RIDERS TAKE DOWN TRAVELERS 7-1, EARN SERIES WIN:

The Frisco RoughRiders defeated the Arkansas Travelers 7-1 on Saturday evening from Riders Field. Frisco (8-4, 52-29) jumped ahead early against Arkansas (6-6, 42-38) starter Juan Mercedes (3-4) when Cody Freeman belted his team-leading tenth homer of the season, driving in Keyber Rodriguez. Leading 2-0 in the bottom of the second, Cooper Johnson then delivered a 418-foot blast to left, extending the RoughRiders lead to 3-0. Emiliano Teodo (5-2) sat down the first eight batters he faced, striking out three. The Travelers picked up their first base runner with two outs in the top of the third on the only walk issued by the righty all evening. Alejandro Osuna, who doubled in the third inning, laced a triple to right and later scored on an error to give the Riders a 4-0 lead in the fifth. Teodo exited after 5.2 innings of scoreless, two-hit baseball in which he issued just one walk and struck out seven. In the bottom of the sixth, Freeman singled to mark the first single of the night for the Riders. Through the first five innings, the Frisco offense tallied two doubles, a triple and two homers. In the bottom of the seventh inning, the RoughRiders notched five straight bits offense tallied two doubles, a triple and two homers. In the bottom of the seventh inning, the RoughRiders notched five straight hits to add three runs. RBI singles from Osuna, Rodriguez and **Maximo Acosta** pushed the Frisco lead to 7-0. The Travelers scratched a run across against **Antoine Kelly** in the top of the eighth, using a leadoff triple by Blake Rambusch and an RBI groundout by Harry Ford to break up the shutout. **Seth Clark** worked a scoreless ninth inning to secure the 7-1 win, giving Frisco a series win over Arkansas. Offensively, the RoughRiders collected 11 hits with six of them being for extra bases. Osuna led the way with three hits as Rodriguez, Freeman and Johnson each logged a pair of knocks.

HOME COOKING:

HOME COOKING:
The RoughRiders have been fantastic at home this year, going 28-10 at Riders Field this season. Their 28 wins and .737 winning percentage at home are both first in Double-A and second among non-Triple-A teams in Minor League Baseball. At home this season, Frisco has a +70 run differential, a 3.43 ERA and is averaging 5.6 runs per game with a .740 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 24-19 with a 3.45 ERA, but a +18 run differential while averaging 4.0 runs per game and owning a .631 OPS. Cody Freeman is slashing 357/.404/.612/1.016 at home this season with seven of his 10 home runs. His .357 batting average is the best in the Texas League play a player at their home stadium. In their series against Arkansas, the Riders went 1-2 in North Little Rock, being outscored 7-5 in their three games. At home in three games, Frisco outscored the Travelers 22-9.

OSUNA FROM THE RIDERS:

Alejandro Osuna has been incredible for Frisco since joining them from High-A Hickory. In seven games, he is hitting .375 (12-for-32)/.375/.750/1.125 with five doubles, two triples, a home run and six RBIs. On Friday, he went 2-for-5 with a triple and a home run, tying his career-high with five RBIs. He set that career high in his final game in High-A this year, also hitting for the cycle in a 5-for-5 game. In the first inning, Osuna is hitting .571 (4-for-7) with three doubles for the Riders.

Cody Freeman blasted a go-ahead home run in the seventh last Friday, giving him the team lead with nine this year. While he slowed down slightly at the plate in June (batting .253/.298/.437/.735), he has clubbed four home runs in his last 12 games with two of them being game-winners and drove in the only runs that the Riders scored on July 3rd with a two-run double in the first. This season, he has a career highs in average (.279), slugging percentage (.468) and OPS (.799) while being on pace to set new career bests in RBIs (69) and home runs (18).

DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:

The Riders have the second-fewest errors in all of Minor League Baseball (47) while also ranking third in fielding percentage (.983) in the minors. Frisco's 81 double plays are the most in the Texas League, second among non-Triple-A teams and seventh in all of Minor League Baseball. Frisco have allowed the third-fewest stolen bases in MiLB (56), throwing out 29 percent of total base runners against

THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Frisco's bullpen has been the best in the Texas League this season, owning a 2.86 ERA, which is also the best in all of Minor League Baseball. In their last 11 games, the bullpen has a 2.36 ERA (12ER/45.2IP). In their last five series, spanning 37 games, Frisco's bullpen has a 1.91 ERA (29ER/136.1IP).

FIRING BLANKS

In their last 27 games, the Riders have allowed just 69 earned runs over 247.1 IP (2.51 ERA). Two Saturdays ago, the Riders allowed seven runs (six earned) for the first time in 13 games (8 allowed on 6/5 at CC). Frisco has not allowed double-digit runs in 36 games (5/23 vs. MID). In thier last 39 games, the Riders have allowed more than three runs in a game just 13 times and 10 times in the last 27 games.

WERE GOING DANCING:
Tuesday marked the first day of the second half. After a Midland loss on two Sundays ago, the RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (2.40), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (2.31) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.
