YESTERDAY: Aaron Civalé, Kevn Kelly and Hunter Gaddis combined on a four-hit shutout, as the Captains beat Great Lakes, 5-0. Civalé pitched 4.1 innings in a major league rehab assignment and limited the Loons to one hit with four strikeouts and no walks. Kelly recorded the final two outs of the fifth in succession, including a strikeout. Gaddis spun four shutout innings with eight strikeouts, two walks and three hits to earn the victory. The Captains scored three runs in the second on a two-run single by Wilfri Peralta and a one-run single by Julian Escobedo. José Tena later hit a two-run homer in the sixth to cap the scoring. The Captains regained sole possession of first place in the High-A Central League East Division with the win.

PRESSURE PACKED: The last 10 Captains games have featured opponents in the top two spots in the High-A Central East Division standings. Every game has pitted the Captains against a team within 1.0 game of Lake County in the standings.

PLAYOFF PICTURE: The Captains enter today 2.0 game behind the Cedar Rapids Kernels for the second playoff spot in the High-A Central League (HAC). Lake County, Cedar Rapids, the Dayton Dragons and the Great Lakes Loons are all separated by just 4.0 games. The Quad Cities River Bandits currently hold the top playoff spot and are 10.5 games ahead of second place. The top two teams in the HAC earn playoff bids (regardless of division).

ARCH NEMESIS: The Great Lakes Loons are the only team against whom the Captains have a losing record this season (9-13). Lake County also has its worst run differential (-52), ERA (6.19) and opponent's OPS (.890) against Great Lakes.

KEYSTONE PRODUCTION: Captains second basemen are a combined 7-for-15 (.467) this series with six RBI and seven runs scored. Christian Cairo, Raynel Delgado and Wilfri Peralta have shared the keystone duties this series. Cairo is 4-for-8 with two RBI and four runs. Delgado is 1-for-3 when playing second base with a run scored. Peralta is 2-for-4 with four RBI and two runs.

NO TRAFFIC: In the month of August, the Captains' pitching staff owns the league's lowest WHIP (1.14), has allowed the second-fewest hits (155) and has the second-lowest batting average against (.213). Their WHIP, hit total and batting average against are all the second-best in all of High-A.

WALK THIS WAY: The Captains' offense enters today tied for the High-A Central League lead in walks in August (96). Lake County has not finished a month above fourth in the league in that category this year.

WELCOME BACK: Aaron Bracho is in the starting lineup for the Captains tonight. It will be his first game since August 3. He was placed on the Injured List on August 6 with a left thumb strain.

HOME COOKIN' TASTES BETTER: The Captains have a better record at home (28-18) compared to on the road (25-28). Lake County's run differential, however, is better on the road (even) compared to at home (-11).

NEW BLOOD: 3B Jhonkensy Noel joined the Captains on August 17. The 20-year old led all of Low-A (minimum 160 PA) with a .393 batting average and a 190 wRC+, while hitting 11 homers. INF Christian Cairo and OF Jonathan Rodríguez joined the Captains on August 24. Cairo led Low-A Lynchburg with 37 walks and held a .364 on-base percentage, which led all Hillcats (minimum 200 PA). Rodríguez slashed .314/.363/.450 with the Hillcats, good for an .812 OPS

LAST TIME OUT: Espino tallied his fourth consecutive 10-K performance and held the Dayton Dragons scoreless over five innings. He earned the win in a 9-2 Captains victory.

WHAT A PLAY: Espino locked in after early trouble last Saturday. The right-hander walked the first three hitters of the game, but escaped the bases-loaded jam with help from his defense and Dayton's baserunning. After Espino struck out Juan Martinez for the first out of the inning, Victor Ruiz hit a flare into centerfield. Jacob Hurtubise broke late from third and got caught between third and home with Michael Siani, who began the play on second. Second baseman **Raynel Delgado** picked up the ball in center and fired toward home. First baseman **Joe Naranjo** fielded the ball below the mound and shoveled home to get Hurtubise. After tagging out Hurtubise, catcher **Gianpaul González** threw to third and caught Siani for a 4-3-2-5 inning-ending double play. Espino allowed just two more baserunners the rest of the way and struck out nine of the final 13 batters he faced.

MOWING THEM DOWN: Espino has struck out 10 or more batters in each of his last four starts. The right-hander has accumulated 43 K's in 19 innings during that stretch for a 20.37 K/9 rate. He has walked seven in that span for a 6.14 K/BB rate. Espino has a 3.79 ERA (8 ER) over those four starts.

PROSPECTING: Espino ranks as Cleveland's #2 prospect according to *FanGraphs*, #3 by *Baseball America* and #5 by *MLB.com*.

SIT DOWN: Espino has struck out 10+ in each of his last three starts. In those starts, Espino has 33 strikeouts and four walks across 14 innings. That is a 21.2 K/9 rate and an 8.25 K/BB rate.

TOP PICK: Cleveland drafted Espino with their first round pick (24th overall) in the 2019 MLB Draft. The right-hander earned a \$2.5 million signing bonus. He was committed to play at Louisiana State University before signing with Cleveland.

SCOUTING REPORT: "Espino works at 94-97 mph and can touch triple digits with his fastball, imparting running life on his four-seamer and heavy sink on his two-seamer. He backs up his heat with a pair of bat-missing breaking balls, with his low-80s slider sharper and grading better than his high-70s curveball. His changeup is more of a work in progress that gets too firm at times but also features some promising sink." (Source: [MLB.com](#))

PANAMA → GEORGIA: Espino was born and grew up in Panama, but moved to the United States when he was a sophomore in high school and pitched for Georgia Premier Academy in Statesboro, GA. As Mandy Bell wrote in her [MLB.com article on Espino](#), Espino spent time in the U.S. for baseball when he was 10 and decided then that he wanted to move there. When Daniel was 15, he went to his parents and told them he needed to move to the United States to pursue his baseball dreams. When asked about his decision to move to the U.S., Espino said "My mom and dad wanted me to finish high school first and then worry about the next, but I love playing baseball. I had the opportunity to [visit America] when I was 10 years old and I loved it. Now, the sacrifice is paying off" (Source: [The Record-Courier](#)).

PANAMANIAN ROLE MODEL: Espino idolized Panamanian star and Hall of Fame closer Mariano Rivera as a child.

FIRST SINCE FRANCISCO: When he advanced to Mahoning Valley in 2019, Espino became the first high schooler promoted by Cleveland to the Short Season level since Francisco Lindor in 2011.

2020: Pitched at Classic Park, which was Cleveland's alternate training site, before doing remote development prior to the fall instructional league. Espino did not pitch at instructs due to a minor shoulder injury (Source: [FanGraphs](#)).

2019: Made his professional debut in the Rookie Level Arizona League and posted a 1.98 ERA before being bumped up to Short Season Mahoning Valley. Espino posted a 6.30 ERA with the Scrappers over three starts. Though he made nine starts and did not make any relief appearances, Espino never pitched more than four innings in a single professional game during his debut season.
