### RIDERS DROP NATURALS WITH BIG OFFENSE:

The Frisco RoughRiders powered their way to an 11-2 win over the Northwest Arkansas Naturals on Friday night from Arvest Ballpark. The RoughRiders (5-2) jumped out in front early, scoring three times in the first inning against Naturals (4-3) pitcher Ethan Bosacker (1-1). Two batters into the game, **Sebastian Walcott** lined an RBI single to center before **Cam Cauley** ripped a two-run triple to right-center field to make it 3-0. Walcott drove in three, going 2-for-5 while Cauley plated four runs, going 3-for-4 with two walks. That score held until Peyton Wilson slugged a solo homer against Mitch Bratt (1-0) in the fifth. Bratt tossed the first RoughRiders quality start on the season, allowing just two runs on six hits over his six innings while striking out six and not walking a batter in the win. Frisco immediately answered back in the sixth by scoring four runs. **Luis Mieses** plated a run on an RBI single before **Alejandro Osuna** added on with an RBI single of his own. With two outs, Cauley drilled a two-run single up the middle to extend the lead to 7-1. After a run for the Naturals in the bottom of the sixth, the Riders volleyed back with four more runs in the seventh. The first run scored on an error before a two-run double from Walcott and a **Josh Hatcher** RBI single that pushed the lead to 11-2. **Ryan Lobus** threw two shutout innings from the bullpen and **Travis MacGregor** added a runless ninth.

### THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

The Frisco bullpen has been a bright spot for the Riders in the beginning of the season. While the pitching staff has had a 3.92 ERA overall (4th-best in the Texas League), the bullpen pitchers have been even better. If you remove **Ben Anderson's** long relief as a normal starting pitcher on Opening Night, Frisco's bullpen pitchers have combined to allow just five earned runs over 29.0 innings (1.55 ERA). The bullpen overall has a 2.41 ERA overall, which is still 4th in the Texas League, but their 1.55 ERA would be second in the circuit.

### I GOT THE POWER:

The RoughRiders have shown off their punch to begin the season. Frisco's eight home runs through seven games are tied for second in the Texas League, while they are also second in SLG (.437) and OPS (.829). **Josh Hatcher**, **Cooper Johnson** and **Luis Mieses** have all hit two home runs, tied for second in the league. Mieses has hit safely in each of his first four games this year, batting .444 (8-for-18) with a triple, the two homers and eight RBIs.

### VERSUS THE NATURALS:

A season ago, the RoughRiders went 7-5 against Northwest Arkansas. **Maximo Acosta** dominated on the offensive side (.421/.532/.658/1.190 over 10G), but **Abimelec Ortiz** and **Josh Hatcher** were the two best returners against the Naturals. Ortiz hit three home runs in 11 games while slashing .341/.449/.610/1.059 while Hatcher collected 17 hits in 10 games, including a five-hit game, to hit .405 with a 1.039 OPS against the Royals affiliate. With his home run in each of the first two games of this series, Hatcher is now hitting .387 (29-for-75)/.432/.573/1.005 in his career against the Naturals across 17 games with three home runs and 16 RBIs.

### HATCHIN' HITTIN':

**Josh Hatcher** was incredible for the RoughRiders in 2024 and he has picked up right where he left off in 2025. Hatcher hit .300/.350/.448/.798 over 107 games with Frisco last season. He was one of just three qualified hitters in all of Double-A baseball to hit .300 or better. To start 2025, he has hit safely in all six games he's played in, batting .483 (14-for-29)/.483/.724/1.207 with a double, two home runs, eight RBIs, a stolen base and six runs scored over his first six games. He has the most hits in Double-A (14) and the second-best batting average (.483) while being second in total bases (21). Hatcher already has five multi-hit games and is 5-for-5 when putting the first pitch of an at-bat in play.

