YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the RubberDucks, 3-1, for their fifth consecutive win. Victor Bericoto and Bryce Eldridge hit back-to-back homers in the bottom of the first inning to open a 2-0 lead. Dayan Frias cut the score to 2-1 with an RBI single in the fifth, the only run allowed over five innings in the first Double-A win for Nick Morreale. In the fifth, Eldridge hit a single and a fielding error brought home Carter Howell to extend the Richmond lead to 3-1. Nick Swiney threw two scoreless innings, Mat Olsen worked a scoreless eighth and Nick Garcia closed out his fifth save in the ninth. Eldridge finished the game 3-for-4.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels face the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians, in the finale of a six-game series at The Diamond, Richmond's finale home series of 2024. The two teams faced off in the first series at The Diamond this year from April 9-14, splitting the set. From April 30-May 5, the RubberDucks won five-of-six at Canal Park. Richmond returned to Akron for three games coming out of the All-Star Break from July 19-21, with the 'Ducks winning two-of-three. The Flying Squirrels are looking for their first six-game sweep in franchise history. Last September, 5-10 they won the first five games against Akron at The Diamond before dropping the finale.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won six-of-seven, including the first five games of this series against Akron. Last week, they went 2-4 in a road series at Erie. Prior to that road trip, they went 4-1 in their previous five games from August 21-25 which followed losing a six-game losing streak from August 14-20. In their last 18 games since August 18, the Flying Squirrels are batting a league-best .270 (165-for-611) and averaging 9.2 hits per game (165 total) and averaging 5.1 runs per game (91 total), also best in the Eastern League. In their last 18 games since August 18, the Flying Squirrels have homered 16 times after hitting six homers in their previous nine games from July 27-August 17.

THE RUBBERDUCKS clinched the Southwest Division's second-half last Saturday night at Canal Park. They swept all six games of last week's series against the Baysox at Canal Park. Akron's roster includes five of Baseball America's top-30 prospects, including 1B C.J. Kayfus (No. 10), LHP Parker Messick (No. 19), SS Kahlil Watson (No. 20), C Cooper Ingle (No. 21) and 3B Dayan Frias (No. 27), MLB.com's top-30 Guardians prospects list includes Kayfus (No. 7), Ingle (No. 15), Messick (No. 20), OF Petey Halpin (No. 28) and Watson (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander John Michael Bertrand makes his league-leading 27th start of the season and the eighth of his career against the RubberDucks. He started the series opener against Akron and threw six scoreless innings. Against Akron this season, Bertrand is 3-0 with a 0.41 ERA (1 ER/22.0 IP). On the year, he leads the minors with 21 groundball double plays induced and he tied for first in the Eastern League with a 511 groundball percentage. In fielding, he leads all MiLB pitchers in assists (29). On the season, he has made 10 scoreless starts, all at least five innings, which is the most in the Eastern League Bertrand has been named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week twice this year, first for throwing seven perfect innings against the Baysox on April 27 and then for working is hitless innings in Bowle on May 23. Last season, he climbed three levels, working from Low-A San Jose to High-A Eugene before joining Double-A Richmond in July for the remainder of the season. For the year, he led all qualified Giants minor league pitchers in winning percentage (.688) and ranked second in ERA (3.65), second in wing (11), tied for second in WHIP (1.23), third in innings pitched (118.1) and fourth in BAA (.248). Entering 2024, Bertrand was rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Giants system. Bertrand began his collegiate career at Furman University in South Carolina before playing his final two seasons at the University of Notre Dame. He was selected by the Giants in the 10th round of the 2022 MLB Draft. For more on Bertrand, see page two.

FOR AKRON: Right-hander Tommy Mace makes his 26th start of the season and his fifth against the Flying Squirrels. He was charged with a loss in the series opener on Tuesday against the Flying Squirrels, allowing one run over six innings. Against the Flying Squirrels this year, Mace is 1-1 with a 1.50 ERA (4 ER/24.0 IP). This season, Mace is ranked eighth in the Eastern League in ERA (3.65), tied for fifth in games started (25), tied for fourth in innings pitched (135.2), seventh in BAA (.235) and fourth in WHIP (1.19). Mace was selected by the Guardians with the 69th pick in the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of Florida.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** The Flying Squirrels have turned 89 groundball double plays this year, which is the most in the Eastern League. Richmond pitcher **John Michael Bertrand** has induced 21 double plays this year, which is the most in the minor leagues. The Flying Squirrels turned four double plays on July 27 against Binghamton, which is tied for the most in a game this season in the league. They matched that feat with four double plays in the first four innings at Harrisburg on August 16 with Bertrand pitching. Those four double plays were tied for the most induced by a pitcher in the Eastern League dating back to 2005, which is the first year those statistics are readily available. It has been accomplished by three other Richmond pitchers, including **Daryl Maday** in 2010, **Clayton Blackburn** twice in 2014 and **Garrett Williams** in 2019. Bertrand's 21 GIDPs this year are tied for the second-most in a season in franchise history, trailing only 27 by **Craig Westcott** in 2012 (second-most in the Eastern league since at least 2005).

