**DOING THE SPLITS OVER HERE:** After splitting 12 games in a two-week home stand and then splitting the first two games of this 12-game road trip with Columbia, the FredNats aim to win the first half of the six-game set with the Kansas City-affiliated Fireflies tonight at Segra Park. Travis Sthele makes another start for FXBG, and in the second half, he has been a key contributor to the FredNat rotation. In nine appearances and 45 innings in the 2nd half, Sthele has an ERA of 2.40, a WHIP of 1.29, and has allowed just 12 earned runs this half. He faces Columbia righty Felix Arronde, who has been solid this year in the Fireflies' rotation.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** Fredericksburg's bat fell mostly silent in a 4-1 loss to the Fireflies. Nate Ochoa had the lone RBI for Fredericksburg, knocking in Caleb Lomavita with a two out, two strike double, but the Freddies managed just seven total hits and went 0-for-7 with runners in scoring position. Alex Clemmey had his best start for FXBG, pitching five shutout innings with five strikeouts, and only allowed a total of three base runners.

**GREEN IS HOT:** After another huge three-run homer Tuesday night to give the FredNats an eventual win, Elijah Green's numbers post All-Star break show why the Nationals selected him number five overall in the 2022 draft. Since the All-Star break, Green is slashing .276/.302/.586 for OPS of .888, which is the best stretch of his professional career at the plate. His wRC+ - which measures a player's contribution to run creation - since the ASB is 157 (100 is average), and his wOBA - which measures not only if a player reached base, but how he reached base and the impact it has on scoring on runs - is .417 (.320 is average).

**EVEN MORE NEW FACES:** After the arrival of Washington's top two 2024 draft picks to the FredNats last week, more members of the draft class are now FredNats. Washington's third-rounder Kevin Bazzell (C) out of Texas Tech made his pro debut last night and got his first hit. Seventh rounder Robert Cranz (RHP) from Oklahoma State will likely debut tonight, and 11th rounder Merritt Beeker (LHP) from Ball State debuted last night in mop up duty. Bazzell was named first team All-Big 12 in 2023 for the Red Raiders and second team in 2024. Cranz began his collegiate career at Wichita State before transferring to Oklahoma State in '24. Beeker began his collegiate career at East Carolina before transferring to Ball State (IN) where he was named the Mid-American Conference's Pitcher of the Year in 2024.

**HE'S SOMETHING ELSE:** Travis Sykora has proven to be one of the most dominant pitchers in the Carolina League since arriving in Fredericksburg on May 1. Since beginning his professional career that day, he ranks first in all of MiLB in strikeouts per nine (13.68), 1st in opponent average (.157), 3rd in WHIP (0.85), and is tied for 9th with 111 strikeouts. In his last six starts, he's struck out at least 10 hitters in three of them, and has an ERA of 1.29 in that time frame. In MLB Pipeline's re-ranking of prospects, Sykora shot up the list to Washington's third overall prospect, and entered the Top 100 prospects in baseball as well. Sykora is also the first and only pitcher in the Carolina League this season to be named Pitcher of the Week in back-to-back weeks after he faced the minimum batters in 11 hitless innings across his previous two starts prior to last week.

**NO-HITTER!:** Last Friday, Travis Sykora, Angel Roman and Merrick Baldo combined to throw the first nine inning no-hitter in Fredericksburg Nationals history. It was the 32nd total no-hitter this year in Minor League Baseball, but only 20 of those have come in full-season ball. Of the 32 total no-no's this year in MiLB, only 16 of them have come in nine innings. It was the second no-hitter this year in the league.

**THE SKIP IS BACK:** The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg. Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 205-171 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

**THE STAFF:** The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals. He was the Pitching Coach for the High-A Wilmington Blue Rocks in 2021 and the Double-A Harrisburg Senators in 2022 before coming to FXBG in 2023 and spending the last two seasons here.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prairie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past three seasons. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with ZSP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh is also in his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

**TODAY'S START:** Travis Sthele makes his 19th start of the year this evening, against the Salem Red Sox. A 12th round pick by the Nats in 2023, Sthele joined the FredNat rotation late in the 2023 campaign. Sthele has been mainly a starter, but has worked in the piggyback role twice this season.

**A YEAR AGO:** Sthele took his lumps after joining Fredericksburg last season. He posted a 7.36 ERA over four starts, to go along with a 1.82 WHIP. Travis struck out six hitters over 11.0 IP but showcased strong command, walking just three men.

**TRENDING UP:** After a rough start to the season, Sthele has made marked improvements as the summer goes along. In the second half, Sthele has posted a 2.40 ERA across 45.0 innings (8/9 GS), with 34 K's and opponents hitting just .229 against him.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Sthele worked five solid innings against the Red Sox last week, who touched him for seven hits but just three earned runs albeit in a loss for the right-hander.
