FRISCO FALLS TO AMARILLO ON FRIDAY:

The Frisco RoughRiders were defeated by the Amarillo Sod Poodles on Friday evening, losing 10-2 from HODGETOWN. Amarillo (15-22) starter Cole Percival (3-2) spun a season-high 7.2 innings of one run ball, allowing eight hits and no walks while striking out four RoughRiders (23-13). **Nick Krauth** (3-1) ran into trouble in the bottom of the first inning, giving up a leadoff hit followed by four consecutive walks. Wilderd Patiño delivered the big hit of the inning with a two-run double to extend the Sod Poodles' lead to 3-0. Krauth picked up a pair of quick outs to begin the bottom of the second, but Tim Tawa launched a homer to left that gave Amarillo a 4-0 advantage. The Riders snagged their lone run of the night on a solo homer by **Daniel Mateo**, his first career Double-A jack. In the bottom of the fourth, the Sod Poodles increased their lead to 7-1 on Deyvison De Los Santos' three-run homer, his Texas League leading 13th of the year. Krauth exited in the fourth, ending his day with 3.2 innings while conceding seven runs on six hits and six walks while fanning three. **Jacob Maton**, in his Double-A debut, used just 20 pitches to toss 2.1 scoreless and hitless frames with a strikeout. The Sod Poodles netted a pair of runs in the bottom of the eighth against **Bryan Chi** with a base hit by Logan Warmoth and a sacrifice fly from Tawa, who finished a triple shy of the cycle. Chi allowed two runs (one earned) on three hits while striking out one across 2.0 innings. Offensively, eight different RoughRiders collected hits with **Aaron Zavala** turning in the lone multi-hit performance. **Josh Hatcher** and **Geisel Cepeda** each doubled.

TIMING MATTERS:

While the RoughRiders are tied for third in the league in batting average (.248), they are second in the Texas League in average with runners in scoring position (.287). They also have the third-fewest left on base in the Texas League (220, 6.1 per game). **Josh Hatcher** is eighth in the league with a .361 batting average with RISP while **Cody Freeman** is ninth (.353) and **Aaron Zavala** is 11th (.344).

DRIVERS, START YOUR ENGINES:

The RoughRiders have seen a lot of runs this season in the first inning of games. Frisco is third in the Texas League with 26 first-inning runs while they have allowed the second-most first-inning runs in the league as well (27).

MAY FLOWERS:

The RoughRiders are 10-4 in the month of May, the best record in the Texas League. Frisco has the best overall ERA in the month (3.44) while they have a 1.84 bullpen ERA in the month. Out of their 10 wins in the month, the Riders have recorded a league-best six saves. On the offensive side, they are second in the league with 24 steals and fewest strikeouts (87), but are fourth in OPS (.715) and seventh with just 10 home runs.

IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

Riders outfielder **Kellen Strahm** has the longest on-base streak this season for the RoughRiders, currently at 22 games. During the streak, he hit .306 (26-for-85)/.394/.412/.806 with a double, a triple, two home runs, eight RBIs, 13 walks, five steals and 20 runs scored. The streak is the third-longest active streak in the Texas League. In his career, Strahm has the second-longest on-base streak in RoughRiders franchise history (37 games in 2022). His 159 career walks with the RoughRiders are the second-most in franchise history, trailing only **Guilder Rodriguez**, who walked 206 times over seven seasons from 2009 to 2015.

THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Part of the RoughRiders' dominance on the mound has been the Frisco bullpen. Over the last 15 games, the bullpen has allowed just 10 earned runs over 52.1 innings (1.70 ERA). On the season, the bullpen is second in the Texas League with a 3.44 ERA.

I WANT TO BREAK FREE(MAN):

Cody Freeman had a monster game on April 25th against Amarillo, going 5-for-5 with two home runs and a double. It was the first five-hit game in Freeman's Minor League career and the first one for the Riders since **Blaire Crim** accomplished the feat on September 2nd, 2022 at Amarillo. Over his last 22 games, he is batting .321 (27-for-84)/.356/.583/.939 with seven doubles, five home runs, 15 RBIs and 13 runs scored. In his last 19 games, he has batted .338/.359/.635/.994 with all five of his homers.

THE HATCHER HAMMER:

In an incredible win on April 27th, **Josh Hatcher** hammered a three-run, walk-off home run for a 4-3 win over Amarillo. Hatcher's caper was his third home run in as many games. He is slashing .330/.376/.490/.866. Hatcher is second in the league in batting average (.330), fifth in RBIs (23), ninth in slugging percentage (.490) and eighth in OPS (.866). Last Thursday, the Texas Rangers announced that Hatcher was named the Rangers Minor League Player of the Month for April. He slashed .373/.403/.576/.979 over 15 games for Frisco in April with three doubles, three home runs, 16 RBIs, 11 runs and three steals. He finished third in the Texas League in batting average (.373), tied for eighth in RBIs (16), sixth in slugging (.576) and sixth in OPS (.979).

ABOUT DANE

-Went to Brenham High School in Brenham, Texas (between Austin and Houston). His senior year of high school, he went 8-2 with a 1.79 ERA.

-Acker attended Rice for freshman season, going 5-2 with a 4.20 ERA and earned Conference USA All-Freshman Team honors. From there, transferred to San Jacinto College for sophomore season in 2019, going 10-0 with a 2.36 ERA in 14 starts. He struck out 97 batters in 76.1 IP.

-Drafted by the Arizona Diamondbacks in the 2019 23rd round, but did not sign.

-For his junior season, he went to Oklahoma University, making four starts in the COVID-shortened season, going 1-1 with a 3.51 ERA. At the Schripes College Classic on March 1st against No.11 LSU, Acker threw the first Oklahoma no-hitter since 1989, striking out 11 batters to just one walk and two hit batters. He threw 117 pitches in the game.

-Acker was taken by the Oakland Athletics in the 4th round of the 2020 draft, one pick after Braves pitcher Spencer Strider.

2024 SEASON

-Ranked as the No. 28 prospect in the Texas system by MLB.com entering the season.

-In first start at Wichita on Opening Day, threw 3.2 no-hit innings before allowing his first hit. Finished with 4.2 innings, allowing just one run in a 6-4 Riders win.

2023 SEASON

-Ranked as the No. 22 prospect in the Texas system by MLB.com entering the season.

-In Double-A debut at San Antonio on July 3rd, allowed two-run inside the park homer in the third inning to Juan Fernandez, but struck out five.

-When he was promoted to Double-A Frisco on July 3rd, Acker had just thrown 53.1 career MiLB innings over 17 games with only 50.1 innings and 12 games in affiliated ball above the Rookie level.

-Finished out High-A time with a 1.65 ERA (3ER/16.1IP) in June.

-Induced ground balls at a 46.9% rate with High-A Hickory over his six starts.

-Earned first career MiLB win with five strong innings against San Antonio on July 18th.

-Made best start of MiLB career on August 30th against CC with 5.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 2 BB, 5 K.

2022 SEASON

-Acker returned from rehab in mid-July, throwing in the Arizona League before making four starts with Hickory, debuting with the Crawdads on August 21st.

-After the season, Acker participated in the Rangers' Fall Instructional League program.

2021 SEASON

-After trade to Rangers, Acker made two starts with the Down East Wood Ducks before his second ended with "Tommy John" surgery.

-Traded from the Oakland Athletics along with OF Khris Davis and C Jonah Heim in exchange for INF Elvis Andrus and C Aramis Garcia and cash on February 6th, 2021.