### ABIME-LECTRIC ORTIZ:

**Abimelec Ortiz** ended the year on fire for the RoughRiders. In his last 48 games, Ortiz hit .321/.413/.592/1.005 with nine doubles, 13 home runs, 38 RBIs, 37 runs scored and 28 walks. After July 10th, in those 48 games, he is fourth in average (.321), first in OPS (1.005), tied for first in RBIs (38) and first in home runs (13). During that span, he paced all of Double-A in OPS as well. In his last 29 games, he batted .364 (40-for-110)/.470/.710/1.170 with five doubles, 10 home runs, 30 RBIs, 21 walks, 24 strikeouts and 27 runs scored. Entering into June 23rd's game, he was hitting .179 with a .550 OPS. After, he hit .307 with a .954 OPS, raising his batting average to .243 and a .760 OPS. Ortiz is hitting .233 (7-for-30)/.324/.300/.624 through the first seven games of the season in 2025.

### WE'RE GOING PROSPECTING:

The RoughRiders have nine players in MLB Pipeline's Rangers Top 30 Prospects rankings to start 2025. **Sebastian Walcott** (No. 1) headlines the bunch and is the only member of the top 100 as well (No. 17). On the mound, **Winston Santos** (No. 5), **Kohl Drake** (No. 13), **Mitch Bratt** (No. 21) and **Josh Stephan** (No. 22) all slot into the starting rotation while **Skyler Hales** (No. 25) will work from the bullpen. On offense, outfielder **Alejandro Osuna** (No. 8) and first baseman/outfielder **Abimelec Ortiz** (No. 14) round out the nine players.

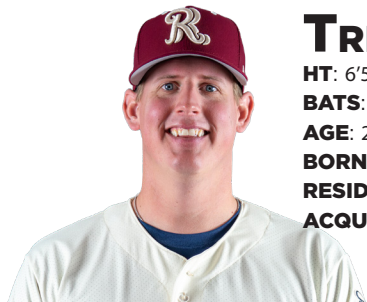

ABOUT TREY

-Pronounced SHOE-pock. Full name is Treyson Thomas Supak. Was named Treyson because he was the third child and "trey" stood for "three".

-Born in Bryan, Texas, but grew up in La Grange, Texas (La Grange didn't have a hospital). At La Grange High School, he starred in football, basketball and baseball and became the first player drafted from LGHS since Homer Bailey in 2004.

-Committed to University of Houston before signing with Pittsburgh. His uncle Jody was an All-American at Houston and was drafted by Detroit in 1987.

-Was drafted by the Pirates in the CB-B round of 2014.

2025 SEASON

-Started the 2025 season in the RoughRiders rotation.

2024 SEASON

-Spent time between Double-A Tennessee and Triple-A Iowa.

2023 SEASON

-Split time between Double-A Midland and Triple-A Las Vegas. Against Frisco in 2023, he made three appearances out of the bullpen (3.1 IP, 5 H, 4 R, 2 ER, 3 BB, 3 K), allowing a home run to Dustin Harris.

2021-2022 SEASON

-After electing free agency in Nov. of 2020, signed with the A's organization 18 days later.

-Missed the entire season and most of 2022 with "Tommy John" Surgery. Returned to make three starts with Midland that season.

2020 SEASON

-Was called up from the Taxi Squad to the MLB roster in 2020 for three days and was sent back down without making an appearance.

2019 SEASON

-Finished the season as the No. 11 prospect in the Brewers organization by MLB.com.

-When he made his Triple-A debut with San Antonio, it was 1.5 hours from hometown, so he had 40-50 friends and family there. "I have never had a feeling like that heading out to the mound."

-With Double-A Biloxi, won Southern League Most Outstanding Pitcher after leading the league in ERA (2.20), opponent batting average (.192) and tying for the lead in wins (11).

2014-2018 SEASON

-In December of 2015, he was traded to Milwaukee from Pittsburgh along with Keon Broxton in exchange for Jason Rogers.
