Tonight: The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the second in a six-game series against the archrival West Michigan Whitecaps, the High-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. The Nuts won the opener last night, handing the Whitecaps their first loss of the year and taking a 215-214 lead in the all-time series.

Starting Matchup: Former Pitt Panther **Mitch Myers** makes his Lugnuts debut, taking on West Michigan's **Wilkel Hernandez** in a battle of northpaws. Myers was acquired by Oakland in the 12th round in 2021 while Hernandez was picked up by Detroit with outfielder Troy Montgomery from the L.A. Angels in exchange for Ian Kinsler in December 2017. Montgomery made it as far as Double-A Erie in 2019 before retiring from pro baseball. Hernandez made two starts against the Lugnuts in 2018, taking the loss on July 2 and firing six shutout innings to earn the win on August 17. A year later, he turned in two more gems against the Nuts, on April 11 (5 IP, 1 R) and July 24 (6 IP, 1 R). In 20 2/3 total innings, he has limited the Nuts to four runs.

Yesterday: Lugnuts 5, Whitecaps 2: Center fielder **Caeden Trenkle** went 4-for-5, **Christian Fernandez** struck out six in 4 1/3 scoreless innings, and the Nuts stayed undefeated in 2023.

LUG•NOTES

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old **Max Muncy** was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 21-year-old **Daniel Susac** was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C Tyler Soderstrom.

His Time: The late-season sensation in 2022 in the A's system was fireballer **Mason Miller**, who made three starts for the Nuts and struck out 13 batters in seven dominant innings. Miller opened the year in Double-A Midland, struck out eight Northwest Arkansas Naturals in 3 2/3 innings and was promoted yesterday to Triple-A Las Vegas.

Sweeping into the New Season: The last time the Lugnuts opened a season with four straight wins, it was 2017, which coincidentally also began with a sweep of the Loons. The franchise record for most wins to start a year is seven, accomplished in 2012 – and snapped on April 13 of that year by the West Michigan Whitecaps.

Starting Strong: Lansing starting pitchers have combined to allow one run (a first-inning tally on Saturday against **Jacob Watters**) in 17 innings through the first four games, an ERA of 0.53. The league is hitting .107 against the combined efforts of Watters, last night's starter **Christian Fernandez**, **Joelvis Del Rosario** and **Jack Perkins**.

To the Max: Lugnuts shortstop **Max Muncy** went 1-for-3 with a two-run single and a walk last night and has now hit safely (and reached multiple times) in all four games this year. Muncy leads the Midwest League in base hits (7) and doubles (3) and ranks third in batting average (.438), fifth in OBP (.500, tied with teammate **Caeden Trenkle**) and fifth in OPS (1.125).

Ready for a Roundtripper? No home runs (or triples, for that matter) have been hit in the first four games of the season by either the Lugnuts or the opposition. Number of games it took to see the first home run in a season: 2022 - four; 2021 - one; 2019 - three; 2018 - two; 2017 - one; 2016 - two; 2015 - two; 2014 - one; 2013 - one; 2012 - four; 2011 - one; 2010 - one; 2009 - six; 2008 - one; 2007 - one; 2006 - five; 2005 - two.

Fast Start: Thanks to a pair of steals yesterday from **Danny Bautista, Jr.** and **Max Muncy**, the Nuts are second in the MWL with ten stolen bases. West Michigan is the only team in the circuit that has yet to attempt a steal. Contrast that with **Lazaro Armenteros**, who has a league-leading four swipes this year, including three in one game on Saturday at Dow Diamond.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2012: The Lugnuts win their seventh straight game to start the season, a new team record, with closer Ajay Meyer stranding the potential game-tying run at third base in a 3-2 win at West Michigan. Lansing had swept three games from Great Lakes and three games from Dayton before taking on the Whitecaps. Future Miami Marlin Jon Berti went 2-for-3 with a single, double, walk, RBI, and run scored to lead the Lugnuts' winning effort.

2022: Pinch-hitter Jonny Butler's RBI single in the ninth had forced extra innings at West Michigan, and then Butler struck again with a tie-breaking single in the 11th to spark a four-run rally, seemingly pushing the Nuts to a thrilling victory at their archrival. But the Whitecaps tallied five runs in the bottom of the 11th against Daniel Martinez, winning the game on a Wenceel Pérez two-run double, 11-10.

In a Nutshell: Final Lugnuts starting pitcher to make his 2023 debut, opening as the Wednesday starter... upon throwing his first pitch, becomes the 906th player in Lansing Lugnuts franchise history... the last Pitt Panther to start a game for the Lugnuts was also the only other Panther ever to play for the Nuts: T.J. Zeuch (pronounced "Zoyk"), the 21st overall pick in 2016, who made two starts for Lansing in 2016 and is now in Lehigh Valley (Triple-A - Philadelphia)... @mitch_myers9.

Hometown Hero: Lanett's motto is "The Gateway to Alabama," since it sits directly on the Eastern border to Georgia, directly bordering West Point, Georgia... pitched for Valley High School as a freshman and sophomore and Opelika High School as a junior and senior, posting a career 1.22 ERA with a fastball/curveball mix, playing third base, and batting third... father Barry starred in baseball at Jacksonville State.

College Journey: Initially committed to University of Alabama, joining juco Florida Southwestern State instead, making 15 appearances, 14 starts, in both 2017-18 and 2018-19... as a freshman: 5-6, 4.28, 2 CG, 73 2/3, 35 BB, 62 K, 1 HR... as a sophomore: 7-2, 3.29, 3 CG, 79 1/3, 23 BB, 88 K, 3 HR... became one of 10 Bucs to sign on with a D-I program (not including Ryan Gusto, who was drafted in the 11th round by the Astros)... upon transferring to Pitt, made four starts in 2020 (2-2, 3.52, 23 IP, 4 BB, 30 K, 0 HR) before the season was shut down, with 10 strikeouts in six shutout innings vs. Lehigh... followed in 2021 as Pitt's Friday starter: 13 GS, 5-5, 3.21, 1 CG, 81 1/3, 23 BB, 83 K, 6 HR... tossed 9-IP CG at Virginia, 3/20/21, allowing three hits, one run, and whiffing five.

Professional Debut: After signing for \$125,000 as the Athletics' 12th-round selection in 2021, did not appear in a Minor League game until 2022, spent entirely with Stockton... led Ports in starts (22, six more than the closest teammate), innings (124 1/3, 28 1/3 more innings than the closest teammate), and double plays (10)... worked seven innings five times, 6 2/3 innings once, 6 1/3 innings twice, and six innings four times: 12 starts of 22 starts lasting at least six innings... struggled in 12 games, 11 starts, at home (7.11 ERA, .304 avg, 16 HR, in 57 innings) compared to 11 starts on the road (4.14 ERA, .269, 10 HR in 67 1/3 innings)... lefties and righties hit nearly identically: .286/.355/.536 for lefties, .285/.339/.525 for righties, though righties hit 17 of the 26 home runs allowed... struggled mightily in first innings, allowing .353/.402/.627 slash line and six home runs... opposing base stealers swiped 10 bases in 16 attempts.
