JACKSONVILLE WINS THIRD STRAIGHT

Yonny Chirinos pitched five strong innings and the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp won their third straight game with a 3-1 victory over the Norfolk Tides. The Jumbo Shrimp opened up the scoring in the second when a **Tristan Gray** triple coupled with a Tides error plated two runs. **Heston Kjerstad's** solo home run in the fifth cut the Jacksonville lead in half, but in the bottom of the fifth, **Jonah Bride** laced an RBI single to make it 3-1. Following Chirinos' five innings, **Devin Smeltzer** threw 2.1 scoreless frame before ceding to **Anthony Maldonado**, who got the final five outs for his second save.

ALWAYS THE BRIDE. NEVER THE BRIDESMAID

Jacksonville infielder **Jonah Bride** blasted two home runs on Wednesday, his second multi-homer game in five days. Bride began the season with Miami, batting just 1-for-7 in five games before getting optioned to Jacksonville. Since coming to the First Coast, Bride is 16-for-41 (.390/.528/.780/1.308) with four doubles, four home runs, eight RBIs, nine walks and six runs scored. Bride leads the International League in average, OBP, SLG and OPS while ranking second in average and tied for 11th in home runs.

SCORING IN BUNCHES

Jacksonville has scored a run in 42 of their 160 offensive innings thus far in 2024. Over those 42 innings, the Jumbo Shrimp have scored multiple runs in nearly half of those, a total of 20 frames. The club's biggest inning came during a seven-run fifth inning on April 17 against Norfolk. Outside of that, the Jumbo Shrimp have logged two five-run innings, five frames of three runs and 13 two-run innings.

YES WAY, JOSÉ

Jumbo Shrimp infielder **José Devers** has reached base in 14 consecutive games entering play on Friday, tied for the third-longest active streak in the International League. Over this stretch, Devers is 17-for-52, batting .327/.375/.596/.971 with three doubles, one triple, three home runs, eight RBIs, three walks and 11 runs scored. Thus far in 2024, the native of Samana in the Dominican Republic has increased his line drive rate to 26.1 percent from 20.1 percent with Double-A Pensacola in 2023, while dropping his ground ball rate from 41.1 percent to 32.6 percent.

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 12 of Jacksonville's 18 games (66.7 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer. The Jumbo Shrimp have excelled in these contests, going 10-2 in those closely-decided affairs thus far. Last season, 85 of the club's 149 games (57.0 percent) were determined by no more than three runs, with the club going 39-46 (.459) in those contests. Prior to that, Jacksonville had been over .500 in games decided by three runs or fewer in every season from 2019-22

THE WHOLE 10 YARDS

Jacksonville began the season by losing two of three games against Gwinnett, but since that point, the Jumbo Shrimp have won 10 of their last 15 games. Nine of those 10 victories have come by three runs or fewer, with Jacksonville outscoring their opponents by a thin 72-67 margin. The Jumbo Shrimp's pitching has excelled during this stretch, with the club placing fifth in ERA (4.06) in Triple-A during this stretch. Jacksonville has ceded the seventh-fewest runs at the level.

SHRIMP ON THE POND

Through 18 games in 2024, Jacksonville has mustered only 78 runs (4.3 per game), in large part due to the club's struggles with runners in scoring position. Thus far during the 2024 campaign, the Jumbo Shrimp are a woeful 31-for-150 (.207/.318/.347/.665, ranking 29th, 29th, 27th and 29th, respectively, in Triple-A) hitting with runners in scoring position, stranding a total of 112 runners. In 2023, Jacksonville hit just .247/.336/.400/.736 with runners in scoring position, figures that respectively ranked 27th, 29th, 27th and 29th in Triple-A.

SHRIMP RITES

Jacksonville has just three stolen base attempts and two stolen bases in the 12 games since April 5. Both figures are the fewest in Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp are the only professional baseball team (MLB & MiLB) to not steal a base since April 11... In four games from April 12-16, Jacksonville relievers surrendered 14 runs, all earned, on 15 hits in 14.1 innings for an 8.79 ERA (7 BB, 16 K). Over the last two games, the Jumbo Shrimp bullpen has ceded just one run on four hits in 10.0 innings for a 0.90 RA (BB, 14 K).
