**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** Down 3-0 after four innings, the Cyclones rallied back to score ten runs across the fifth and sixth innings en route to a 10-4 victory over Jersey Shore Tuesday night in Lakewood. C **Matt O'Neill** had a three-run triple in the four-run fifth inning, while 1B JT **Schwartz** enjoyed a "Little League Grand Slam," unloading the bases with a three-run triple and scoring on a throwing error in the six-run fifth. RHP **Oscar Rojas** carved up Jersey Shore across the middle innings, allowing one unearned run over five with eight strikeouts.

**CONGRATULATIONS:** RHP **Jordan Yamamoto** and RHP **Hunter Parsons** were both promoted to Double-A Binghamton after last night's game. Parsons has spent three different seasons with Brooklyn. Since 2019, the Maryland native has made 47 of his 51 career appearances with Brooklyn.

**NEWCOMERS:** Following the promotions of both RHP **Jordan Yamamoto** and RHP **Hunter Parsons**, the Mets promoted LHP **Nathan Lavender** and RHP **Luis Moreno**. Moreno has been used as both a starter (25 times) and reliever (18 times) in his Mets career that began in 2019, while Lavender came to the Mets out of Illinois in the 14th round of the 2021 MLB Draft and has been used exclusively in relief.

**BOMBOSAS:** Since the May 22nd doubleheader against Hudson Valley in New York, the Cyclones have completely turned around their power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 16 home runs in the past nine games after just seven over the team's first 34 games.

**BMAC ATTACK:** OF **Brandon McIlwain** has been on base in six straight games, hitting .360 with a .467 on-base percentage with two home runs in his past four games and had a 4-for-4 game on Saturday at Bowling Green.

**vs. JERSEY SHORE:** The Philadelphia Phillies affiliate sits in last place in the North Division and the South Atlantic League entering the series. The Cyclones have won six of the first seven with the first trip to New Jersey this week. Eight of Philly's top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline, are in Jersey Shore, including No. 3 RHP Mick Abel, No. 4 OF Johan Rojas, and No. 7 OF Ethan Wilson.

**MAY FLOWERS:** INF **Jose Peroza's** month of May has reflected the talent of the No. 29 prospect in the Mets system, according to *MLB Pipeline*. After an April in which the Venezuelan hit .155 with no extra base hits and three walks, Peroza hit .263 in May with eight walks, four doubles, and two home runs.

**THE SUOZZINATOR:** Brooklyn OF **Joe Suozzi** has been on another level since going through a development program in early May. Since returning to action on May 19, the Long Island native has hits in six of eight games, hitting .344. The former Boston College Eagle is 11-32 with two doubles, two home runs, five walks, and just eight strikeouts. Prior to the stint on the development list, Suozzi was hitting just .111 over his first 13 games with a 42% strikeout rate and three walks prior to the break.

**ARM ASSISTANCE:** RHP **Mike Vasil** and RHP **Carson Seymour** joined the team in Bowling Green last week after earning their respective promotions from Low-A St. Lucie. Vasil, the No. 21 prospect in the Mets system, according to *MLB Pipeline*, was drafted out of Virginia in the 8th round last season, while Seymour was selected in the 6th round out of Kansas State last year.

**ROUGH N' ROWDEY:** OF **Rowdy Jordan**, the Mets' 11th-round selection out of Mississippi State, has been well-rounded in his first full season. The Brooklyn outfielder leads the team with 56 total bases and leads the team with 17 RBIs.

**2021:** Bryant spent 2021 with the Low-A St. Lucie Mets, breaking camp with the team in May. He made two starts before tearing his oblique in May. Did not pitch again until mid-August with the FCL Mets. Made one appearance with the Cyclones in September, allowing a career-high four home runs against Hudson Valley on September 8th.

**2019 SEASON:** Bryant put his name on the radar in 2019, leading the Cyclones pitching staff to a New York Penn League Championship over the Lowell Spinners. That season, Bryant was named to the mid-season All-Star team. Bryant struck out 75 batters in 75 innings and pitched a pair of seven-inning games for the Cyclones.

**MAN, YOU MOVE:** Bryant grew up in Deerfield, New Hampshire but moved to and grew up in the Clearwater, FL area. Bryant now makes his home in Saratoga Springs, NY.
