Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland A's, play the second game of a six-game series against the Lake County Captains, the High-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians, the 223rd all-time meeting between the two teams. On five games remain in the Lugnuts' 27th Midwest League season. The Lugnuts are 8-11 vs. the Captains this season, losing four of five games in Eastlake in April before winning four of seven games in Lansing in May and splitting a six-game series in July.

Last Night: Picantes 3, Lugnuts 2. T.J. Schofield-Sam beat out a game-tying fielder's choice in the top of the ninth inning, only to see Kahlil Watson deliver Lake County's third sacrifice fly of the game for a walk-off win in the series opener.

**Starting Matchup:** 22-year-old right-hander **Jacob Watters**, the Athletics' 4th-round selection in 2022 and top pitcher drafted, makes his team-leading 21st start of the year, opposite Captains right-hander **Ethan Hankins**, the 35th overall pick in the 2018 draft. Watters has struck out 15 batters combined in his last two starts, firing 4 2/3 one-hit scoreless innings with seven strikeouts vs. West Michigan last time out.

#### Lug•Notes

Among the League Leaders, Individual: The promoted Daniel Susac leads the Midwest League in qualified batting average with a .303 average and is 8th in OBP (.373) and 10th in OPS (.810). Danny Bautista, Jr. is tied for 2nd in base hits (114). Junior Pérez is tied for 3rd in stolen bases (41), tied for 6th in doubles (26). 9th in total bases (167) and 10th in extra-base hits (40).

Among the League Leaders, Team: The Nuts' offense is 2nd in the MWL in team batting average (.251), 2nd in fewest strikeouts (1032), 2nd in stolen bases (185), tied for 2nd in sacrifices (15), tied for 3rd in sacrifice flies (46), 3rd in base hits (1040), 3rd in doubles (210) and 4th in triples (30). The Nuts' pitchers are 1st in GO/AO ratio (1.00) and GiDP (95) and 3rd in saves (37). Lansing also leads the league with 113 double plays turned, seven more than second-place Peoria.

Reunion in Oak Town: Former Lugnuts who played in last night's Toronto 7-1 win over Oakland: Davis Schneider, Vladdy Guerrero Jr., Alejandro Kirk and Cavan Biggio for the Blue Jays, and Ryan Noda, Jordan Diaz and Tyler Soderstrom for the A's.

Keeping it Close: Of the Lugs' 126 games played this year: 45 have been one-run games, 34 have been two-run games, 16 have been three-run games, nine have been four-run games, and 22 have been games decided by five or more runs.

Jerome Holtzman, Represent: On that note, saves recorded in Lugnuts games in each month: seven saves in 20 games in April (35%), nine in 27 games in May (33%), 15 in 24 in June (63%), 20 in 24 games in July (83%), 22 in 27 games in August (81%), and one through four games in September.

Roll Call: The Lugnuts have used 25 position players this year and 26 pitchers (not including Danny Bautista, Jr., who tossed one inning as a position-player-pitching). 16 players have hit at least one home run, 16 players have stolen at least one base, 15 pitchers have made at least one start, 19 pitchers have won at least one game, and 13 pitchers have recorded at least one save.

Consistent Faces: Lansing has used the same outfield of LF Danny Bautista, Jr., CF Junior Pérez and RF Colby Thomas for 14 straight games, every game since August 20th, since Clark Elliott was placed on the Injured List. Bautista, Jr. has played in 59 of the last 60 Lugnuts games dating back to June 24, while Pérez has played in 55 of the last 56 games and Thomas has played in 49 consecutive games since joining the Nuts on July 7.

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has four players acquired via trade by the Oakland Athletics on its roster. Chronologically, working backwards: Christian Fernandez (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); Euribiel Ángeles (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea, and a 2021 member of the Fort Wayne TinCaps); Gunnar Hoglund (Toronto Blue Jays, 3/16/22, for Matt Chapman); and Junior Pérez (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo).

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster has two current first-rounders: shortstop Jacob Wilson, the sixth overall pick this year from Grand Canyon University, and the Blue Jays' 2021 first-round selection, 19th overall, Gunnar Hoglund, acquired via trade in March 2022 for Matt Chapman. The A's 2021 first-round selection, shortstop Max Muncy, and 2022 first-round selection, catcher Daniel Susac, are both currently excelling with the Double-A Midland RockHounds in the Texas League.

#### **TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY**

2009: The Lugnuts scored nine runs in the 5th inning to win at South Bend, 11-10. The Silver Hawks scored three runs in the bottom of the 9th and had runners at 1st/2nd with only one out, but Yorman Mayora retired A.J. Pollock and Reynaldo Navarro to sew up the win. The Nuts went 11-for-21 with runners in scoring position in the win, and RF Johermyn Chavez went 5-for-6 with two doubles and two RBIs.

2010: In the final game of the season, the Lugnuts routed host Lake County, 11-0, behind four-hit games from Brad McElroy and Jake Marisnick (raising Marisnick's average with the Nuts to .220). Marisnick also had two of the Lugnuts' five stolen bases in the game, and Casey Lawrence (7 IP, 2 H, 5 K) combined with three relievers on a five-hit shutout. The Nuts finished the season 70-69.

2016: Bo Bichette and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., made their unofficial Lugnuts debuts, competing in the pregame Home Run Derby at the 10th annual Crosstown Showdown presented by Auto-Owners Insurance (where they were outhomered by eventual champion Connor Panas, who hit 14 homers in the 1st round and 14 more in the championship round to best MSU's Dan Durkin). Then Bichette supplied an RBI triple in the game itself,

Christian Williams hit a two-run homer, and the Lugnuts beat the Spartans, 4-1, before a crowd of 8,432. Cavan Biggio went 2-for-3 with two stolen bases and a run scored.