WELCOME HOME, BRYCE: Bryce Eldridge was assigned to the Flying Squirrels on Tuesday afternoon. The 19-year-old first baseman was selected with the 16th pick in last year's MLB Draft out of Madison High School in Vienna, Va. With his debut, he became the fifth player in Flying Squirrels franchise history born in Virginia, joining Jarrett Parker (2013-14), Matt Winn (2016-19), (2018-19) Connor Overton and Spencer Bivens (2023). At 19 years, 10 months and 14 days old, Eldridge became the second-youngest player in franchise history, trailing only Anyesber Sivira (2019) and just ahead of Heliot Ramos 2019, 2021). As the 16th player selected in last year's draft, Eldridge is the seventh-highest draft pick in franchise history, trailing only Joey Bart (2, 2018), Hunter Bishop (10, 2019), Patrick Bailey (13, 2020). Tyler Beede (14, 2014), Will Bednar (14, 2021) and Will Wilson (15, 2019). This season, Eldridge leads the Giants organization in batting average (296), home runs (23), RBIs (88), SLG (540), OPS (920), hits (118), extra-base hits (50) and total bases (215) and ranks second in doubles (26), tied for sixth in walks (54) and second in runs scored (72).

BERICOTO BASHING: In his last 64 games dating back to June 6, Victor Bericoto is hitting .297 (77-for-259) with seven homers, 16 doubles, 15 walks and 41 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland, but he had not homered in 34 games before belting a two-run shot on August 9 off the scoreboard in left-center at The Diamond. Dating back to August 24, Bericoto has homered three times in his last 10 games including a grand slam on September 1 at Erie. On Thursday, he hit the second walk-off hit of his Flying Squirrels career, a 10th-inning single to beat Akron, 7-6.

MUN-SHOTS: In his 23 August games, Ismael Munguia batted .353 (30-for-85), third-highest in the Eastern League, with three homers, five doubles and 14 RBIs, adding five stolen bases. He has at least one hit in 21-of-26 games played since August 1. Last year, he hit .282 over 75 games with the Flying Squirrels. In his Richmond career, Munguia is batting .295 (136-for-461) in 118 games, which is the third-highest career mark in franchise history (min. 450 PA). In his last 10 games since August 24, Munguia is batting .412 (14-for-34) with four homers and 11 RBIs. He has nine RBIs in his last six games since last Thursday.

**GO, DIEGO, GOI:** Diego Velasquez is batting .349 (16-for-46) in his last 12 games dating back to August 22, including a four-hit game that day against Altoona. He has nine hits in his last seven games played with five RBIs. Among Giants full-season Giants minor leaguers this season, Velasquez is ranked fourth in batting average (.281), ninth in OBP (.358), third in hits (112), tied for seventh in triples (4), ninth in total bases (150) and fifth in stolen bases (21).

**HOWELL AT THE MOON:** Carter Howell has collected 16 hits in his last 14 games since August 21, batting .281 (16-for-57) with a double and eight runs scored. In the Eastern League this season, Howell is ranked first in doubles (30), tied for first in triples (6), fourth in hits (116), tied for fourth in extra-base hits (39) and ninth in total bases (168).

PACKING THE HOUSE: For the season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,597) and total (428,830) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels are ninth in average attendance. In 2022 and 2023, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance for the first times in franchise history. This year's total attendance is the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history.

BOULEVARD TO THE BAY: This season, 13 former Flying Squirrels players have reached the majors for the first time. That is the most in a season in franchise history. In 2014, 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including Joe Panik, Adam Duvall, Andrew Susac, Matt Duffy, Jackson Williams, Edwin Escobar, Hunter Strickland, Chris Dominguez, Gary Brown, Brett Bochy and Chris Heston. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors this season are Erik Miller (2023 Flying Squirrels), Landen Roupp (2022-23), Kai-Wei Teng (2022-23), Nick Aviia (2022), Randy Rodriguez (2022-23), Mason Black (2023), Gerson Garabito (2021), Spencer Bivens (2023), Raymond Burgos (2023), Hayden Birdsong (2023-24), Parker Dunshee (2023), Grant McCray (2024) and Sandro Fabian (2021), Dating back to 2022, 21-of-the-last-24 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers), Fabian (Rangers) and Dunshee (Braves) being the only exceptions. Last year saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster.

**LOTTA INS, LOTTA OUTS, LOTTA WHAT-HAVE-YOUS:** The have been 61 players who have seen action for the Flying Squirrels this year, a new franchise record for a single season. In 2018 and 2019, the Flying Squirrels had 60 different players see time on the field. This season, there have been 31 different pitchers used by the Flying Squirrels, which includes appearances by **Andy Thomas** on June 1 against the SeaWolves and **Luis Toribio** on August 10 against the Yard Goats. There have been 32 different hitters who have seen at least one plate appearance with Richmond this season.

PROSPECT WATCH: Three of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including 1B Bryce Eldridge (No. 3), OF Vaun Brown (No. 11) and SS Diego Velasquez (No. 26). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, LHP John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features three Richmond players, including Eldridge (No. 1), Velasquez (No. 15) and LHP Jack Choate (No. 19).
