**HAPPY OPENING NIGHT:** The sixth season of Fredericksburg Nationals baseball at Virginia Credit Union Stadium has arrived. Tonight, the FredNats begin the 132-game Carolina League season with a three-game Opening Weekend series with the Augusta GreenJackets, Single-A affiliate of Washington's NL East rival Atlanta. This is the first meeting between FBG and AUG since August 2023, when Dylan Crews starred in the outfield for FBG. This series is the only time the teams will meet in the regular season.

**OPENING WEEKEND:** The Fredericksburg Nationals are 2-3 all time on opening day under their current moniker (since 2020). The FredNats have won two of their last three opening days, but look to get back in the win column after dropping their opener last season to the Carolina Mudcats. This is the first time the FredNats have faced the Augusta GreenJackets in their season opener.

**ABOUT LAST YEAR:** The FredNats finished last season at 65-64 overall under Manager Billy McMillon, following the championship in 2024 by winning the North division's second half title to advance to the playoffs for the second straight year. The FredNats season concluded with a two games to none loss to eventual Carolina League Champion Lynchburg in the Division Series.

**IN THE OTHER CORNER:** The Augusta GreenJackets (Braves-A) have been affiliated with Atlanta since their inclusion in the Carolina League beginning in 2021. Located in Augusta, South Carolina since 2018, the team is named for the famous award for the winner of The Masters golf tournament, played across the Savannah River in the Georgia city of the same name.

**REPEAT (SOMEWHAT) RECENT SUCCESS:** The FredNats last faced the GreenJackets during the final full month of the 2023 season. The six game set was soundly won by Fredericksburg five games to one. The FredNats also won their first series against a team from South Carolina last season, beating Charleston 4-2, but dropped their final two series to teams from the Palmetto State, falling later in the year to Columbia and Myrtle Beach.

**UP TO OUR ARMPITS IN PROSPECTS:** The Fredericksburg Opening Day roster is loaded with some of the top talent in the revamped Nationals organization, headlined by Washington's top prospect Eli Willits, the No. 1 overall pick in the 2025 MLB Draft. Willits is ranked as baseball's 9th-best prospect overall by MLB Pipeline. Overall, the FredNat roster has seven prospects ranked in MLB Pipeline's top 20 Nationals prospects.

**MACKENZIE'S GONE:** The FredNats opening day roster includes two of the five prospects dealt back to Washington from Texas as part of the trade for Nats' top end arm MacKenzie Gore. Last year's 12th overall pick Gavin Fien debuts as the fifth-best prospect in the Nationals organization, and is joined by former Rangers prospect Jeremy Cabrera (Nats No. 20) in the haul back from Texas. Both players bring Carolina League experience to FXBG after finishing last year with the Hickory Crawdads.

**THE STAFF:** Manager Chris O'Neill leads a coaching staff of seven newcomers to the Washington organization, and the average age of the coaching staff is 28.

**WE ARE GETTING YOUNGER:** The new staff in Fredericksburg follows a trend of young brainchildren charged with working in the Nationals organization this year, with other notable hires within the organization including President of Baseball Operations Paul Toboni (currently the youngest lead executive in MLB), General Manager Anirudh "Ani" Kilambi (aged 31), and Major League Manager Blake Butera (the youngest manager in MLB since 1972 at 33 years old).

**FREDNATS BASEBALL NETWORK IS BACK:** Once again, all 132 FredNat games this season will be broadcast live on the FredNats Baseball Network, with Luke West Poley beginning his first season as the lead voice of the team. Home games are broadcast on MiLB.tv and the Bally Sports Live App to go along with the audio-only stream at frednats.com/broadcast or the MiLB App. For road games, the radio broadcast is available at the same link. In addition, all FredNats games preceded by a 20 minute pregame show and postgame coverage following each night of action.

**A LASTING LEGACY:** The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Potomac Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024, defeating the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers and winning the title at Virginia Credit Union Stadium. The franchise has appeared in the Carolina League playoffs in three out of the last four seasons.

**FINISH STRONG:** After allowing 12 ER over the span of four appearances to finish the month of June, Portorreal rebounded well in the final month of the Complex League season, allowing just 3 ER over his final four outings during the month of July.

# Chris O'Neill - MANAGER

1st Season | Previously: Hitting Coach/Recruiting Coordinator, Virginia Commonwealth University

O'Neill, 36, joins the Nationals organization after two seasons (2024-25) as a hitting coach/recruiting coordinator at Virginia Commonwealth University. Prior to that, he served as an assistant coach and assistant recruiting coordinator at George Washington from 2022-24.

O'Neill is credited with helping fuel major offensive surges at both VCU and George Washington, as both schools set offensive records and contended for Atlantic 10 championships under his watch. O'Neill spent the 2021 season as the director of operations at Duke University and prior to that, he served as an assistant coach at Bucknell University (2020), Marshall University (2018-19) and the University of Maryland-Eastern Shore (2017).

This season will be O'Neill's first time managing since he led the Grand Lake Mariners (Great Lakes Summer Collegiate League) in the summers of 2016 and 2017. A Pennsylvania native, he received his Bachelor's degree in Education from King's College in 2012. O'Neill and his wife Kate have two boys, Easton and Callum.
