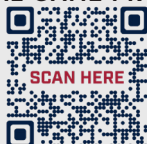

### TONIGHT'S GAME

Round Rock searches for a series victory on Saturday evening at Greater Nevada Field. A win will give Round Rock their third series victory of the year. Express RHP Cole Winn is scheduled to start against Aces RHP Drey Jameson. First pitch is slated for 6:05 p.m. CT.

### ABOUT LAST NIGHT...

Round Rock launched four home runs and 23 hits en route to a 19-5 drubbing of Reno on Friday night. After a two-RBI triple from RF Leody Taveras, and an RBI single from DH Yohel Pozo, 1B Sherten Apostel put an exclamation point on the first inning with a three-run home run. The Express led 6-0. Reno scored a run in the second on a sacrifice fly. In the third, the Aces scored three runs and trimmed the Express lead at 6-4. Round Rock scored six more in the fourth. Another Apostel three-run home run headlined the scoring. Pozo, SS Josh Smith, and C Meibrys Viloria each drove in a run during the outburst and it was 12-4. In the sixth, Round Rock scored five more runs when Pozo and 2B Ryan Dorow went deep to make it 17-4. Viloria had his fifth hit of the game in the seventh inning and it plated two more runs. Reno scored twice in the ninth inning on a single from RF Alek Thomas but the Express took home a 19-5 win. RHP Jason Bahr earned the win. He tossed three scoreless innings out of the bullpen and allowed only one hit. LHP Tyler Gilbert earned the loss. He allowed six runs on seven hits and recorded only two outs.

### TIME TO WINN

Round Rock RHP Cole Winn will take the baseball on Saturday. Winn has made five starts this year and holds a 3.38 ERA (8 ER/21.1 IP). He has 17 strikeouts to 11 walks this season.

### APOSTEL SHOW

After Round Rock C Sam Huff hit two home runs on Wednesday, 1B Sherten Apostel went deep twice on Friday. Apostel ended the day 4-for-6 with two home runs, a double and six RBI. He also scored three runs. His six RBI and 11 total bases were a season high for a Round Rock player. Apostel reached the 50-home run milestone for his career on Friday and it also marked the fifth multi-home run game of his career.

### OFFENSE SHINING IN MAY

In five games this month, the Express lead all of Minor League Baseball in runs scored (51), hits (72), batting average (.365), on-base percentage (.428), slugging percentage (.655) and OPS (1.083). The E-Train lead the PCL with 12 home runs in May and they are tied for the second most home runs of any team in Minor League Baseball this month.

### THE STREAK LIVES ON

OF Leody Taveras didn't waste much time and extended his hitting streak to 16 games with a first inning triple last night. After going 2-for-5, he is tied for the longest active hitting streak in Minor League Baseball with El Paso Chihuahuas OF Nomar Mazara. The longest hitting streak in team history belongs to 3B Yangervis Solarte (2012) at 22 games. Taveras leads the PCL in batting average (.363).

### VILORIA VROOMS FORWARD

Last night, C Meibrys Viloria collected the second five-hit performance by a Round Rock player this year. OF Leody Taveras accomplished the feat on April 8. Viloria went 5-for-6 with three RBI. His 12-game hitting streak is the third longest in Minor League Baseball. Viloria is slashing .386/.493/.544 in 16 games this season.

### DOROW KEEPS HITTING

2B Ryan Dorow hit his first home run of the season yesterday. It was part of a 3-for-5 night at the dish for Dorow. He drove in three runs and had his third three-hit game of the series. He is now 9-for-18 (.500) in four games this series including two doubles, a triple and a home run.

## EXPRESS MANAGER MATT HAGEN

The 2022 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Matt Hagen's Triple-A coaching debut. A resident of Austin, Hagen spent the last two seasons as the Texas Rangers' Minor League Field Coordinator. He is entering his seventh season in the Rangers organization after previously managing the Low-A Hickory Crawdads in 2018 and 2019 as well as the Short-Season Spokane Indians in 2017. In his three seasons as a manager, Hagen has compiled a .550 winning percentage, combining to post a 192-157 overall record, including capturing the South Atlantic League Championship with Hickory in 2019. He originally joined the Texas organization in 2016 as a coach for the Crawdads.

Prior to joining the Rangers, Hagen spent three years as the head coach at Four Points Baseball in Austin. Upon the conclusion of his playing career in 2012, Hagen returned to his alma mater, Liberty University, as an assistant coach. He also had a stint on the Liberty staff in 2007 and spent three off-seasons as a strength coach for the Flames' baseball, men's soccer and football programs.

An infielder in his playing days, Hagen was selected by the Seattle Mariners in the 12th round of the 2002 MLB Draft and spent time in both the Seattle and San Diego Padres organizations, reaching Double-A Mobile in 2006. Hagen continued his playing career in the independent Frontier and Atlantic Leagues from 2007-2012, earning Atlantic League All-Star honors three times. Hagen was a first team All-Big South selection at Liberty University, leading the conference in home runs and RBI as a junior, and was a member of Liberty's 2000 Big South Championship team that advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Hagen graduated from Liberty in 2012 with a degree in Sport Management.
