games with Indy during the 2023 season and hit .270 (119-for-440) with 64 runs, 23 doubles, four triples, six homers and 56 RBI.

THIS DATE IN 2002: Left-hander Jimmy Osting struck out seven batters while allowing one earned run on four hits and four walks in 5.0 innings at Charlotte. The effort was good enough for the Indians, who cruised to a 6-1 win thanks to a four-run first inning. Eight of the nine batters in Indy's lineup recorded at least one hit, led by three-hit performances from first baseman Jon Zuber and catcher Marcus Jensen.

Eric Lauer: Right-hander Eric Lauer is set to make his first start with the Indians tonight in Toledo after coming out of the bullpen for his first two appearances.

Last Outing: Lauer took the bump for the Indians for the second time on Friday and fanned four over 4.0 one-hit innings to earn his first win of the campaign.

Against the Mud Hens: Lauer has never faced Toledo.

Lauer Power: Eric Lauer split the 2023 season between the Milwaukee Brewers, Triple-A Nashville Sounds and the ACL Brewers. ... He made 23 total appearances (19 starts) while having his season shortened by right-shoulder impingement.

Miscellaneous: Lauer was selected by San Diego in the 1st round (25th overall) of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Kent State. ... He had his contract first selected by the Padres on April 24, 2018 and made his MLB debut that night at Colorado. ... He was signed by Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent on March 22, 2024.
