INDY BITS

LAST NIGHT: The Indians offense exploded with 13 hits and a season-high six home runs in a 12-8 win over lowa last night. The ball was flying out of Principal Park on both sides, with the teams combining for nine home runs and Anthony Alford, Hunter Owen and Trayce Thompson each hitting two. Through the first three innings, Alford gave the Indians a 3-0 lead with a pair of home runs. Hunter Owen followed up with a solo shot in the fourth inning, and with a 4-0 lead the Indians put up seven runs in the fifth to lift them over lowa's reach. Bethancourt and Michael Chavis each homered in the fifth inning and Anthony Alford scored two with an RBI single. lowa attempted a comeback with Thompson's four RBI on two home runs and three RBI by Nick Martini but fell short.

SLUGGING THE WAY: Anthony Alford had his contract selected by Pittsburgh today after going 4-for-5 with three runs scored, two home runs and a career-high five RBI last night. In the past two nights at lowa, Alford hit three home runs and notched seven RBI, leading to a .429 average (9-for-21) with four home runs and 11 RBI in five August games. Alford leads Indianapolis and ranks among Triple-A East league qualifiers with a .307 batting average (7th, 58-for-189), .420 on-base percentage (3rd), .593 slugging percentage (2nd) and 1.013 OPS (2nd). His OPS is just shy of the league lead. Since June 1, which was the start of Alford reaching base safely in 34-of-38 games, he has hit .356 (48-for-135) with a .456 OBP and 1.160 OPS.

HOPPING OFF THE FLAGPOLE: Hunter Owen joined Anthony Alford last night with two home runs of his own, bumping his season total up to 12 with Indianapolis. He homered first with one out in the fourth, and then sent his second home run off a flagpole out in center field in the ninth inning. It was his first multi-home run game since May 27, 2018 (1) vs. High-A Jupiter. Owen had three total hits in the game, which set a season-high and was his most since June 14, 2019 at Double-A Binghamton.

TOUCH 'EM ALL: The Indians six home runs last night was their most since tying a Victory Field era high with seven home runs on July 6, 2017 at Columbus. Anthony Alford and Hunter Owen's pair of two-homer games was the first time two Indians batters have had multi-home run performances in the same game since May 17, 2017, also at Columbus (Max Moroff, 2; Eric Wood, 2). Last night, nine of Indianapolis' 12 runs were scored via the long ball.

FIRST IMPRESSIONS: Michael Chavis went yard last night to drive in two runs, his first home run in an Indians uniform and ninth of the season between Indy, Triple-A Worcester (6) and Boston (2). In his first three games with Indianapolis, Chavis has gone 4-for-12 with three extra-base hits, four RBI and a stolen base. He was traded from Boston to Pittsburgh in exchange for LHP Austin Davis at the trade deadline on July 30 and was assigned to Indianapolis. He split time between the Red Sox and Triple-A Worcester this season, hitting .263 (25-for-95) with six home runs and 17 RBI in 24 games with the WooSox. Chavis spent most of his time as Worcester's first baseman, compiling a .987 fielding percentage (2 errors, 155 total chances) in 158.2 innings.

TONIGHT: The Indians will look for their third consecutive win at Principal Park since losing the first three games of the series. The I-Cubs still hold a two-game lead this season vs. the Indians and can end the season with at least a split on their home field. The Indians haven't finished with less than a winning record at lowa since 1995 (4-5). LHP Dillon Peters will make his third appearance and second start with the Indians tonight against RHP Adrian Sampson. Sampson has gone 2-0 with a 3.09 ERA (4er/11.2ip) against Indy this season.

WELCOME TO THE ROTATION: Indianapolis native Dillon Peters made his first start with his hometown team on Aug. 1 at St. Paul and allowed just one run on two hits (one home run). He walked three batters and struck out five as the Indians piled on the run support. Prior to being traded from Los Angeles (AL) to Pittsburgh, he made eight starts with Triple-A Salt Lake and compiled a 2-2 record, 4.35 ERA (20er/41.1ip) and 48 strikeouts. In 111 career starts, Peters has gone 39-31 with a 4.12 ERA (251er/548.0ip).

SHAKING IT UP: Along with Anthony Alford's contract being selected by Pittsburgh, the Pirates announced today that outfielder Dustin Fowler has been released and infielder T.J. Rivera has been traded outright to Philadelphia (Triple-A Lehigh Valley). Fowler was just reinstated from the injured list and hit .270 (10-for-37) with three home runs and six RBI in 13 games with Indianapolis this season. Rivera appeared in 57 games with the Indians and hit .249 (48-for-193) with five home runs and 24 RBI.

THIS WEEK IN HISTORY VS. IOWA: From Aug. 5-7, 1997, the Indians and I-Cubs faced off in their final series against each other before a 23-season hiatus. Indianapolis outscored lowa 15-4 en route to a three-game sweep on the road and finished the season with a five-game winning streak against the Cubs. Brian Hunter, Eric Owens and Aaron Boone each hit safely in all three games of the series, with Hunter leading off the series with two extra-base hits, a triple and home run, two runs scored and two RBI.