2018: The Bowling Green Hot Rods won their first playoff series in franchise history (en route to the first MWL title in franchise history, holding off the Lugnuts, 4-3, to win Game 2 of the first-round series at Bowling Green Ballpark, clinching the series, 2 games to 0. The two teams had driven eight hours through the night after the previous evening's game. Trailing 4-1 entering the 9th, the Lugnuts scored runs on a Ryan Noda sacrifice fly and a Brandon Grudzielanek RBI single to keep hope alive, but Ryan Gold flied out to center field against Tyler Day, ending the game and the season. Moises Gomez hit a two-run homer and an RBI single, driving in Vidal Brujan twice, to lift the Hot Rods' offense. Nuts starter Graham Spraker pitched seven innings in defeat, allowing three runs, and leadoff hitter Samad Taylor singled, doubled and scored a run. On the same day, Nuts groundskeeper ach Sevens was named Midwest League Groundskeeper of the Year.

**Retrospective:** Watters made his Midwest League debut at Four Winds Field on August 31, 2022, pitching against rehabber Wade Miley in Lansing debut... had made just one prior appearance in the minors before joining the Lugnuts: August 23 for the Arizona Complex League Athletics vs. the Ariz. Complex League Cubs.

Entering Draft Day: Rated Keith Law's No. 68 draft prospect for The Athletic, with Law writing, "Watters started the year in the Mountaineers' bullpen, where he hit 99 mph a few times, so the team moved him to the rotation around midseason, where he struggled more with control (37 walks in 50.2 innings) but also showed enough that some scouts think he can start in pro ball. Watters sits 94-97 mph with a power slider in the mid-80s that can miss bats ... when he locates it. It's not a bad delivery, with a reasonably short arm stroke and strong finish, so that's not the reason he doesn't throw strikes, but it's true across all of his pitches. It's much more likely he ends up a power reliever with two plus pitches. But with enough of a changeup to start and a delivery that looks like it should work, I wouldn't be surprised to see a pro team keep him in the rotation."... Fangraphs' No. 96 draft prospect.

**Inked:** Selected 124th overall by the A's in the 4th round and signed for \$491,750... highest pitcher taken by the Athletics in 2022 (following first-round catcher Daniel Susac and three straight outfielders in high schooler Henry Bolte in the second round, Michigan Wolverine Clark Elliott in the compensatory round B, and Mercer slugger Colby Thomas in the third round).

**WVU** to the Pros: First of three Mountaineers selected in the 2022 draft... the 2021 Fort Wayne TinCaps featured two WVU teammates in 2021 draftees Jackson Wolf (4th round) and Ryan Bergert (6th round); pitched against Bergert on May 26 and tossed 5 2/3 scoreless innings, allowing only one hit... the last WVU player taken in the first round was Alek Manoah by Toronto in 2019, who in 2022 joined John Means as the only Mountaineers to be named MLB All-Stars... the last West Virginia player to suit up for the Lugnuts was Ryan McBroom, who won the 2015 Midwest League Most Valuable Player award.

Glory Days: Starred for the Bland County HS Rockets as an all-state baseball player as well as in basketball (where he regularly posted double-doubles and topped out at 45 points in one game) and football.

**Off to College:** Did not receive much notice before his high velocity was discovered at a tryout in Morgantown... named to the Academic All-Big 12 Rookie Team as a freshman (5 G, 4.70 ERA, 7 2/3 IP, 4 R, 6 BB, 11 K)... as a sophomore, made 19 appearances: 3.33 ERA, 27 IP, 15 H, 11 R, 32 BB, bullpen-leading 53 K, .165 avg. allowed, tied for team lead with four saves; named Academic All-Big 12 Second Team; NCBWA Stopper of the Year Midseason Watch List... made first college start in the 2021 Big 12 Championship vs. Texas: 3 IP, 0 H, 1 R, 4 BB, 8 K... as a junior in 2022, named preseason All-American; dominated early as team closer and was moved into role as Friday starter; struck out 15 Texas Longhorns in 6 1/3 IP on May 7; overall: 18 G, 11 GS, 3-7, 6.22 ERA, 59 1/3 IP, 64 H, 44 R, 41 BB, 75 K; named All-Big 12 Honorable Mention.

Hometown Hero: Home city of Rocky Gap, Virginia, is in the Ridge-and-Valley Appalachians, located near the West Virginia border... neighboring city: Bluefield, home of the Bluefield Ridge Runners, previously known as the Bluefield Orioles and Bluefield Blue Jays, which fed such stars as Alejandro Kirk and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. to the Lugnuts when both were part of the Jays' system... cousin is Jason Michaels, who played 11 years (2001-2011) in MLB.

Prospecting: MLB Pipeline had ranked Watters the No. 26 prospect in the A's organization and the No. 12 pitching prospect before the recent ranking reorganization, in which he fell off the Top 30 entirely... his grades: Fastball 60, Curve 60, Changeup 45, Control 45, Overall 40... his scouting report: "Watters is a strong presence on the mound at 6-foot-4. His fastball was up to 99 mph during his junior year and touched triple digits in his time as a reliever. He also possesses a plus pitch in his power curve, missing plenty of bats as a true 12-to-6 that sits in the mid-80s. There's also a mid-80s changeup in there, though it's less polished compared to his other two offerings. Command will need to improve for Watters to have a chance to start at the next level. While the stuff was high-octane in college, he usually had little idea of how to locate it. Given his track record as a reliever, there's a strong chance he ends up back in the bullpen, where he can rear back and overpower hitters with two plus pitches."
